Motor Cycle News/Duckhams Superbike Championship

Welcome to Mallory Park for the third round of the exciting Motor Cycle News/Duckhams Superbike Championship.

After the first two rounds, at Donington and Cadwell, Roger Marshall, the brilliant Lincolnshire rider, has already pulled out a slender two point lead over Rocket Ron Haslam, both riding the all-conquering 750 Yamahas. Haslam won the first leg at both Donington and Cadwell, with Marshall chasing him home at the Louth circuit, but in the second leg at Cadwell, Marshall reversed the positions — and picked up five bonus points for the fastest lap. That win gave Marshall 50 championship points to Haslam's 48, so today's races have an extra spice.

Down in third place and 20 points behind the leader is the one and only Barry Sheene, still recovering from his spectacular crash at the French GP in which he seriously injured his left hand.

Bazzer certainly seems to have sorted out his early season problems with the Akai Yamaha and is riding as well as ever, and holds his third place despite missing the Cadwell round.

Behind Sheene is the exciting newcomer Keith Heuwen with 27 points. The star of the Transatlantic series, Heuwen really has come good this season getting faster with every ride on his Len Manchester sponsored Yamaha. Mallory is Heuwen's home circuit so watch out for some fireworks!

Down in fourth place is Mitsui Yamaha rider Dave Potter, the current MCN Duckham's Superbike champion. Always very quick round Mallory, Potter will be keen to improve his placing so as to give himself a chance of retaining this prestigious title. Potter has 22 points following his second place at Donington and a third at Cadwell.

Scunthorpe's Graham Wood has been one of the real sensations of 1980 coming from relative obscurity to challenge the leading runners' reputations. This 27-year-old has been riding exceptionally well and his fifth place in the table is justly deserved.

Right on Wood's tail are Steve Manship and Wil Hartog, both on 12 points. Manship has been his usual consistent self, picking up good points in three of the four legs of the previous two meetings with his 750 Yamaha, while Hartog has only scored once so far this year, taking his big works Suzuki into second place at Donington.

The Gentle Giant is always a big hit with the crowds, his white leathers and immaculate red and black Suzuki making him immediately identifiable. Getting down the championship table now we come to Steve Parrish and Mick Grant, both on ten points. Grant, once again riding the big Yamaha, didn't ride at Donington but scored a good third place in the first leg at Cadwell to pick up his first points of the championship.

Fresh from the Isle of Man TT races, Grant is sure to go well round the circuit today in an effort to get back into a championship in which he has been such a prominent feature for many years.

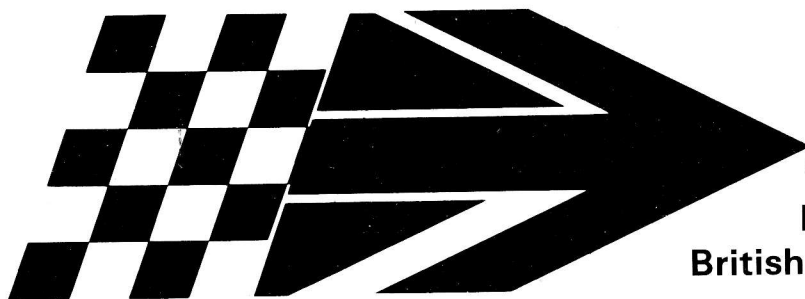
Steve Parrish, the ex-Suzuki team rider, gathered nine points at Donington, but missed out at Cadwell, only picking up a single point in the second leg. Both men are down in eighth place at the moment but with five rounds still to go anything could happen.

Completing the top ten are Chris Guy and Australian Jeff Sayle, tying on nine points each. Guy didn't score at Donington but had two very good rides at Cadwell on his Yamaha, chasing Haslam much of the way. Jeff Sayle is back in Britain again after a short absence, and so far has only failed to score in one of the four legs.

But apart from these top eleven riders, Mallory has attracted a first class entry — all of whom are capable of springing a few surprises.

Of the old guard there's John Newbold, Stan Woods and Barry Ditchburn, all fast enough to win or at least get up there in the points. Of the new boys there's Mitsui's Dave Dean, Steve May and Steve Henshaw — all getting faster with every race and already the stars of tomorrow.

All in all it should be a very exciting day's racing — enjoy it!



