

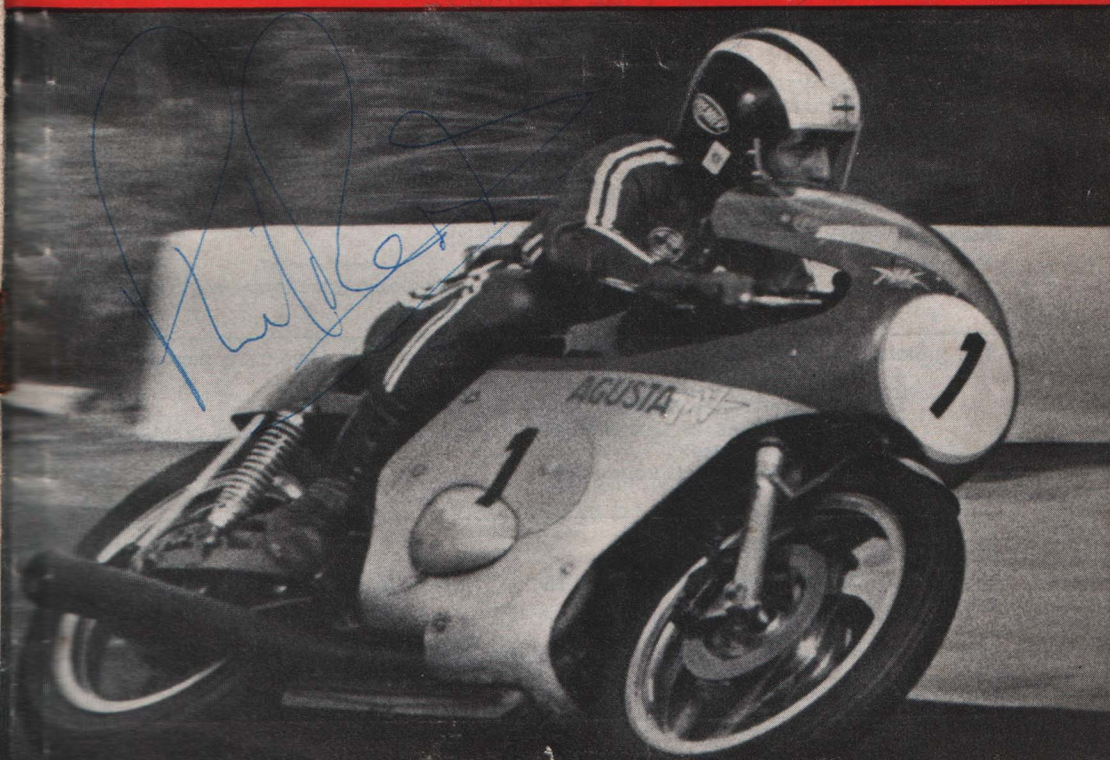

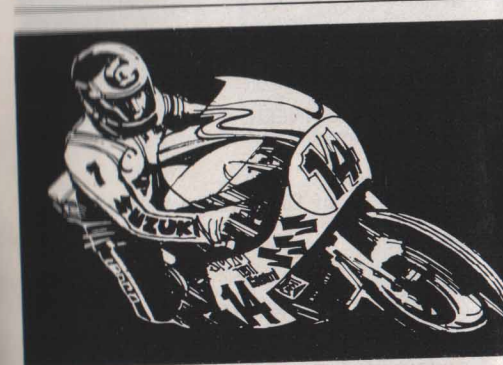

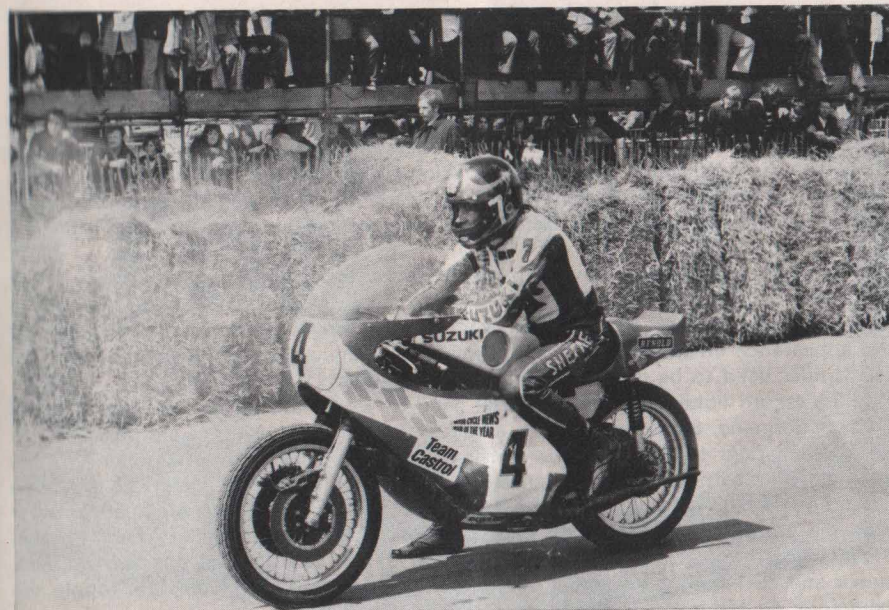

Cockney Whizz-Kid Barry Sheene, hot from two wins and two new lap records at Brands Hatch over Bank Holiday weekend, starts here today.

Works M.V. Agustas highlight spectacular Post T.T.

World 500 cc Champion **Phil Read**, fighting to retain the title which he won for the first time last year, brings the mighty M.V. to Mallory Park for the first appearance in Britain this year, and his first appearance since he took the World Senior title. Joining him will be **Gianfranco Bonera**, the suave Italian who only won his first Grand Prix at Imola last year and who succeeded in finishing runner-up to Phil in the world championship title chase. Franco broke his left leg during a freak accident at Modena in March, and he didn't even fall off! He caught a trackside strawbale with his leg. Although fit enough to ride at the German Grand Prix, Count Agusta would not permit such an early return to racing and the ex-cyclist had to sit the race out. Franco put in a superb performance on his first appearance at Mallory Park last June when he finished third behind the uncatchable Phil and Norton's Peter Williams. During this meeting Phil set a new 500 cc record at 94.92 mph, and, during the unlimited race equalled the late Jarno Saarinen's and Kenny Robert's ultimate lap record at 96.05 mph.

Another injured rider making up for lost time is **Barry Sheene**. Surviving a 175 mph spill on the Daytona banking would be enough for anyone, but Barry is back on form setting a new lap record at Brands Hatch on Whit-Monday in a time of 52.4s on

the 750 cc Suzuki. On the 500 square-four Grand Prix machine he also took the 500 lap record as well, so with two wins and two lap records you could say he's back with a bang!

