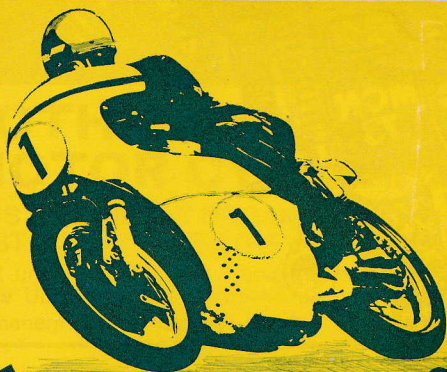

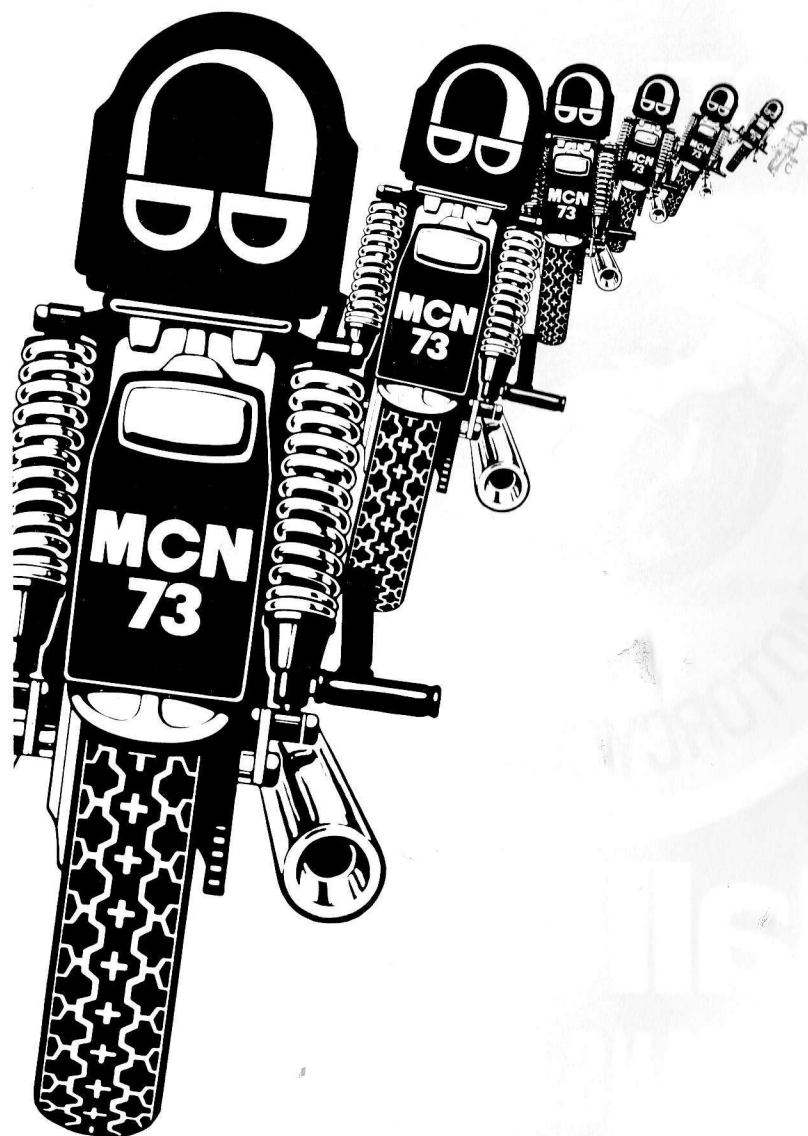

## Let Battle Commence

### Today's Rothmans contest is the start of something big

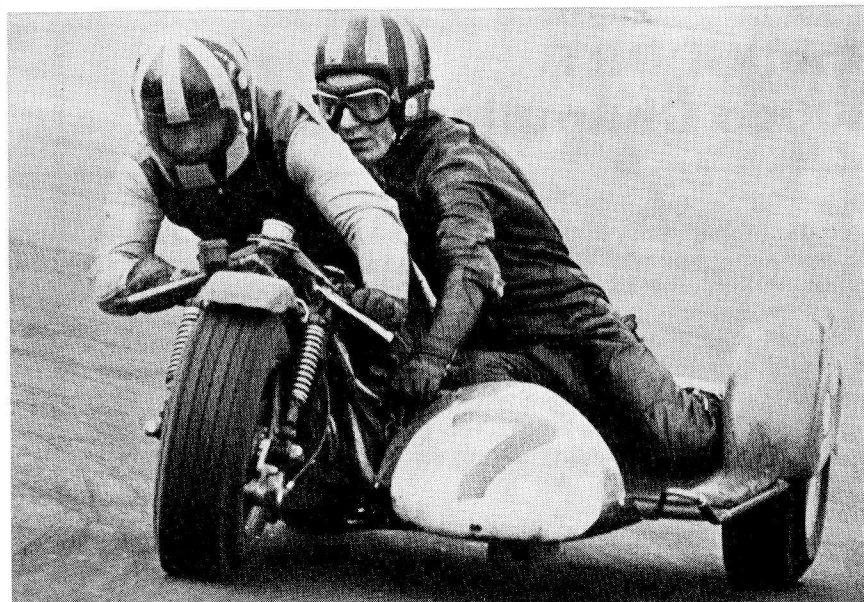
If the 750 watercooled three cylindered Suzuki appears on the line today—last minute doubt exists as to whether or not either of the two Suzuki (GB) machines will be ready in time—Barry Sheene must rank as one of the bravest riders in the world! Mallory Park is no place to unleash a potential of 100bhp as we witnessed last Easter; the corners arrive much too quickly and the much maligned "flexy flyer" doesn't always manage to corner as easily as some of the lesser capacity machines. Barry has a choice of two machines, one which is expected to arrive any moment direct from Hamamatsu in Japan, and one which Colin Seeley is preparing with a new frame. The Japanese delivery will be a completely new monster, hopefully with a revised frame layout, and will be identical to those being rushed to the United States in time for Daytona on March 11. If neither of the 750s appear, Barry will revert to a tube framed 500 Suzuki, again being prepared by Colin Seeley. Since it suffered



from grounding last year the engine has been lifted, the frame modified, and it is intended to replace the conventional spoked wheels with the magnesium variety which has just started to become the rage in two-wheeled sport. You may recall that Peter Williams was the first to present these to the public on a solo motor cycle. Alternatively, Seeley's "space framed" monocoque will also be available, already tested at Brands Hatch by both Barry and Pat Mahoney.

So although we may well be disappointed with the non-appearance of the new 750s both Barry and his co-rider in the Suzuki (GB) team, Stan Woods, will have plenty of quick machinery to choose from. Twenty-seven-year-old Stan, from Chester, turns full-time professional rider this year having previously hit the news under the Eddie Crooks banner. Having made headlines in a number of the important races, Stan has yet to achieve the big win. The closest he ever came to it was in winning the 500 class of last year's Production TT on Eddie's T500R Suzuki with a commendable average of 92.20 mph. He also led the 1968 250 Manx Grand Prix before retiring on the last lap. Both Barry and Stan are going to be formidable opposition for anyone today.

