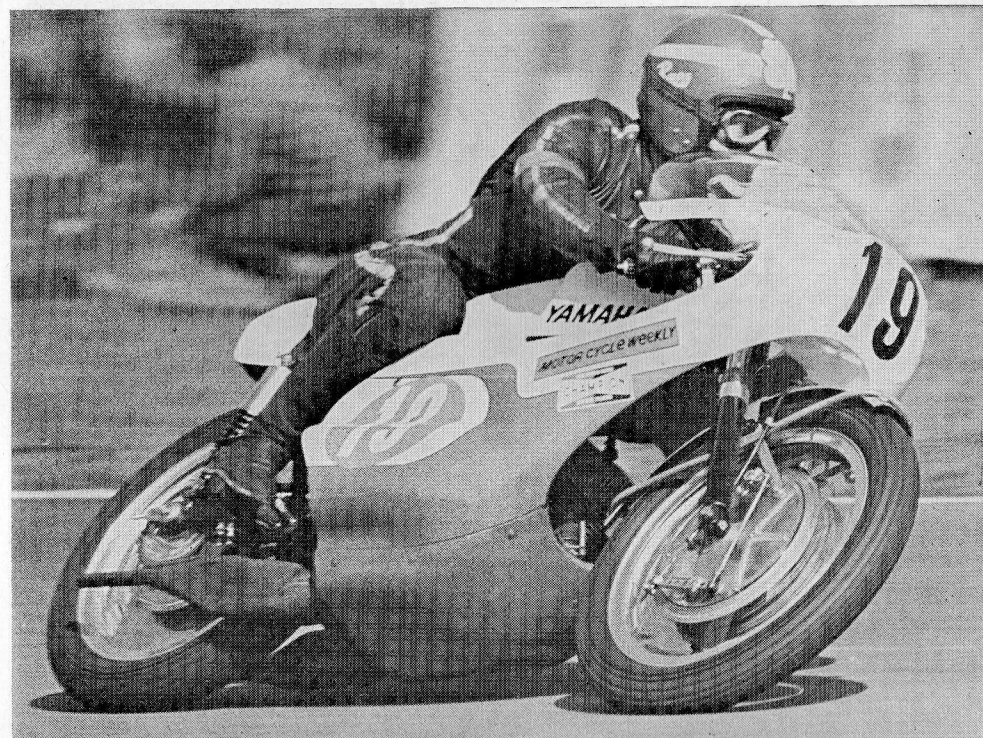
## SPECIAL CHALLENGE MATCH

## You Name 'em — We've got 'em !

It's post-T.T. day at Mallory Park and they're all here—double world champion (350 c.c. as well as 500 c.c.) Giacomo Agostini from Italy with his M.V. Agustas, double champion. Phil Read (125 c.c. and 250 c.c. sidecar world champion Helmut Fath from Germany, Gyula Marsovsky from Switzerland, sidecar race Georg Auerbacher from Germany with a B.M.W., Alberto Pagani from Italy with 350 Aermacchi and 500 Linto machines, Frank Perris (who now lives in South Africa) who is making a great come-back with a 250 c.c. Suzuki, that hard-riding Aussie, Kel Carruthers, and stay-at-home British 500 c.c. champion Dave Croxford, who doesn't like the long Isle of Man circuit.

With over £2,200 prize money at stake—including £100 for the winner, £80 for the second man and £60 for third in all the main events—racing is certain to be keen. Even the sometimes neglected 125 c.c. class has £80 for the winner

and cash awards scaling right down to the 15th finisher.

First name to catch the eye is that of the man who will be wearing the No. 1 racing plates, double world champion and new Brands Hatch lap record holder Phil Read. Phil, Luton-born but now resident in Guernsey, C.I., where he runs a flourishing marine engine agency, is entered for every solo class, with Yamahas of 125 c.c., 250 c.c. and 350 c.c. capacity and the 498 c.c. Read/Weslake. The clashes between Read and "Ago" in the Junior race and the 250-1,000 c.c. event should be quite something.