Kawasaki's **Mick Grant** is another bang on form. In May he took the North West 200 by storm notching a fantastic lap record of 122.62 mph on a machine previously noted for its lack of staying power. This speed was no less than seven seconds faster than John William's previous best. Winning the 500 race on another Kawasaki, previously untried, put the cap on it all, particularly as his team-mate **Barry Ditchburn** finished second in the big race. Barry has since retained his King of Brands title for 1975.

Adding some International flavour is **Gyula Marsovszky**, now considered by most to be one of the "old stagers". His new Yamahas are but a phase in the whole string of machines he has ridden from year to year. **Helmut Kassner** puts in his very first appearance on the reliably quick Yamahas. A regular Grand Prix contender, this ex-MZ rider used to be quite a performer at one time.

New lap record holder **Mac Hobson** will have to work hard at this meeting to head the two Germans, **Siegfried Schauzu** and **Rolf Steinhausen**. Neither are strangers to the Yamaha rider as Mac is now considered to be quite a threat on the World's circuits. After setting a fourth fastest qualifying time at Hockenheim, he seized a big-end during the race which was a disappointment shared by all. Steinhausen now leads the world championship race. It will be his first race at Mallory Park for this T.T. lap record holder and it will be interesting to see whether the on-form Hobson, winner and new lap record holder at Brands a couple of weeks back, can topple the champions on his home territory.

It all adds up to quite a day's sport which, providing the weather is kind, should produce some new lap records.

Motor Cycle International Sidecar Championship

The weekly enthusiasts' paper Motor Cycle continues to sponsor their international sidecar championship on Motor Circuit Developments' circuits during 1975 which, last year, had an outstanding effect in reviving interest in three-wheeled motor cycle sport and improving the quality of fields.

The same figure of £1,000 prize money will be available at the end of the season—£500 for the winner and place money down to 6th. With a generous prize fund for each of the eight rounds, it adds up to a £2,000 championship.


