



Top Class Entry for Season Opener.

First rounds of the Shell 500cc Championship and the B.P./Bill lvy Elimination Trophy add spice to the meeting.

The national racing scene bursts into life at Mallory Park today, the crescendo of which will spread beyond the immediate environment of the circuit and contains a variety of talent which augers well for the busy racing season ahead.

During the past few years life has settled down a little. At one time many of the riders and machines entered for the early meetings never made the starting line. For a variety of different reasons, but mainly due to the fact that the promised new machines were invariably behind delivery schedules. Consequently the Spring meetings suffered from last minute non-appearances much, to the annoyance of the eager spectators. Thankfully, nowadays things are changed and services more reliable, but I suppose some absentees are inevitable and we can but wish today's non-starters a speedy return to the racing scene.

Few rabid race-followers need any explanation of today's racing programme and even a cursory glance at the fourteen races will yield as much information as any biography but as every meeting is unquestionably different, it would be helpful to draw your attention to some of the star riders who will help make your day's sport so much more interesting.

Topping the list will be Paul Smart whose recent meteoric rise to prominence has been achieved with the aid of some very good machinery: and dare one say it: a riding style all of his own. After the "Race of the Year" here last September Gary Nixon was heard to remark "Who's this guy Smart?" If he has been reading the European press latterly he will now know, particularly from Paul's superb riding in South Africa. Paul is riding better than he has ever ridden before; has complete confidence to go with it, and must be reckoned as the best bet for a win today.

But the man who first broke into the headlines at Mallory Park, Ken Redfern, will be out to wreck that bid if he can. Ken defeated Paul in the 1000 cc race at the "Race of the Year" in a most convincing way, even though he could not repeat the dosage in the major event later in the day. Tony Jefferies is also riding again and Tony, you may remember, was very much the "nigger in the woodpile" at that meeting.

The solo races which include such stalwarts as Rex Butcher, Ron Chandler, Charlie Sanby, Martin Ashwood, Brian Kemp, ex-British Champion Dave Croxford, Pat Mahoney, Barry Sheene and many others, should be enough to create excitement throughout the day, supplemented by the Shell Super Oil 500cc Championship which,

has the first of its eight-rounds here today.

The BP/Bill Ivy elimination trophy series takes on a new look as well. Twenty-four riders will start in this first round over eight laps and it is a case of "the devil takes the hinde-most", with the last two finishers being excluded from future rounds. With seven more rounds to come, two of them at Mallory Park on June 13th and September 19th, the immediate onslaught is very important indeed for the tailenders who will have to fight hard to keep in with the chance of winning that coveted Silver Helmet and prize of £150.

And for those sidecar enthusiasts amongst us, lap record holder Chris Vincent wheels his 650 cc B.S.A. out yet again to take on a challenge from Peter Brown, Mick Boddice and the Hanks family,

traditionally mounted on B.S.As.

What more could you wish for than this exciting season-opener. We could have done without the postal strike with its attendant complications which may delay the practice schedule slightly but regardless of all other considerations you may rest assured of good racing and a thoroughly enjoyable day which will wet your appetite for our Easter Sunday event on April 11th.