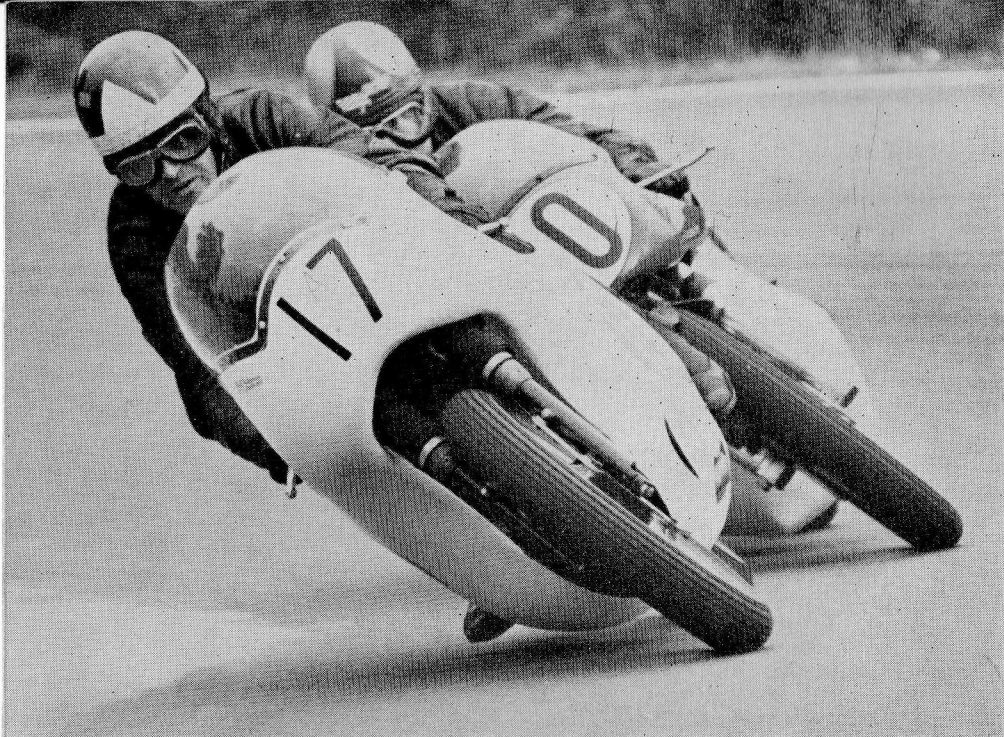
John Cooper, from Derby—out of the T.T. with a broken collarbone—will, we hope be fit to race the 250 c.c. Yamaha and 500 c.c. Seeley on which he has been entered by Walter Wragg of Chesterfield.

Dave Croxford has a pair of Seeleys and his partner from the South London Gus Kuhn camp, Mick Andrew, has two Seeleys plus a 750 c.c. Norton Commando.

Above: The new 'Master of Mallory,' Rodney Gould from Banbury, astride his 348 c.c. Yamaha. (Photograph by John Stoddart).