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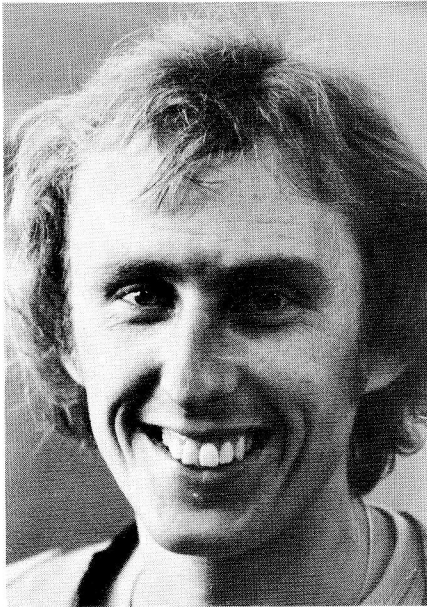
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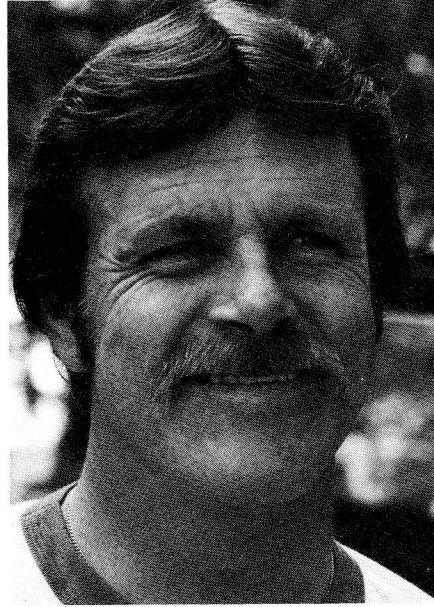

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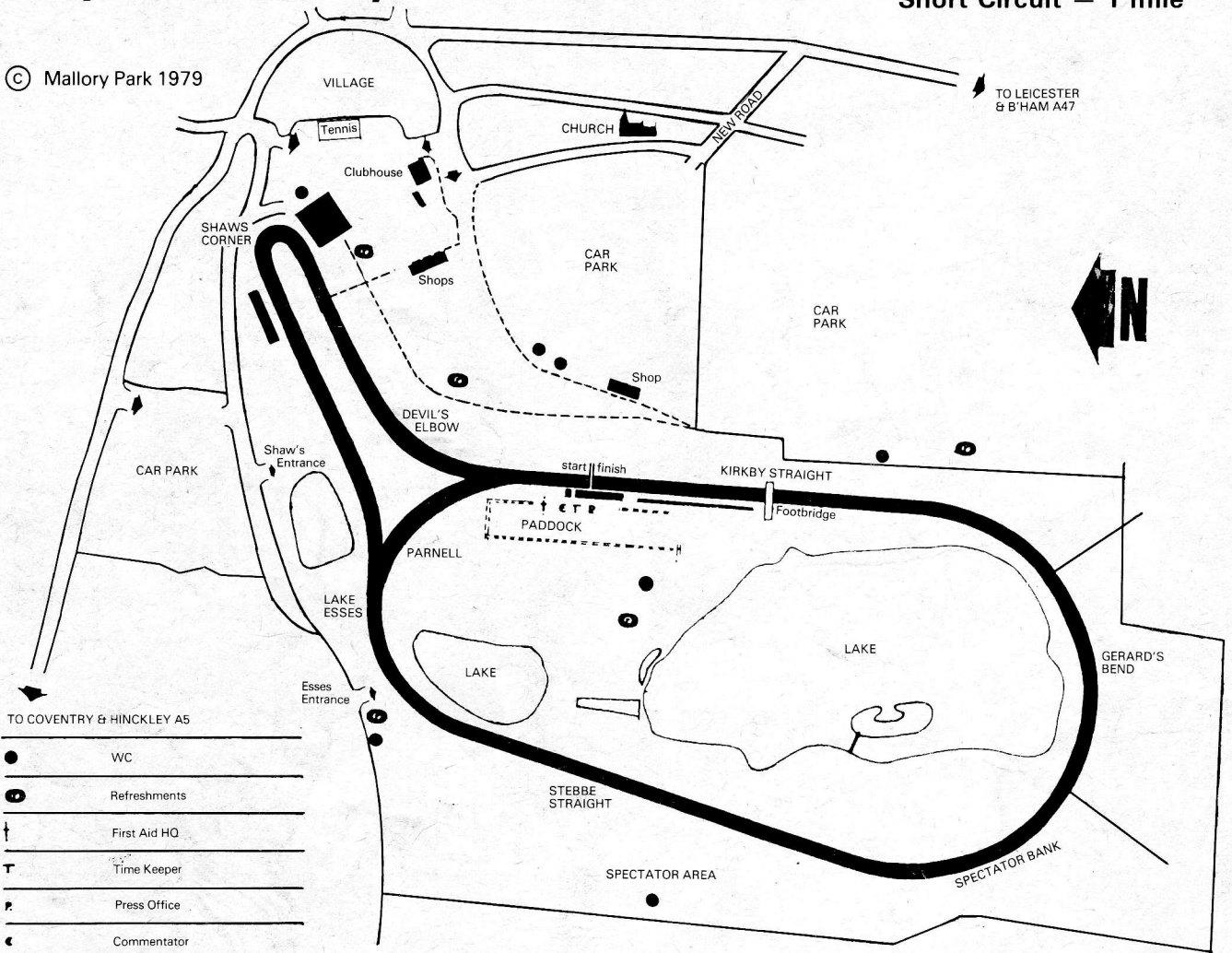