Points are scored on a 15-12-10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1 basis and all points scored count towards a rider's total. Five points extra will be awarded for the fastest lap at each round with double points for the final round at Brands Hatch on October 26.

Considerable encouragement is given to competitors to produce smart and attractive outfits by the ShellSPORT Prix d'Elegance which continues in 1975, providing £25 in cash plus two bottles of champagne and two Shell goblets for the winning pair at each round. End of season winners receive an oil painting of themselves in action. Future dates: August 24, Snetterton; August 25, Oulton Park; September 14, Mallory Park; October 26, Brands Hatch.



Can Mick Grant continue his run of stunning successes on the superquick water-cooled Kawasaki, can Barry Ditchburn on a second "meanie" oust his team-mate, or will reigning champion Barry Sheene follow up his Brands Hatch record-smashing spree with the Superbike victory he so desperately wants?

Sheene has made it quite clear that second place is not good enough: "I need to win and get the fastest lap for the full 20 points to catch Mick," said the Suzuki ace after snapping his chain in the last meeting.

Although Stan Woods is out of Suzukis Mallory line-up with a broken wrist, and Dave Potter with a broken ankle, Pat Mahoney who also crashed heavily at Paddock Bend is back in the fray on the Clean Walls Yamaha and keen to improve on his fourth equal position in the superbike stakes and earn himself a bigger slice of the £8,000 purse.

Gulf are putting £500 into this Superbike round, with £250 going to the first six riders at one third and two thirds race distance, £50 going to the spectator winning the pick-a-six competition, elsewhere in this programme, and £200 going to boost the final prize fund.