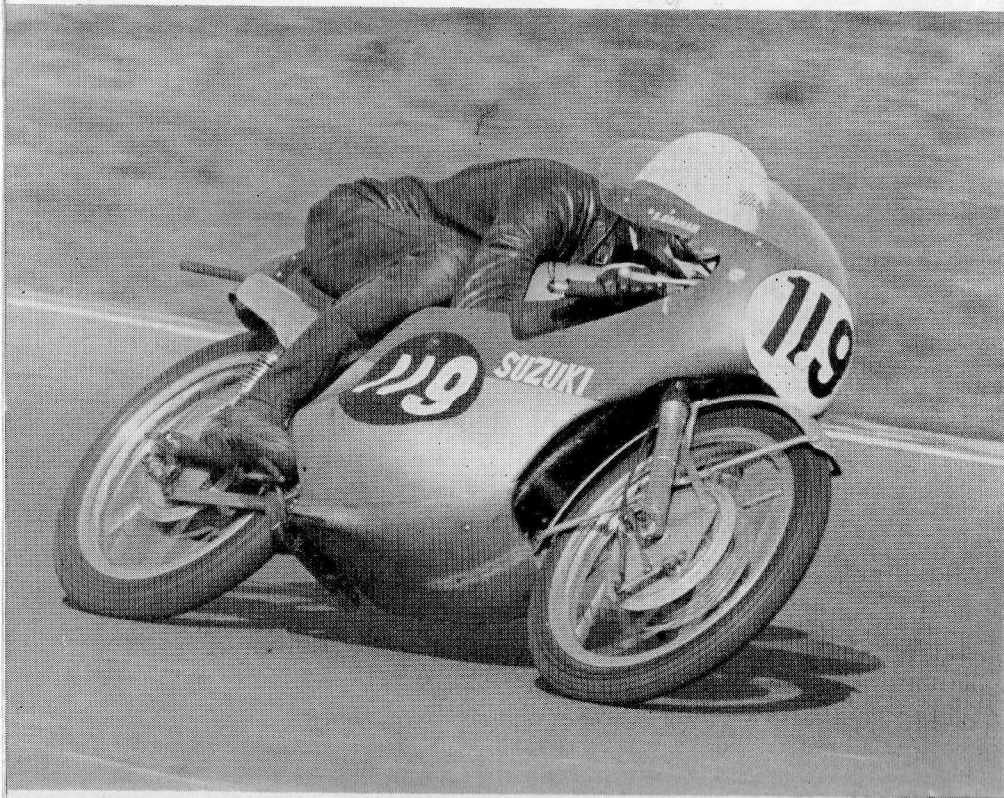

Also Seeley mounted for the 350 c.c. and 500 c.c. classes is Ron Chandler from Sevenoaks, Kent, sponsored by Reg Kirby. Alan Barnett from Iver, Bucks, British 350 c.c. champion and the only rider enjoying the full back of Reg's brother, Tom Kirby, this season, is also a two-machine man — with the special Kirby Metisse models.

Coventry motorcycle tester Percy Tait has just one machine to worry about, his impressively fast 500 c.c. Triumph; and another ace one-bike man is Stuart Graham from Nantwich, cheekily pitting his little 125 c.c. ex-works Suzuki against the big 750s as well as machines in its own class.

Rod Gould from Banbury, new "Master of Mallory" and now outright record holder on Ireland's North-West "200" circuit, has the 350 c.c. Yamaha with which he outspeeded all the "500s" on that occasion, and a 250 c.c. Yamaha as well. Dan Shorey, from the same home town as Gould, has a 350 c.c. Aermacchi and a 500 c.c. Matchless. Like Geoff Barry from Derby he is sponsored by Nottingham enthusiast Ted Oakley.

Although Ray Pickrell has an Aermacchi, it will be in the 500 c.c. and 1,000 c.c. events that this very polished Harrow rider should really shine — on the Dunstall machines with which he has been so consistently successful.

Marsovsky with the Italian Linto, Tony Smith with 500 c.c. and 650 c.c. factory B.S.A.s, Barry Randle with a pair of Nortons, Steve Jolly—entered by Frank

Higley on Seeleys—and John Taylor, Kent rider of a Matchless, are just a few more for the big-machine line-up.

Carruthers has works Aermacchis for the 125 c.c. and 350 c.c. classes and, like Pat Mahoney, also has a 382 c.c. Aermacchi with which to challenge the "500s".

Dave Simmonds from Stanwell has his fast 350 c.c. Kawasaki as well as a 125 c.c. version. Gordon Keith from South Africa has a 125 c.c. Mondial, Yamahas for the middle classes and a 500 c.c. British Lynton "twin". And Paul Smart from Maidstone is another with a mixed bag of machinery — Spanish Bultaco, Italian Ducati and British Seeley and Norton.

Fath, entered on the 500 c.c. version of his four-cylinder Urs, takes on the whole of B.S.A. Birmingham brigade—British sidecar champion Peter Brown, ex-champion Chris Vincent, Mick Boddice and the Hanks family—plus Pip Harris and Tony Wakefield with their B.M.W. outfits.

