

#### SHELL 500 cc CHAMPIONSHIP — 1972

The very popular and successful Shell 500 cc Motor Cycle Championship will be continued in its established form for 1972.

The 500 c.c. race at each of eight National and International Road Race meetings will count for points in the Championship on a scale of 8, 6, 4, 3, 2, 1 for the first six places.

At the end of the season, with all results counting, the rider with the highest total of points wins the Championship and receives the first prize of £100. The runner-up gets £50, third man £25, fourth £15 and fifth £10.



## **Rothmans National gets** Mallory season underway

#### Opening round of Shell 500 Championship

The opening of any racing season is a traditional Mallory Park occasion. Fans will, however, observe a marked visual difference when they look around their old haunts today for the march of speed has determined major alterations to the circuit. With Formula 2 and Formula 5000 cars reaching 130 m.p.h. on the straights, sleeper walls have replaced the all too flimsy earth banks, and tremendous care has been exercised in their siting and construction. Spectating facilities have suffered in a few areas, notably the Esses to Hairpin section, but we hope to overcome these problems shortly, if we have not done so by the time you read this.

Whatever the weather today's racing will warm people's hearts if not their vocal cords since the array of talent is such that close racing is assured. While we are still awaiting confirmation of Barry Sheene's entries at the time of writing, one look at the list will determine where the closest of the racing is going to come from. All last year the names of Steve Machin, Derek Chatterton, Barry Randle and Tony Rutter cropped up time and time again the only difference


being the variation of order. All Yamaha mounted they were regularly inseperable and at this particular meeting one can fully expect them to make the running whether or not Barry Sheene is amongst them to upset the battle order. At the Race of the Year last September, Barry Randle was second to Giacomo Agostini in the Junior final ahead of Barry Sheene, Mike Hailwood and Jarno Saarinen. It was a quiet unassuming ride which brought him precious little recognition at the time but I think there were few dissenters when he won a Grovewood Award.

The most successful of the foursome at Mallory has been British 350 c.c. Tony Rutter who has now landed a contract with Norton to ride the new 750. I doubt that we will see him in action guite so much now on the Yamahas particularly where his own interests clash with the works team but certainly he is no stranger to big capacity machines. Here however, he is on his familiar Yamahas and I don't doubt that his confidence has ever been better.

Neither Derek Chatterton nor Steve Machin have been out of the first six places much this year so we can confidently expect some


fine racing with little to choose between them.

The very popular and successful Shell 500 c.c. Championship opens at this first National event. Won last year by Jim Harvey the 500 class has had a very welcome revival since it's introduction and now provides some of the closest racing at any meeting. To quite a few people's obvious distaste, the scene is gradually being added to by the oversized, 354 c.c. Yamahas and, in the odd case by a 365! There are few stalwarts of the Manx and G.50 (although the latter is a rare bird these days) who readily accept these newcomers with enthusiasm! An interesting addition this year is the Difazio Suzuki with it's hub-center steering to be ridden by Brian Kemp. Although this form of steering is not entirely new, Brian is very happy to race it particularly as one of it's characteristics is to

allow for heavy braking when cornering, a facility which he hopes to put to great use in the months to come. Ron Chandler undoubtedly hopes to get the Kawasaki up amongst the leaders and Bob Heath will be striving hard to improve his April placing of fifth place in the final, his best of the year at Mallory. Ken Redfern and Tony Jefferies are amongst the big capacity runners with Ken

unfamiliarly mounted on a B.S.A.

In the sidecar class we have a welcome return of Orrie Salter, Australian champion from 1968 to 1971 who will be thrown in off the deep end when he comes up against the "terrible threesome" of Roy, Norman and Fred Hanks plus Mick Boddice who I seem to recall cut his first teeth at Mallory Park riding an Ariel Arrow in the paddock! The new 750 BBS—obviously Bill Boddice Special leaves me to hope that Mick has a faster, reliable outfit for this year as certainly his prowess as a rider is very little tapped as yet and only needs a firm boost to set him off to success. Mick was third behind Chris Vincent and Roy Hanks at the Race of the Year in September so I cannot see that this race can be anything other than a Midlands dominated affair. Even Orrie Salter, resplendent with a Honda 4, is passengered by Eddie Bulgin who, many years ago, was Bill Boddice's passenger. Eddie is probably still the most experienced "ballast" of all time!

Whatever your interest, whether two or four stroke, multi or single, solo or sidecar, there is plenty to interest you today. We all hope the weather shows an improvement because the cold wet conditions spoilt an otherwise excellent meeting last year, mourned as much by riders as spectators and officials. There is no great enjoyment in riding in such conditions and riders rarely give of their best. So if spirits lag a little do give them some encouragement—if only

to warm yourselves!


