

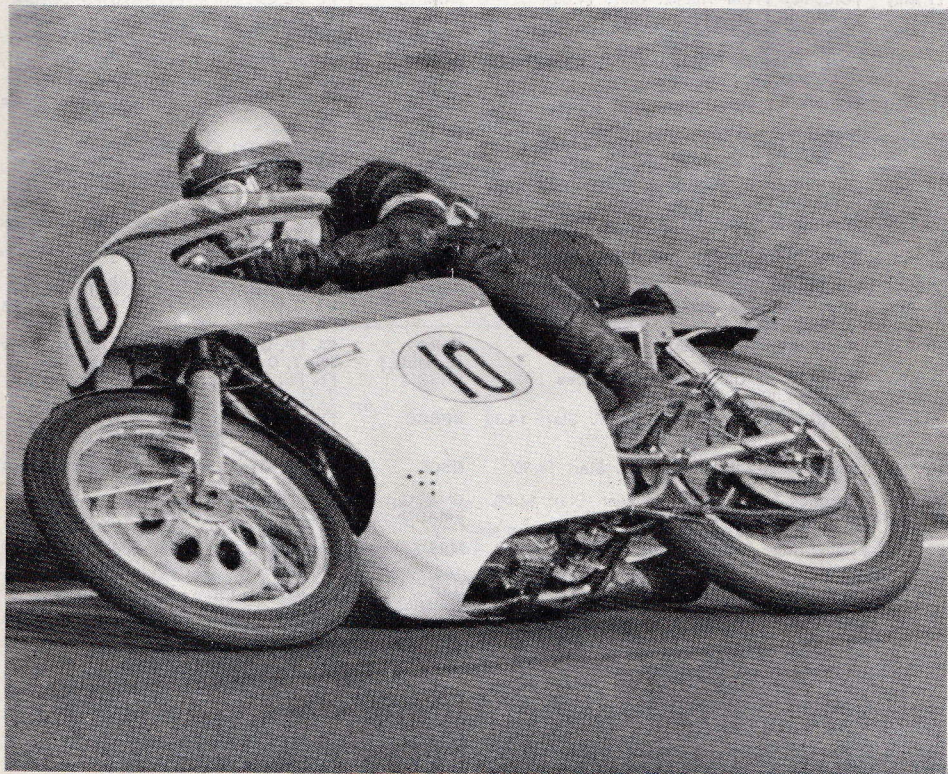

HERE WE GO AGAIN!

The motor cycle road racing season for the Midlands opens here today with a star-studded field on the 1.35 mile circuit for this national road race meeting of the Auto-Cycle Union East Midland Centre.

This is one of the most popular of all circuits with motorcycle racers and their enthusiastic supporters. The Lake Esses, the hairpin and the difficult downhill sweep through the Devil's Elbow provide a fine contrast to the two high-speed straights and the long curve of Gerard's Bend. Mallory Park is a place where riding skill can offset a slight disadvantage in machine performance.

There are so many competitors that five-lap heats are being run for every class except the 125 c.c. For this opening race run over eight laps, there is a John Ringwood from Buckhurst Hill, Essex, winner of the first ultra-lightweight race of the season, pitting his East German MZ against the home-brewed Shepherd "specials" of Martin Carney from Wallington and Trevor Burgess from Audenshaw, the Spanish Bultaco and Montesa of Charles Mortimer of Guildford and Londoner Grant Gibson; two Italian Villas raced by Derek Chatterton of Boston and Dave Browning from Cheltenham; and Japanese Tohatsus.

All these are two-stroke machines, like most in the smaller engine sizes, but the winner could well be an old but beautifully prepared four-stroke Honda—in the hands of reigning British champion Jim Curry from Broadway, Worcs.

Last year the Japanese Yamaha two-stroke cleaned up in the 250 c.c. class. Now they are being challenged by Italian four-stroke Ducatis.

Browning and Chatterton, and Ian should keep the Yamaha name in the Goddard from Boreham Wood, Herts., picture. But with Mortimer and Paul Smart from Maidstone, Kent on Ducatis they will not have it all their own way.

Welshman Malcolm Uphill, who could pull off a 250 c.c. win on the Eddie Crooks Suzuki, lines up for his 350 c.c. heat with Alan Barnett from Iwer, Bucks., the national champion for this class. Uphill is on an "old-fashioned" Norton, as is Barry Randle, the Stourbridge rider who performed so well in last year's Isle of Man T.T. Barnett has the Tom Kirby Metisse. Ron Chandler from Sevenoaks in Kent is on a Seeley, sponsored by Reg Kirby; and two men who will certainly be up with them are Roy Francis from Maidstone on the Monty and Ward Aermacchi and lone-hand John Taylor from Gravesend who rides an A.J.S.

The second 350 c.c. heat gives Mr. Short Circuit himself—Master of Mallory and King of Brands Dave Croxford from Ruislip, Middlesex—his first outing of the day, riding a Seeley in the green racing colours of his new sponsors, Gus Kuhn Motors.

Croxford's opposition includes Banbury's Dan Shorey on an Aermacchi, Paul Dunstall's big-machine specialist Ray Pickrell from Harrow, making a rare appearance on a 350, Paul Smart on Vic Camp's Ducati, Jim Curry on an Aermacchi Metisse, Martin Carney on a Shepherd, and Londoner Mick Andrew, previously best known as a production machine rider but now teamed with Croxford on Gus Kuhn "real racers".

The Senior class is for machines between 350 c.c. and 1,000 c.c. This gives many of the riders a choice of mounts and it is interesting to see that while Croxford is down to race a 496 Seeley his team-mate Andrew is on one of the big 745 c.c. Gus Kuhn Norton Commandos.

Chandler has plumped for a 500, so has Triumph speed merchant Percy Tait from Coventry; and Barnett, Randle and Shorey all have 500 c.c. machines. But two of the PR stars — Londoner Peter Butler on the Boyer Triumph and Tony Smith from Birmingham on the works development B.S.A. — both go for 650 c.c. vertical twins. And Ray Pickrell will almost certainly be out on the bigger of his two Dunstall Domiracers.

One of the more interesting entries in the three-wheeler class comes from Terry Harrison, former passenger to Owen Greenwood. With Roy Miller as passenger, he is down to drive the 998 c.c. Harrison Mini. Can't keep those trikes out of it!

Apart from that, the B.S.A. brigade from Birmingham won't have an entirely clear field. The Hanks family, Peter Brown, Mick Boddice and Chris Vincent are all entered with their 650 c.c. (or thereabouts) B.S.A. outfits: but up against them is that formidable pair, Pip Harris from Wombourne, Staffs., and Tony Wakefield from Spaldwick, Beds., both driving 500 c.c. German B.M.W.s.

With prize money just topping £1,500—including £70 for the winner of each final and some cash for everyone down to 12th place, competition is bound to be keen from the drop of the flag to the finish.
