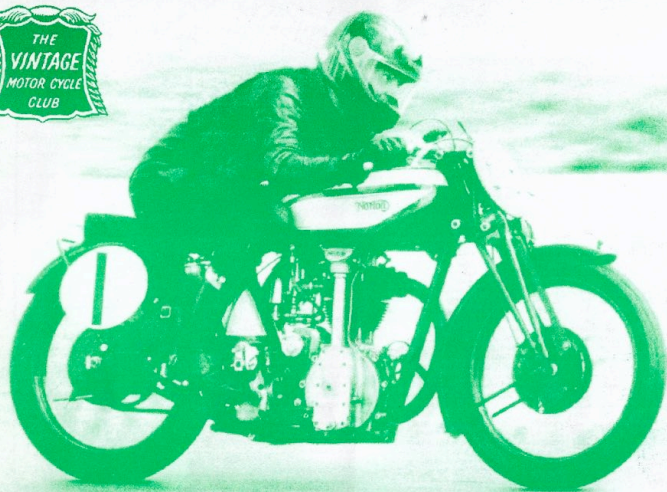
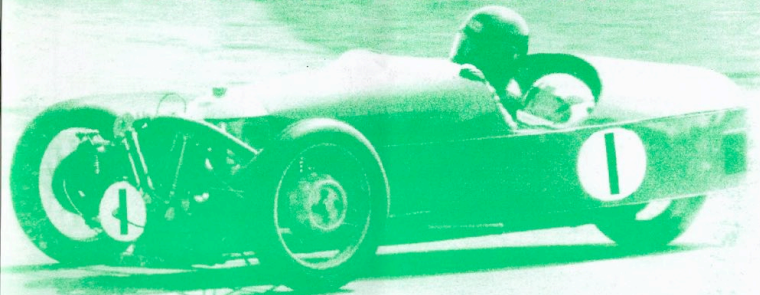

The racing season seems to start earlier and end later each year. However, Easter has always been the traditional opener and so it is with great delight that we welcome you to Mallory Park for the first round of the Historic Racing Championships. It is usually a meeting of mixed emotions as those on the ball take an early season advantage over those teams who, shall we say, were not quite so productive over winter and find themselves today without a bike ready!

There have been a few changes over the winter months, too. The big news being the introduction of a Gold Star Championship, which runs an open invitation to the G.S.O.C., and all Goldie riders. The Gold Stars already have their own Club Championship and the Historic Championship is intended to compliment it by means of races at different tracks, i.e. Mallory today.

The rules are simple.....a Goldie power unit.....end of rules. This means you may well see machines with fairings, disc brakes, Featherbed, Seeley, Metisse chassis and more besides, line-up alongside the Historics today.

The idea is the brainchild of 1997 Jim Lidgate Memorial 350 Champion, Stefan Radakovic, who will also be out on the nimble red 350. You will be forgiven for confusion on this one, for as well as Stefan, Duncan Walmsley, Martin Page and Dave Longstreth (making a welcome return after a few seasons lay off) will all be running identical, Roy Shearwood built 350s. So with a warm welcome to the Goldie Club Members here today, it promises to be a great series.

Another class to watch is the G S Fabrications Three-wheeler, for 1998 sees mini rear wheels allowed into the class, with 16" wheels prevailing up front. Who knows, perhaps this may see the appearance of someone who can genuinely give the Tuer Morgan a run for its money. Bill and Maggie will naturally be out there defending their championship, and the No.1 plate in the Richard Adams Photography Champion as will Roley Mettam with the ever immaculate Mogvin, the Scitsu of Phil Biggadyke, and who can think of the three wheelers without the venerable "Blue Fox" Triumph outfit of father and son teamsters John and Dave Fox. Let us hope we see some new faces out there, too.

In their 50th Anniversary year, the Bantams will be out in force, going for the Shuttleworth Trophy in their feature race and flat out to humble the heavy metal in the Chiltern Systems Specials Class. With this category going from strength to strength, it has been split into two groups- Up to 500cc and 501 to Unlimited- all out together should make the timekeepers earn their keep!

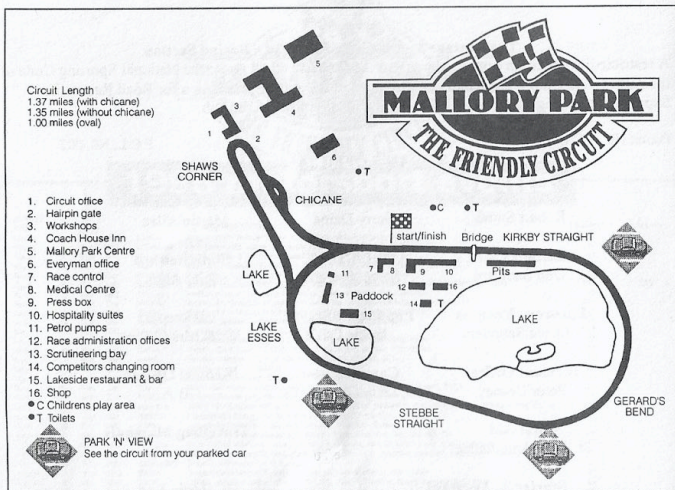

Senior Champion and current No. 1 plate holder is Tim Jackson. He reckoned on a 7R mounted Junior challenge for this year, but with Doug Jones back on for a full season aboard the Harry Whitehouse Manx, it is hoped that Tim will defend the Senior class on that wonderful, all conquering, Summerfield Norton.

A new face to the 500cc class is John McMahon, out for the first time on another Whitehouse Manx. In the Tuers Garage pre'35, Ian Bain will be pitting his CS1 Norton against Merv Stratford's amazing Ridges, trying to turn the tables on last year, whilst keeping the Guthrie Manx ahead of the allcomers in the O.B.M. pre'49, and an eye on the handicap for the Champion of Champions which he so nearly retained last year.

Langham Engineering are back with the sidecars and proprietor Robin Williamson, will be anxious to retain his trophy from '97 with the big Manx outfit. Lortim Consultants stay with the 250s and J T Fabrications are behind the Unlimited class again, so it all looks good for 1998.
