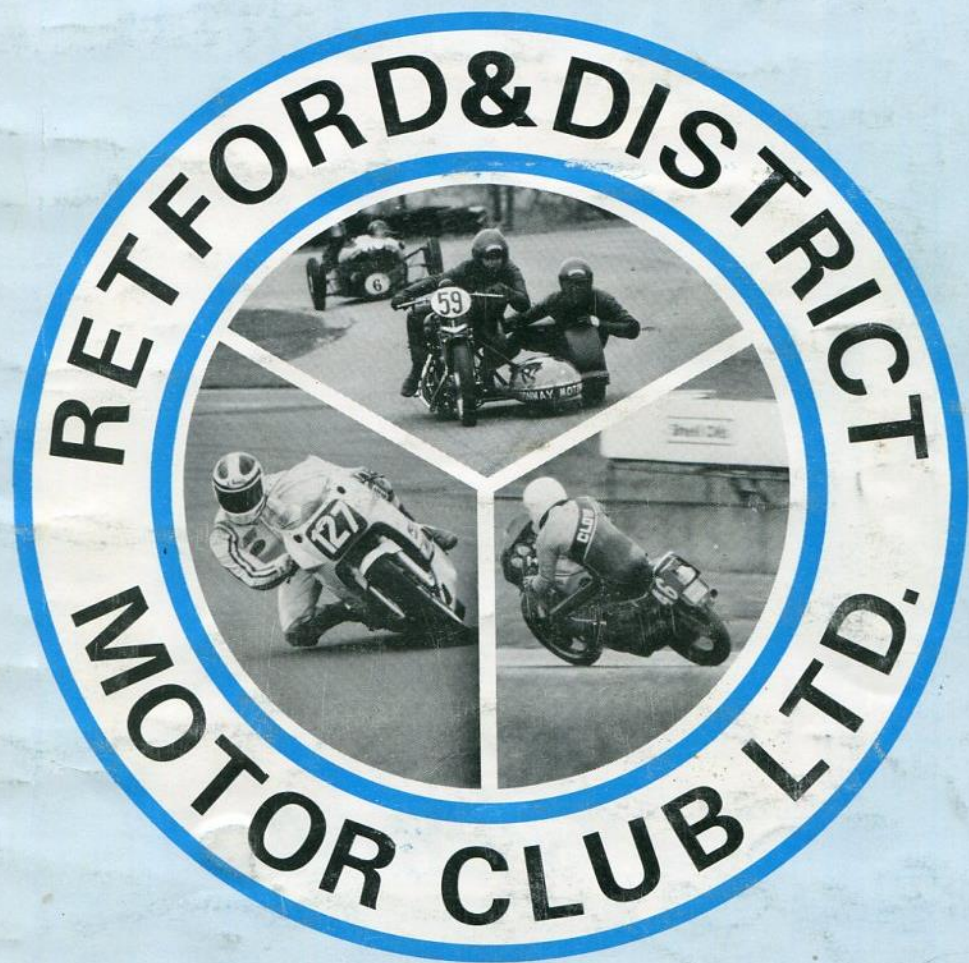

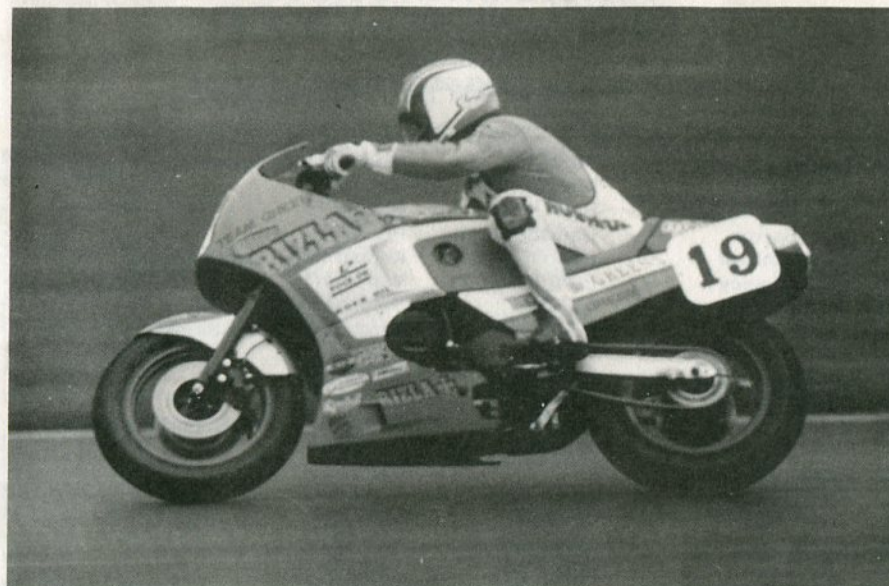

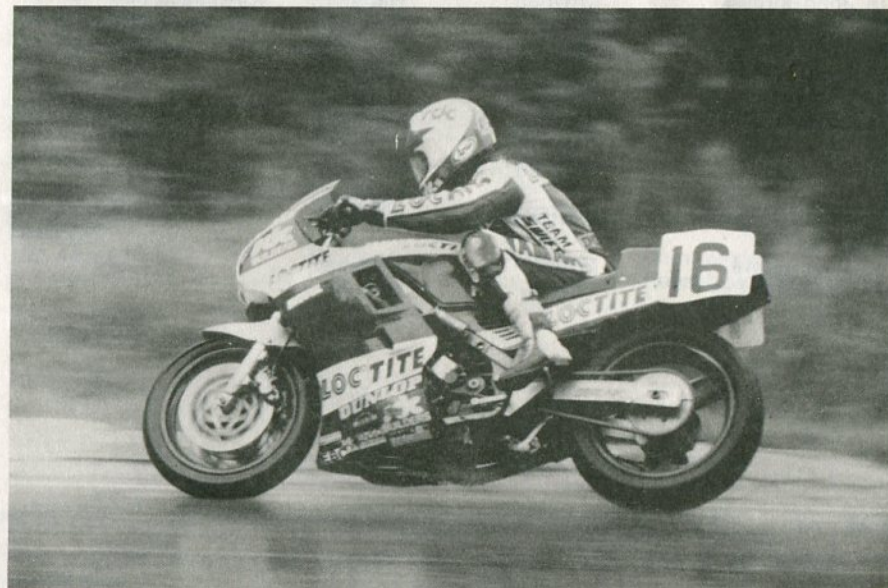

PROGRAMME NOTES

The third round of Europe's premier historic racing championships sees the battle for points as tight as ever. In the 500cc class, 1986 champion Dave Pither, on a Seeley owned by Hinckley butcher Mick Taberer, is one point ahead of Yorkshireman Mike Dowkes. Dowkes rides the Weslake-powered Seeley built by sponsor Roger Titchmarsh, and two seasons of hard work are getting the twin on top form — a possible winner today. And always a fast man at Mallory is John Cronshaw on the Unity BSA Gold Star, winner of the last round at Brands Hatch and just back from a successful visit to compete at Amaroo Park in Australia. Pither 25 points, Dowkes 24, Cronshaw 23 — tight stuff!