So we have a possible situation where Tony Jefferies and British 750 Champion Dave Potter may have the quickest of the 750 machines, Tony having retained his ex-works 750 three-cylinder Triumph which he has to keep fit himself, whereas Dave has the full backing of Vincent Davey and the Kuhn Norton team of enthusiasts, rarely seen without a smile! Dave was a commendable sixth on his last appearance here, beating Tony Jefferies. It is likely that he would have finished higher in the placings but suffered clutch



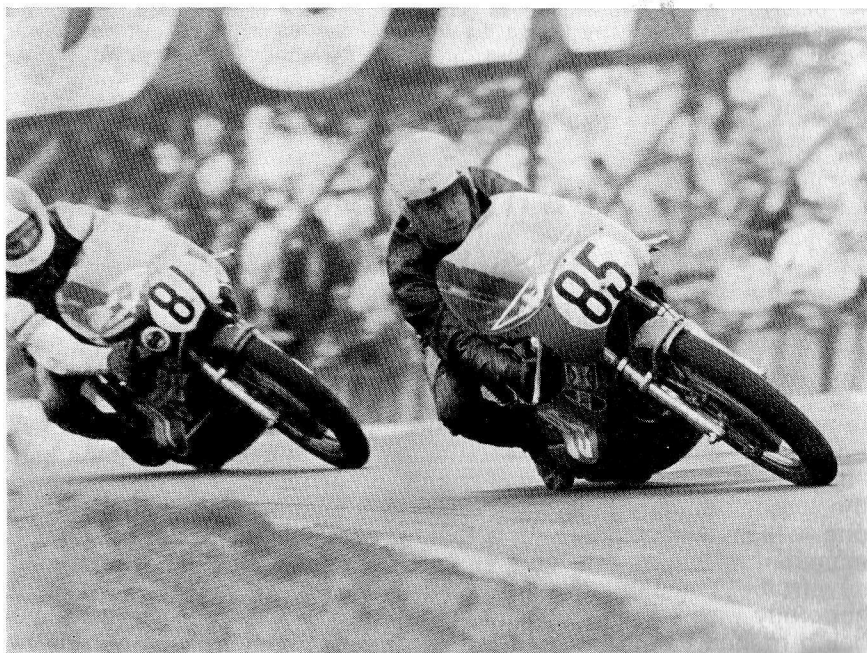

slip towards the end of the race. Tony was later detuned during the three-machine crash at Devil's Elbow so this will be his first race at Mallory since then.

British 125 and 250 Champion Steve Machin stands to upset many plans, since he is entered on his very fast 350 Yamaha in the Rothmans Trophy Race, along with such stalwarts as Barry Randle—500 class winner at this meeting last year — Tony Rutter, Alan Barnett, Charlie Sanby and Ireland's Tom Herron, making his first appearance here I believe. Riding with no. 29 affixed to his machine is Barry Ditchburn on Ted Broad's Yamahas. But do watch out for the machine with the 523 cc engine! Ted was the first to upset the apple cart by entering the 'til then closed ranks of the 500 class with a 354 cc Yamaha with shattered the opposition. Is this latest device about to destroy bigger reputations?

If you tend to favour sidecars more than solos then you should welcome the opportunity of seeing Norman Hanks in full cry once again in an attempt to defend his 1972 British Sidecar Championship. This may prove more difficult than it looks on paper as Mick Boddice is due to unleash the new Kawasaki powered BSA, the engine of which belonged to his lamented brother-in-law Dave Simmonds whose rise to stardom with the Kawasaki works team culminated in a World Championship win in 1969. Mick will be giving away a good number of cubic centimetres but the 500 engine should be capable of giving a good account of itself. George O'Dell, who gave late season promise last year, should provide the opposition along with Norman's brother Roy, Peter Williams and .....well your guess is as good as my own!

Whatever your taste is, today's sport should whet your appetite for the season ahead. JIM SWIFT.

# ShellSPORT 500cc Championship

The 500 c.c. motor cycle championship continues for 1973 under the new ShellSPORT title, with end-of-year prize money increased to £250. Eleven rounds at national and international meetings are to be staged at Brands Hatch, Mallory Park, Snetterton, and, for the first time, Oulton Park. All rounds will count for championship points on the 8-6-4-3-2-1 scale. The Champion at the end of the year will receive £150 and the runner-up £50. Third to fifth place men will earn £25, £15 and £10.

