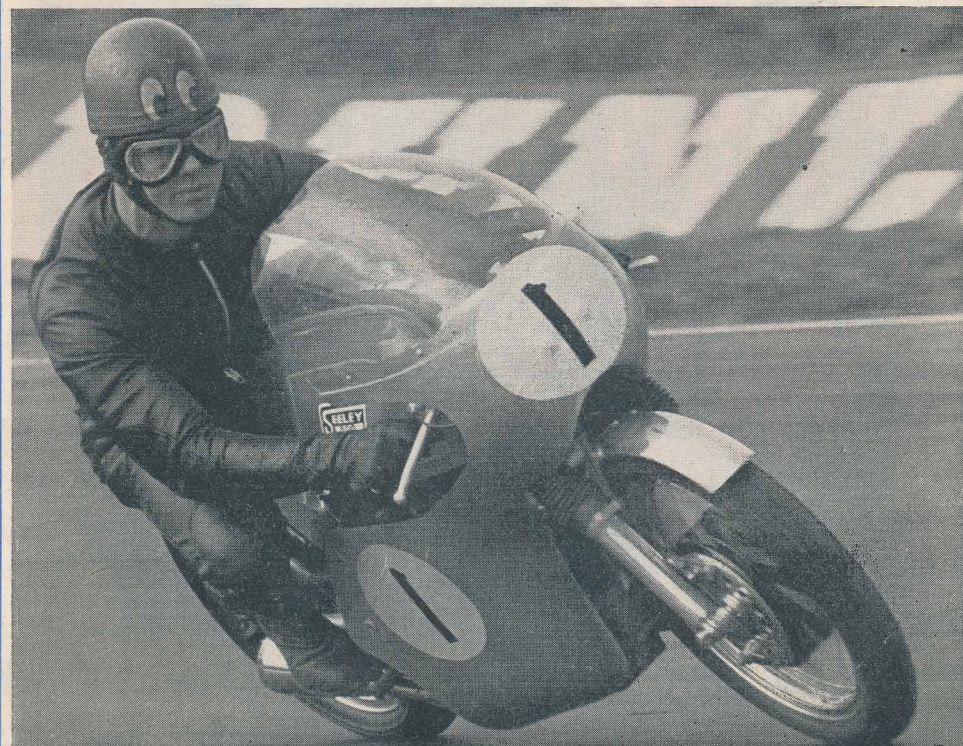

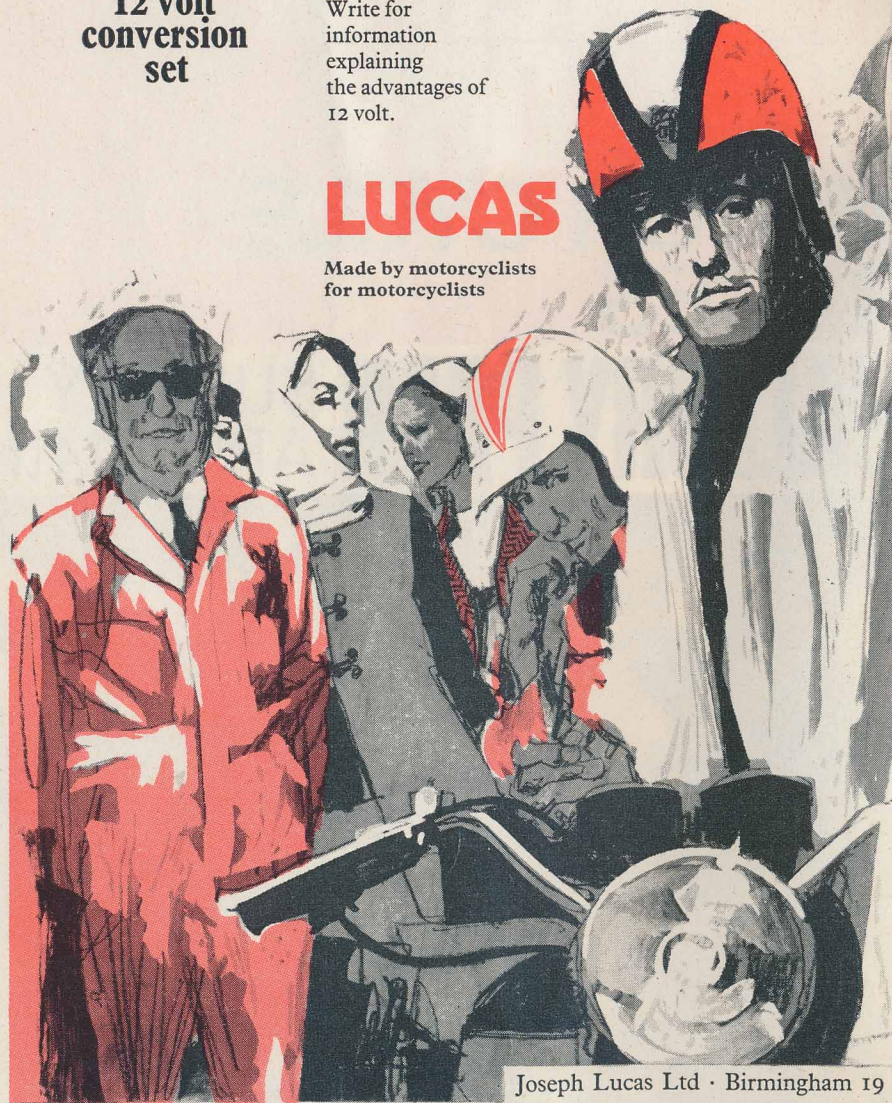

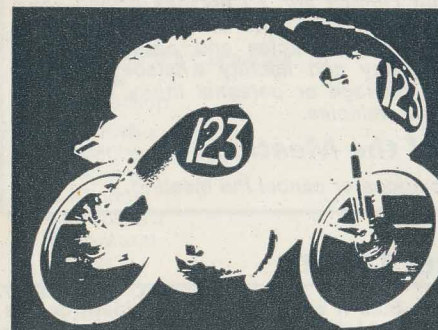

HOW FAST WILL IT GO?