Graham Godward leads the 350 battle, which is dominated by the slim Italian Aermacchi singles. But David Dearden is back in contention after missing the last round and is one of the fastest men around Mallory. If Scotsman Joey Mulholland makes the long haul south with his rare two stroke Greeves 'Oulton', expect some surprises — he beat all the four strokes at Brands Hatch.

Les Trotter on the TR250 Suzuki leads the 250s, with GP runner Dennis Batchelor close behind on his four stroke Aermacchi. Dark horse is Martin Studer on his Greeves — immaculately turned out and ridden very hard.

Today's round is sponsored by Controlled Flame Boilers of Hitchin, and managing director Martin Orgee is competing in both 350 and 500 classes. Nice to have a sponsor that's interested in the sport!

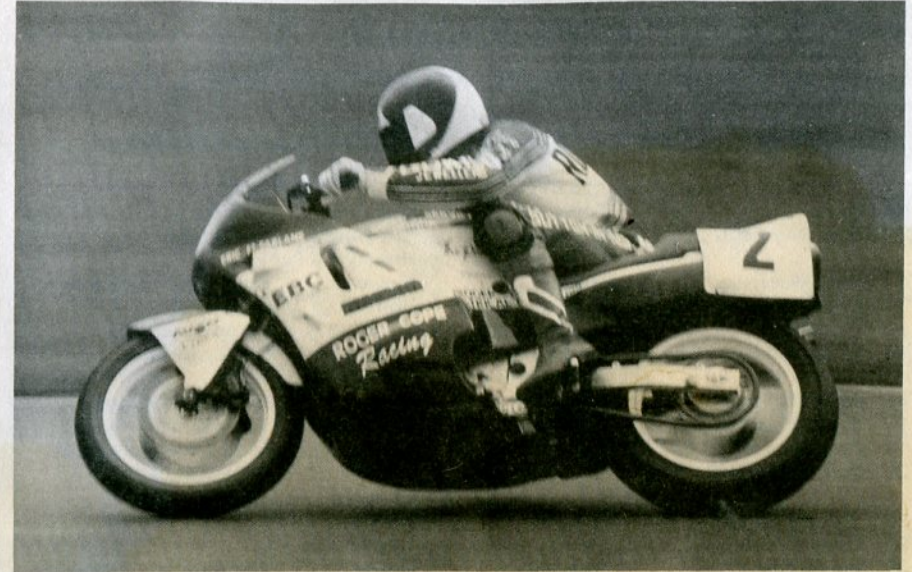

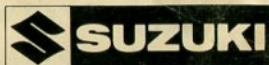
