

# Keen Racing expected in fourth round of British Championships

To-day sees the fourth round of the Castrol sponsored British Championships with four out of five of the current champions out to retain their titles, but only three of the current leaders in action. Dave Croxford, 500 c.c. champion and 350 c.c. class leader and Alan Barnett 500 c.c. class leader having opted for other week-end meetings. Barnett was also down to take on Robin Duffty in the second of the match races in the B.P.-Bill Ivy Silver Helmet Match Race series. At Barnett's suggestion the prize money for to-day's meeting plus the retainer until the post T.T. event here on 14th June, will be paid to June Andrew as a token to her husband Mick, who was so tragically killed in a road accident a few weeks ago. This popular rider will be sadly missed around the circuits. Mick was to have been to-day's challenger and all racing fans will share our sympathy for Mick's widow and his family and we hope that the fund that has been started for his young daughter, Kym, will be well supported. Donations should be made to the Mick Andrew Fund, National Westminster Bank, South Lambeth Road, Stockwell, London, S.W.8.


There is little doubt that today's races will be hotly contested and after Charles Mortimer's fine showing in the recent West German Grand Prix he will be out to get back to the top of the 125 c.c. table. At the moment he has 30 points while Barry Sheene has 36, behind them but not really in touch are Fred Launchbury, Andrew Manship, Ron Hackett, and Austin Hockley in that order but the race on paper looks like a match between the leading contenders for the title.

In the 250 c.c. class Derek Chatterton has a two point lead over 1969 champion Dave Browning and Malcolm Uphill, the latter, however, is not listed for to-day's race but Steve Machin and Tony Rutter are, and on his present form Tony could well go to the top. Charles Mortimer and Clive Offer will have other ideas as a win

could put either of them in a very strong position.


With Croxford away Tony Rutter also has a chance to take over the lead in the 350 c.c. class, he is only 12 points down and a win here will give him another 15. Derek Chatterton, Martin Carney, Pat Mahoney and Mortimer will all be out to improve their own positions, anyway, the situation at the top is very open. Not so in the 500 c.c. class where Barnett has an 18 point lead over Peter Williams who may well narrow the gap before the next round. Pat Mahoney is the nearest challenger to these two but such riders as Barry Ditchburn, John Taylor, Charlie Sanby, Bob Heath and Percy Tait will all be having their say in the matter and the final here promises to be a real scorcher.

Chris Vincent and his partner Keith Scott have been having a great season and although missing one round are still at the top of the table by the slender margin of three points from his old rival Peter

Not in the points table so far but always great performers at Mallory are Norman, Fred and Roy Hanks while the ex-Greenwood Mini in the hands of Andrew Chapman can always spring a surprise if it is on full song and keeps out of trouble from the back of the grid. That is the news on the chief contenders for championship honours but there is still the 20 lap race for Production Machines which looks like being fought out between Brian Steenson, Barry Ditchburn, Ray Knight and Ted Wallace but there are many others who could upset this prediction. Let us hope that you see and enjoy a fine day's sport and take care on the way home.


