

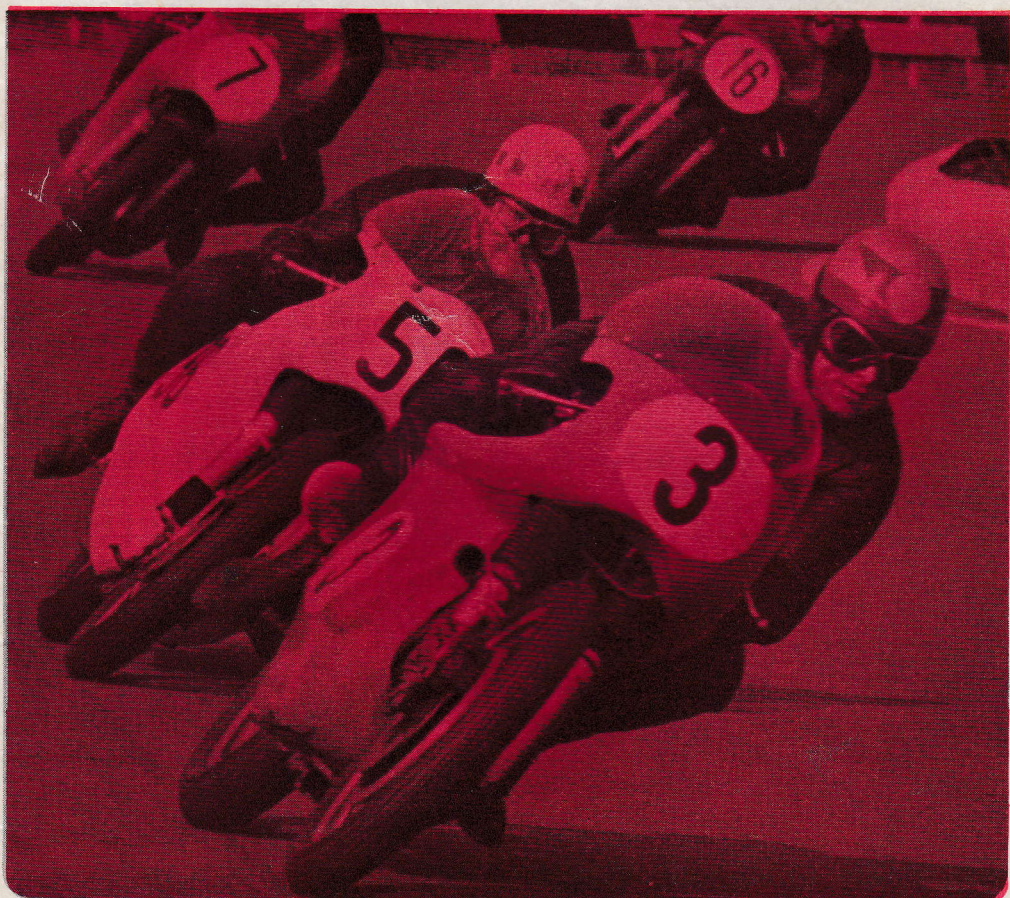

With 2,000 guineas at stake the racing today cannot fail to be other than spine-tling. Master of Mallory and King of Brands — Dave Croxford will again be mounted upon the fast Oakley AJS and Matchless bikes that have already brought him so much success this year. Eager to dethrone him and regain his 'Masters' title, John Cooper fields the immaculate Seeley machines, and since there is little if anything to choose from the performances of the bikes, victory depends largely upon the nerve and judgement of the riders.

If John and Dave start favourites today riders of the calibre of Ray Pickrell, Dan Shorey, Griff Jenkins, Rod Gould, Kel Curruthers, Rex Butcher, Steve Jolly, Gordon Kieth and Martyn Ashwood are unlikely to be deterred and are all quite capable of winning if luck is with them.

sented by the Aermacchi's of Ray Pickrell and Kel Carruthers, Keith's Yamaha and Kawasaki's ridden by Rex Butcher and Trevor Burgess. Don't write off the chances of a British victory though, there's plenty of life left in 'them thar singles'.

