Speed and Novelty for Today's Motor Cycle 'Derby'

"Master of Mallory" takes on all comers, by Victor Winstone

WITH the "Master of Mallory" and "King of Brands" titles already tucked under his leathers, Britain's new motor cycle ace Dave Croxford will be out to win more honours in the Derby Cup £1,000 races at Mallory Park today, when he is entered in all four events for solo machines.

But the brilliant 27-year-old from Ruislip, Middlesex, will be up against stiff and, in some cases, novel competition at this popular and well-supported meeting with capacity entries for every one of the 12 races.

Mounted on Bultacos from the Frank Sheene stable in the 125 and 250 c.c. events and on Oakley AJS and Matchless machines in the 350 and 500 c.c. classes, Croxford will be hard pressed by riders of the skill and experience of Pat Mahoney (Yamaha and Oakley AJS), Derek Chatterton (Mondial, Chat-Yamaha and Kawasaki), John Cooper (Padgett-Yamaha and Seeley), John Taylor (AJS and Kirby-Matchless) and Alan Barnett (Kirby-Metisse).

Debut of the Humber Crescent

Among an array of machines which includes names like Yamaha, Aermacchi, Norton, Metisse, BSA and Triumph, the entry of Londoner Peter Humber will claim a good deal of attention. His specially built frame houses a watercooled, three-cylinder, two-stroke Swedish marine engine of 499 c.c.

capacity. The Humber Crescent 3, as it is called, showed an encouraging turn of speed when it was tested at Brands Hatch and it could provide a major upset in the Senior race.

In fact, this 500 race is unrestricted (i.e., there is no lower capacity limit), so that some spritely tiddlers, like Chatterton's 257 c.c. Chat-Kawasaki, will be in hot pursuit of bigger fish in the form of Norton, AJS, Triumph and BSA entries over the 30-lap event.

Family Feuds

Three-wheel heats, building up to a final for the 18 fastest "drivers" will add some outstandingly skilful handling and the inevitable passenger acrobatics to a packed and varied day's racing.

In a near-benefit day for BSA machines combinations, the Hanks and Boddice families will forget filial loyalties in the battle for a share of the "Derby" prize money. But they will have to outpace Chris Vincent, Peter Brown and several other riders of note if they are to take the lion's share.

Worth a glance

Fred Hanks will be competing with his sons Norman and Roy, while the doyen of three-wheel riders, Bill Boddice, will do battle with his son Mick. And if some enthusiasts eyes are rivetted to those closely fought family feuds, others might well stray to Norman Hanks's passenger, Mrs. Rose Arnold. She and Gloria Atkinson, who crews for Cardiff rider Bobby Chapman, are well worth a glance!




