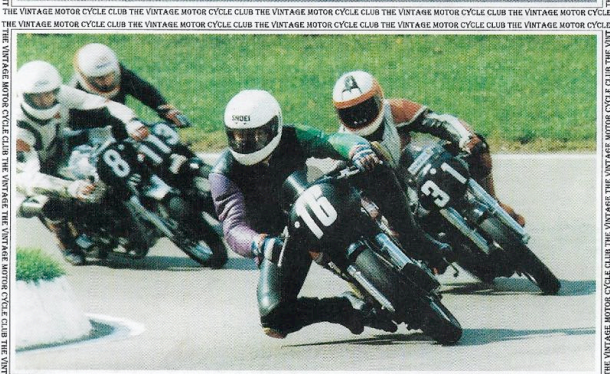

Phil was a familiar face at Historic Race Meetings, he missed only a few meetings in his thirty years as a rider, reporter and auto jumbler. As a pre war amateur he rode an O.K. Supreme, New Imperial and H.R.D machines and achieved good results at the Manx Grand Prix and at home circuits. After the war he went professional on the 'Continental Circus' whilst riding AJSs and Norton machines, he came second in the Manx on an AJS and came second in the 1000cc Clubmans TT on a Vincent HRD. After he retired he rode vintage HRD JAP and post vintage Nortons. Phil was also a past President of the Vintage Motor Cycle Club and worked in many positions and was the Library Research Officer at the time of his death at the age of 83. Phil leaves his wife Annette who he met when racing on the Continent where she became his mechanic and secretary and later the Vintage Club Insurance Secretary and a trophy has been donated in his memory. He will be sadly missed by all.

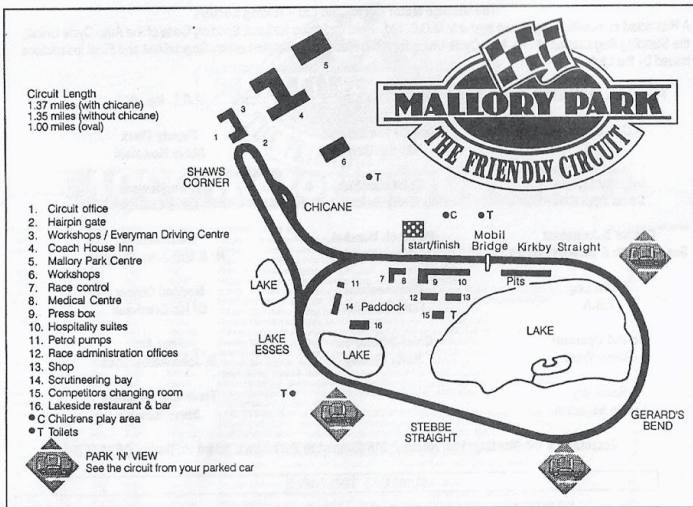