With many of the production racing specialists in 'The Island' for the start of TT practice, the production race nevertheless could be an interesting one, featuring as it does a pitstop and change of riders. Starting favourites must be the Pickrell/Croxford pairing on the Dunstall Dominator though one should not rate lightly the chances of the works BSA Spitfire with Tony Smith and Mick Andrews at the controls. For Triumphs the 500 Mile Race winners Peter Butler and Dave Nixon on the Boyer Bonneville will hope to pull off another surprise win.

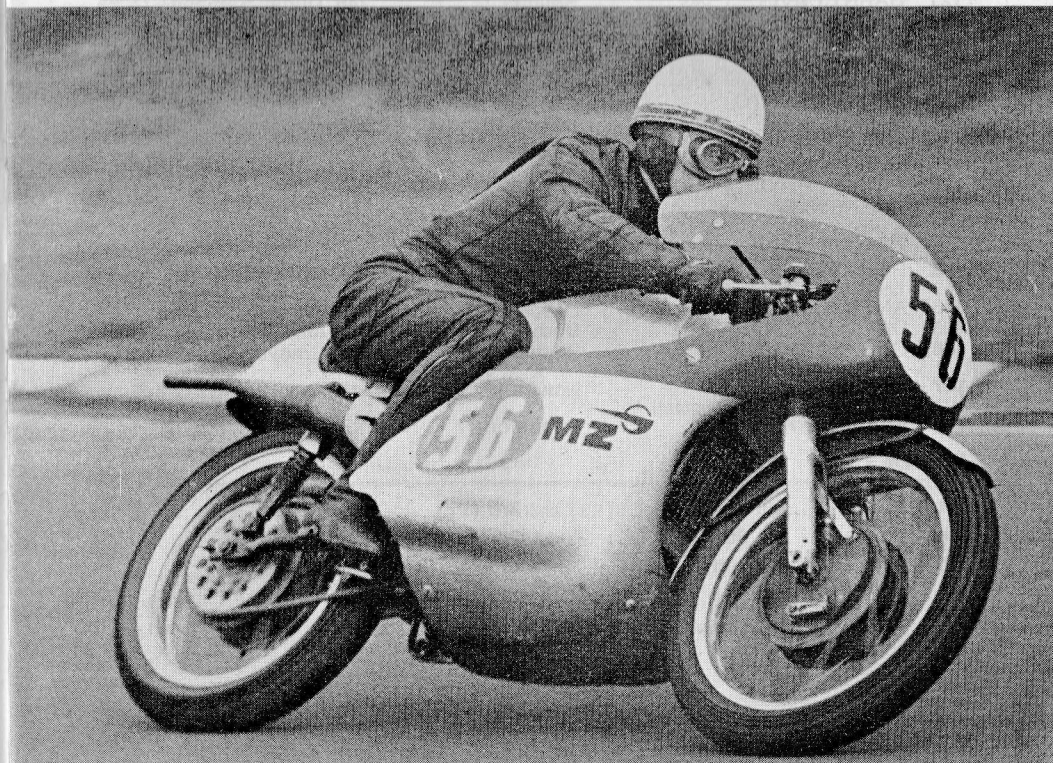

Possibly the most interesting class of the day as regards machinery is the 350 race. The seemingly ageless Ajay and Norton singles have Italian fourstrokes and Japanese 'stroker' twins to contend with. The 'foreign' machines are repre-

In race record shattering form after his Oulton Park victory Chris Vincent heads the entry in the three Wheeler race but he has very worthy opponents in Peter Brown and Mick Boddice, all of which drive BSA Spitfire powered outfits in a class where the big BSA motor seems to reign supreme. Outgunned in c.c.s. at least, if not b.h.p. will be the 500 BMWs of Pip Harris and Tony Wakefield, but the Munich twins make excellent 'chair' bikes and are only a little down on sheer brake horse power so expect to see them challenging. The infamous Greenwood Mini three Wheeler is also entered and now in the hands of Ken Allen should make the sparks fly in its progress from the back row off the grid, but with the 'small 970' motor will probably not quite be quick enough to win.