Did you know that practising facilities exist at Mallory Park for members of car and motor-cycle clubs to test their machines on certain Saturdays ?

The cost is £2 10s. per car and driver (15s. for each additional driver), £1 10s. per solo motor-cycle driver and £1 10s. per three-wheeler driver (10s. for passenger). You will need a current driving licence, a crash helmet and, if you are a motor cyclist, leathers or a barbour's suit, goggles and gloves. Drivers of open cars will also need either goggles or a vizor, and all headlamps must be taped.

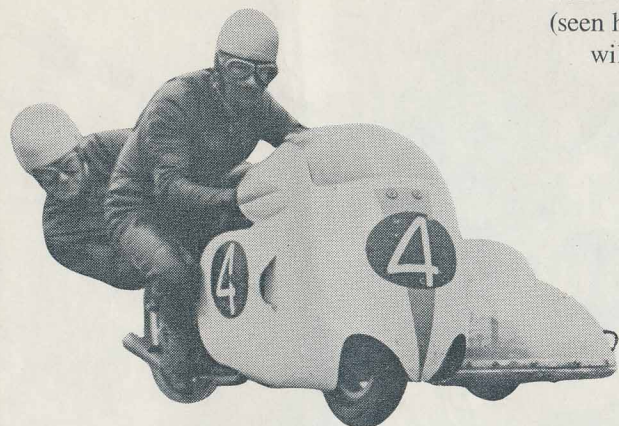

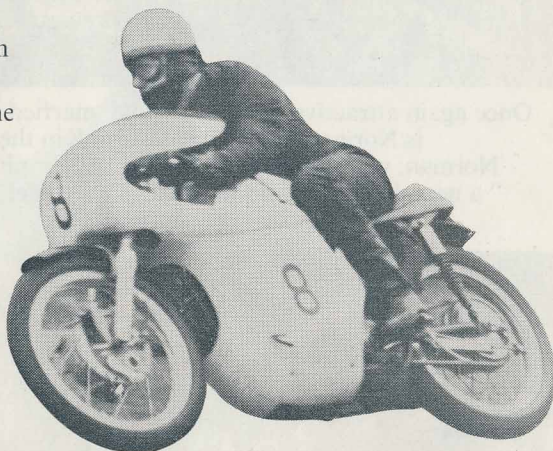


One of Britain's most experienced riders, Dave Croxford from Ruislip, Middlesex, will be going all out for a win today.

Chris Vincent, from Northampton, one of the world's best riders, has B. Burt as his sidecar passenger on the 654 B.S.A./Wats.



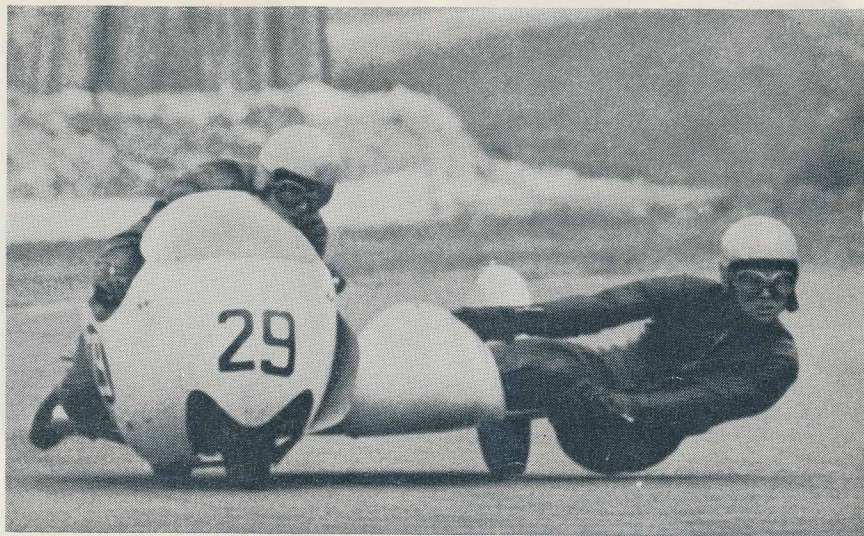

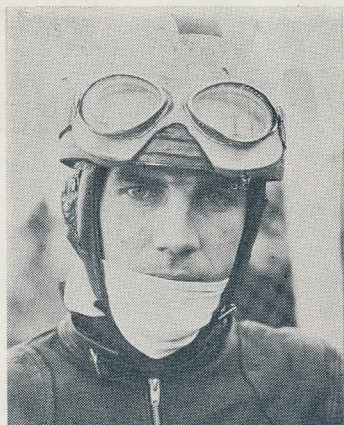

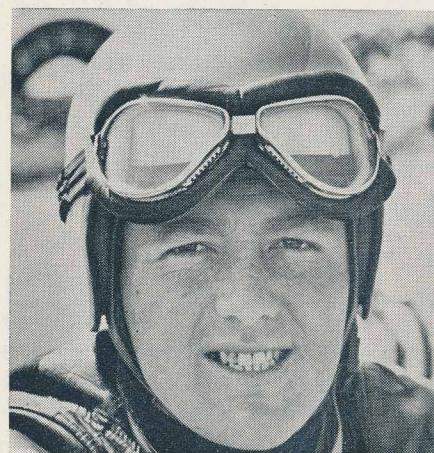