Future championship rounds: April 20, Brands Hatch; April 22, Mallory Park; April 23, Oulton Park; May 28, Brands Hatch; June 10, Mallory Park; August 5, Brands Hatch; August 26, Snetterton; August 27, Oulton Park; September 16, Mallory Park; October 7, Brands Hatch.



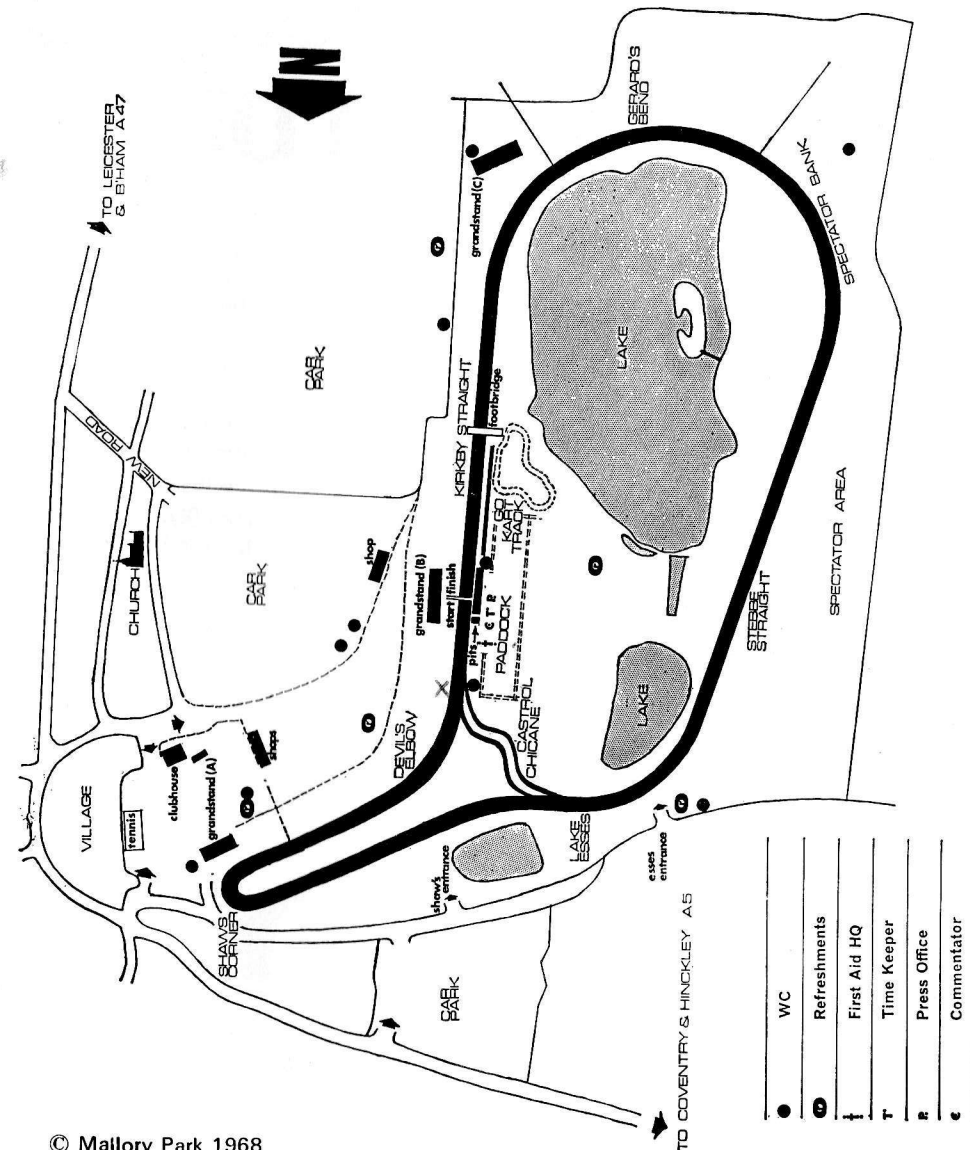
