

## Globe-Trotting Grand Prix Riders Star in today's meeting

This annual meeting is always staged as a climax to the finest road racing fixture in the world, the T.T. for it enables the less fortunate enthusiasts who could not get to the Island to see in action, some of the established stars of Grand Prix racing and competing against our home based short circuit riders. The riders have little respect for big names and welcome the opportunity to compete against them and provided that there are no absentees due to lack of machinery or unfortunate mishaps during the past week we should be ensured of a great afternoon's racing racing.

We extend a warm welcome not only to our regular spectators but to those who may be visiting Mallory Park for the first time and with a hope that they will go away with a fine impression of a sport which, while getting little National acclaim has a world wide following and produces a breed of men whose enthusiasm, courage and sportsmanship is second to none in any sphere.

Our welcome to the riders is no less sincere, particularly for the effort that many have made to get here after a busy and sometimes hectic week in the Isle of Man.

Two current World Champions Dave Simmonds (125 cc) and Australian Kel Carruthers (250 cc) will be in action and as it is every riders ambition to beat the best they will be in for some tough competition, with Carruthers getting particular attention from that colourful and popular Spaniard Santiago Herrero, riding his very fast Ossa, Rod Gould and Phil Read. Herrero who was third in the 1969 World Championship is currently on top of the table, Gould is second while the Australian is close in touch in fourth position.

This by the way, before the T.T. These riders will be expected to make the running in the events for which they are entered but make no mistake they will not have things all their own way for our 'regulars' will be asking for, and giving no quarter.

The 125 cc race looks a good thing for Dave Simmonds but Londoner Barry Sheene has been having such a run of success that he could well spring a surprise. Currently topping the National table, Barry will come into the reckoning together with Steve Machin, Derek Chatterton and Dave Browning who head the 250 cc table, in that order.

These three should come to grips with the World ranked riders in the 250 cc final and will also have such men as John Cooper, Tony Rutter and Paul Smart to contend with.

John Cooper had a great day at the recent Brands Hatch meeting winning both the 350 cc race and the Evening News International on the same machine and he is always a difficult customer to beat on this circuit. He should be the one to watch in the 350 cc final

which should include most of the riders already mentioned in addition to Alan Barnett, Ray Pickrell, Peter Williams and Rex Butcher on the Yamaha entered by that very sporting and popular lady Mrs. Nell lvy.

It is always an interesting past-time reviewing races before the 'off' but thank goodness our men are a bit more predictable than the riders of horses. One young rider who is really making the grade is Tim Kirby's protege Jim Harvey who, having established himself at the top in Club events put up his best performance yet when finishing sixth in the Evening News International.

The 500 cc final brings riders together for the fifth round of the Shell Championship in which Bob Heath has a point advantage

over Pat Mahoney. Within striking distance are John Cooper, Peter Williams, Paul Smart and Ivan Hackman. Any one of these is a potential winner of to-day's race. Smart won the previous round and is in great form at the moment.


There are conflicting views on the B.P.—Bill Ivy Silver Helmet Match Race Championship series, due perhaps to the fact that in the first round Dave Croxford had a shocking start and Alan Barnett was a runaway winner. Robin Duffty takes Alan on to-day and with a clutch start it could be a more interesting race and the winner is anybody's guess.

The 250 cc-1000 cc final should be the 'Race of the Day' with a glorious battle between 350 cc machines and a horde of 500s and 750s with perhaps, the little 'uns having the advantage on the short circuit.

When Chris Vincent is in form he simply plays with the opposition and in recent weeks he has been doing just that which confirms his recent quote "only first place is good enough for me".

The Hanks family of Fred, Roy and Norman in addition to Peter Brown will be amongst those trying to put a stop to the Vincent run of successes so the sidecar final should wind up a fine afternoons racing which we hope you will thoroughly enjoy.