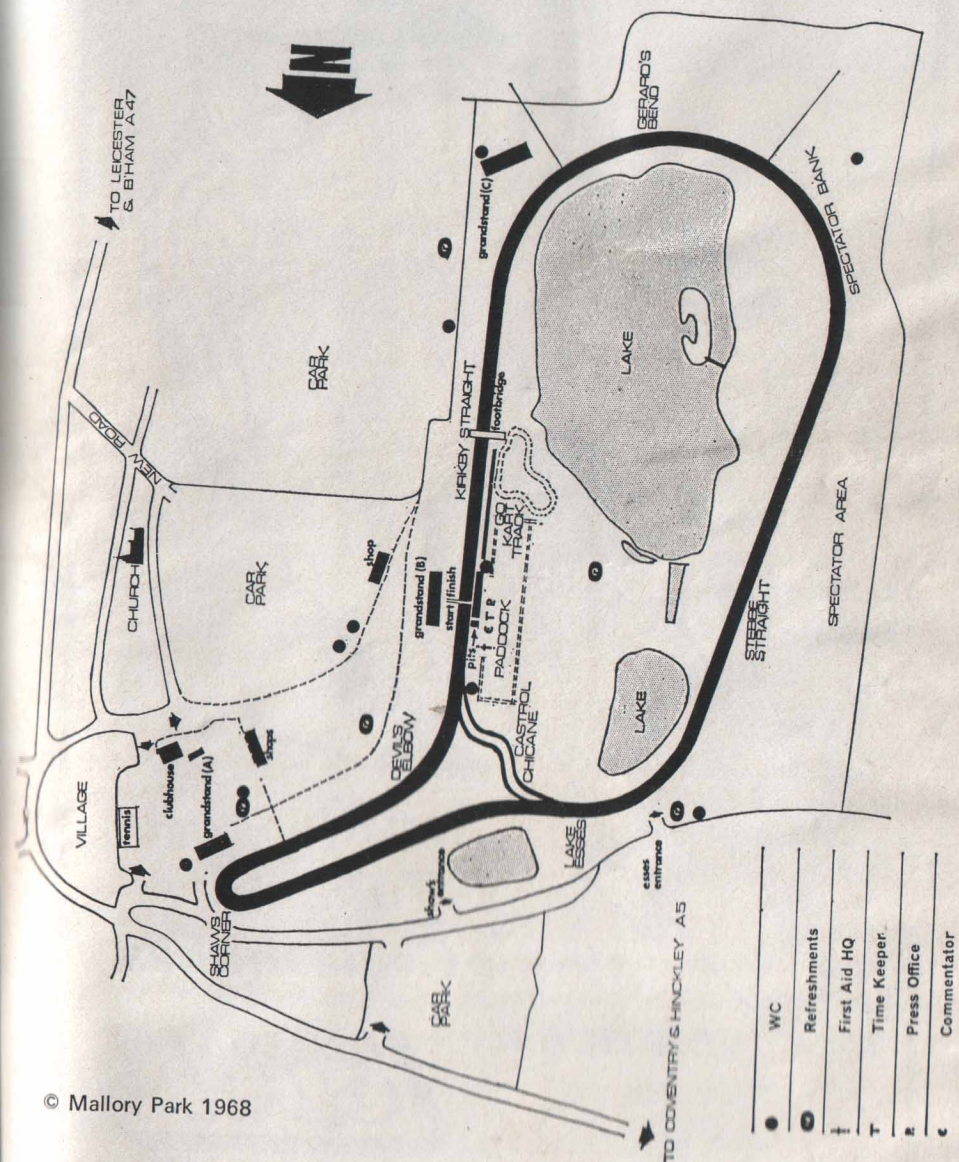

Map of Mallory Park Race Circuit

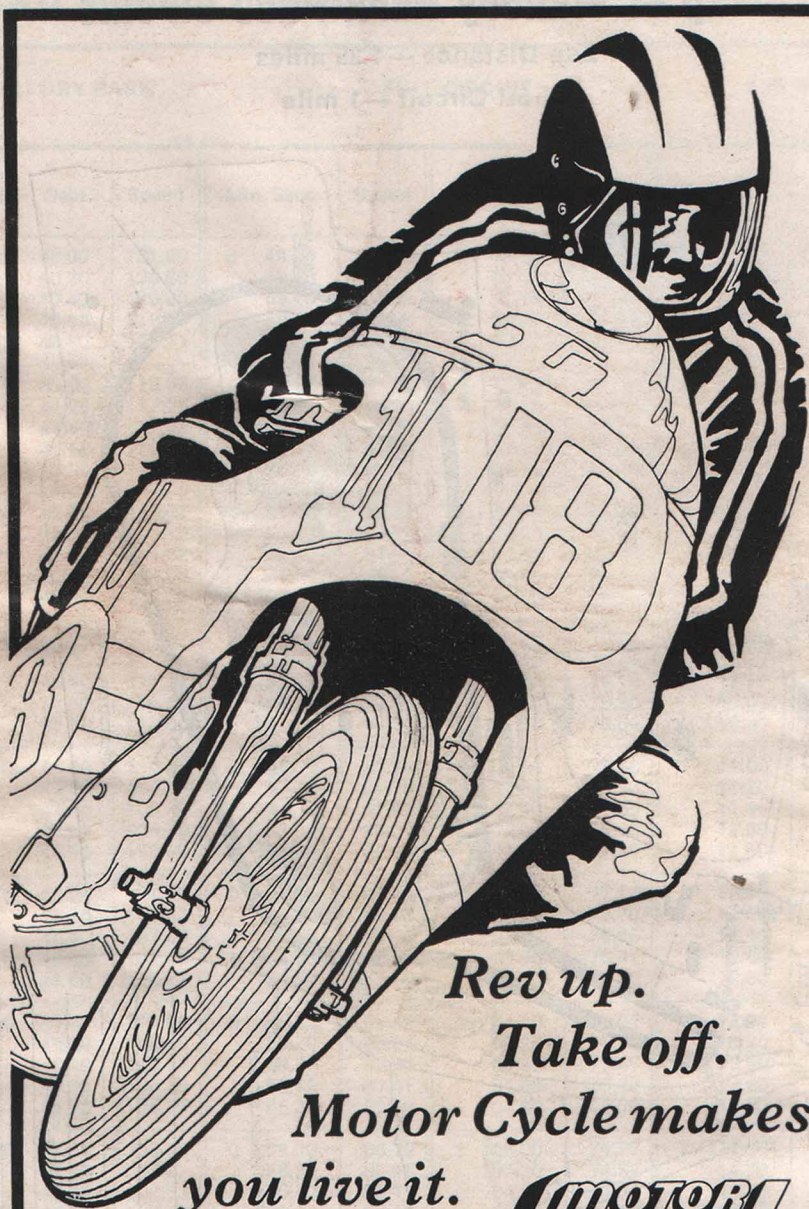
Lap Distance — 1.35 miles
