



The nearest I have come to racing was owning a mid 50s 350cc Gold Star, in Clubman's trim in the late 50s, just prior to doing my National Service. Unfortunately because of the pay it had to go (how many time have we heard this).

Anyway lets have a really good day's racing and hope the horrible weather that has been around recently has cleared away and start the season with some fine weather for a change.