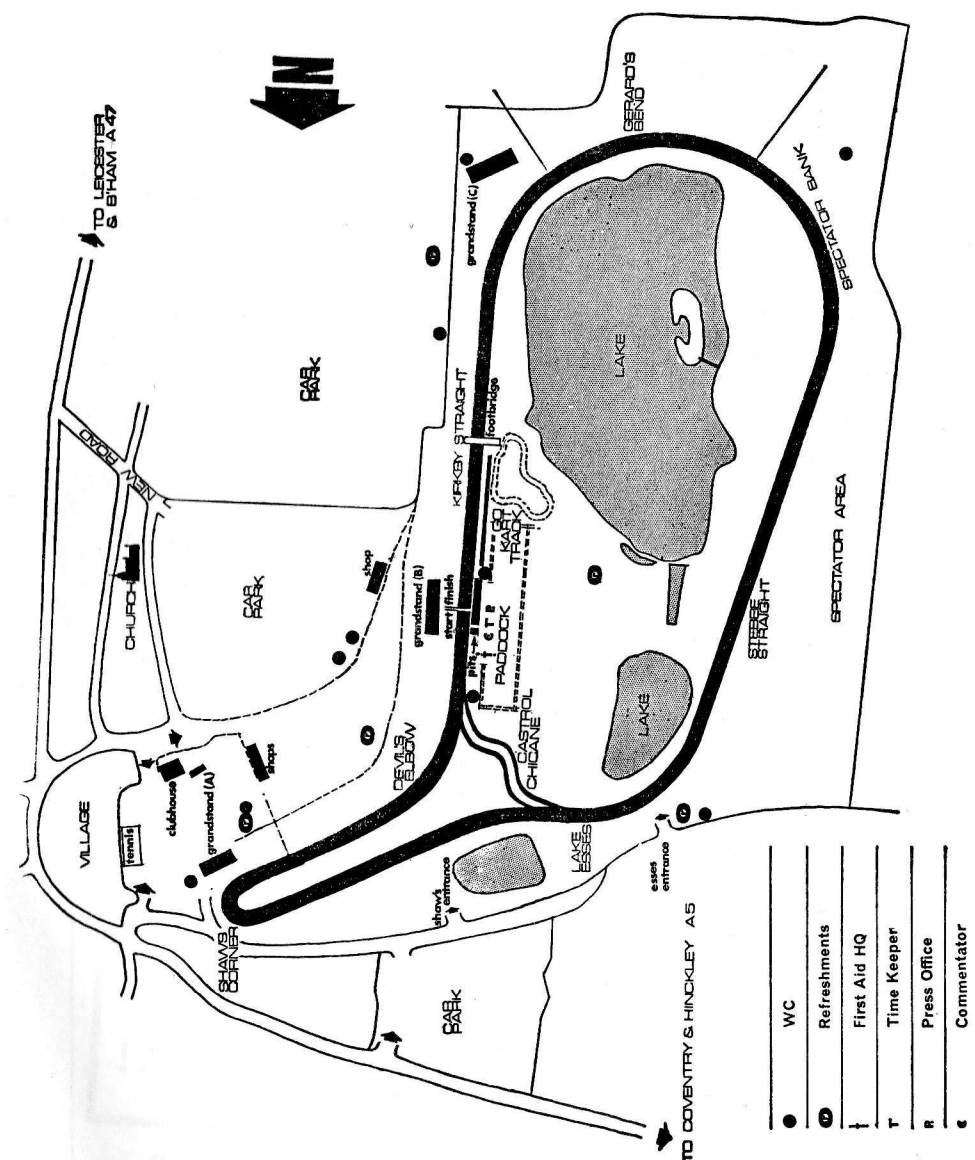