As an added attraction, there is the long-awaited duel between Chris Vincent and Andrew Chapman, current owner of the controversial Owen Greenwood Mini Cooper-powered three-wheeler. This will take the form of three five-lap match races, each with a clutch start. And Motor Circuit Developments, owners of Mallory Park and other leading British circuits, are handing over a £100 prize to the winner.

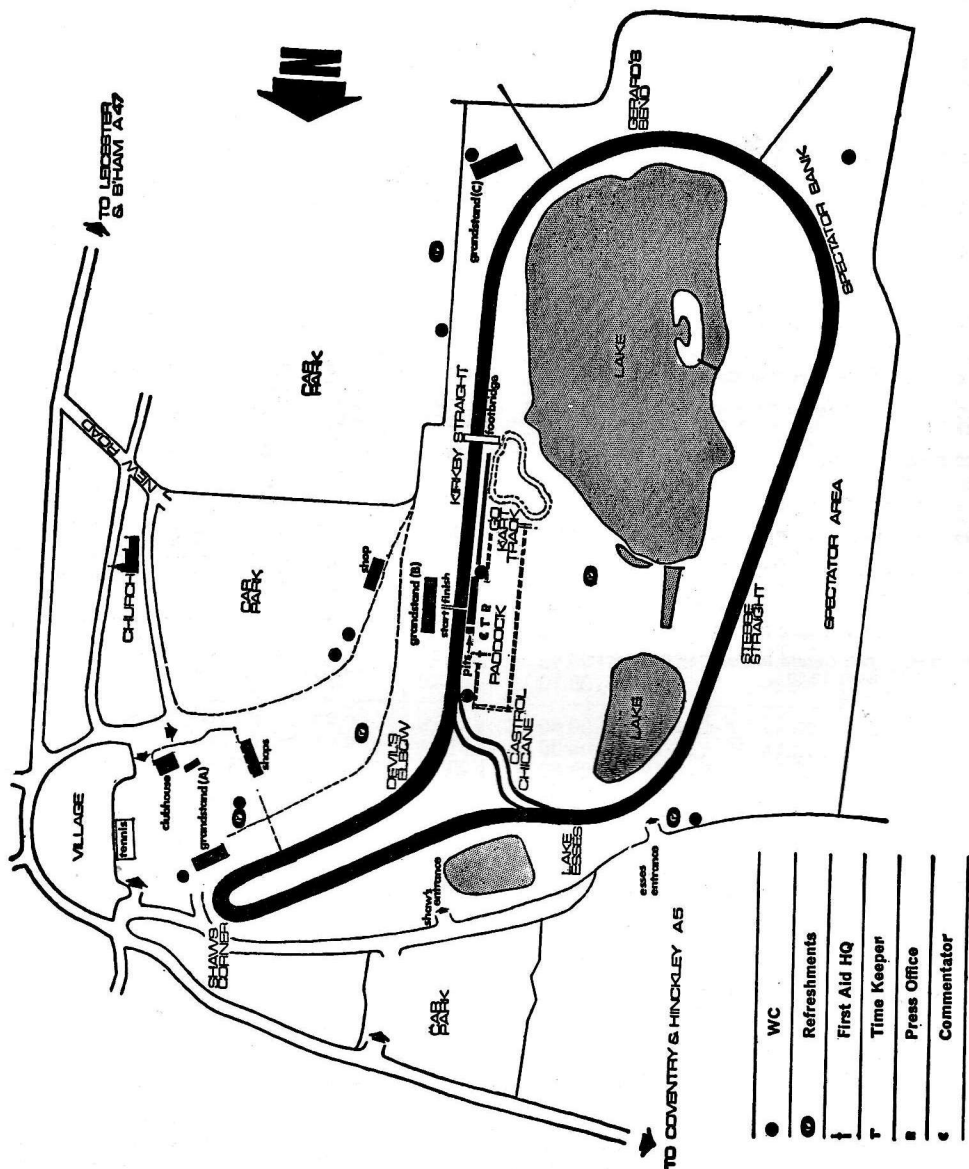
