


NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

This constant hard pursuit was probably the reason why towards the end the bike got a bit nervous and started smoking. Smoking being a bad habit, I thought I'd better put it in the garage to cool down for a while.

In 1986 I fetched out the Twin (another AJS of course), its first outing being at Brands Hatch in June. Several comments were made about the handling and the way the machine seems to jump about, although being at one with the machine I didn't seem to notice this too much.

1987 saw my first full season on the Twin, and overall I achieved a fourth in the 501-unlimited Tudor Motorcycle Championship. An added bonus was when I attended the Annual Racing Dinner and Awards Presentation, where to my surprise I was awarded the Arthur Whitehouse Cup for the Best AJS.

Enough of me and my small achievements though, and on to the world of Vintage Racing. From the start I have found everyone all to willing to give me a helping hand, both physically and technically. They really are a great crowd, so come on — there's no reason to sit there as I used to, day-dreaming about the possibility of taking part. Find yourself a machine, and come and join us - like me, you'll never regret it, especially if you are lucky enough to have a good back-up team, such as I have with my wife Elaine and daughter Jayne.

Well, that's all for now, and the Morris Team would like to wish you all every success in the coming season.


