These are areas where the public are not permitted to walk, stand or sit, for safety reasons. They are usually "run off" areas, on the outside of bends, where spectators could be at risk if a rider leaves the road and where the presence of spectators could be a danger to a rider who loses control and enters the area.

For your own safety and the safety of riders PLEASE DO NOT go into prohibited areas and always remember that, if marshals ask you to move on, they are doing so for your safety.

Also, please do NOT take prohibited area signs as souvenirs. We need them.

Every one taken has to be replaced at a cost which could otherwise go towards buying more safety fencing to protect the riders and missing signs make the marshals' work that much harder.

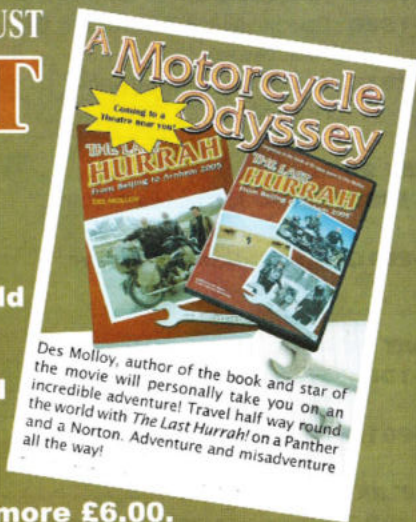

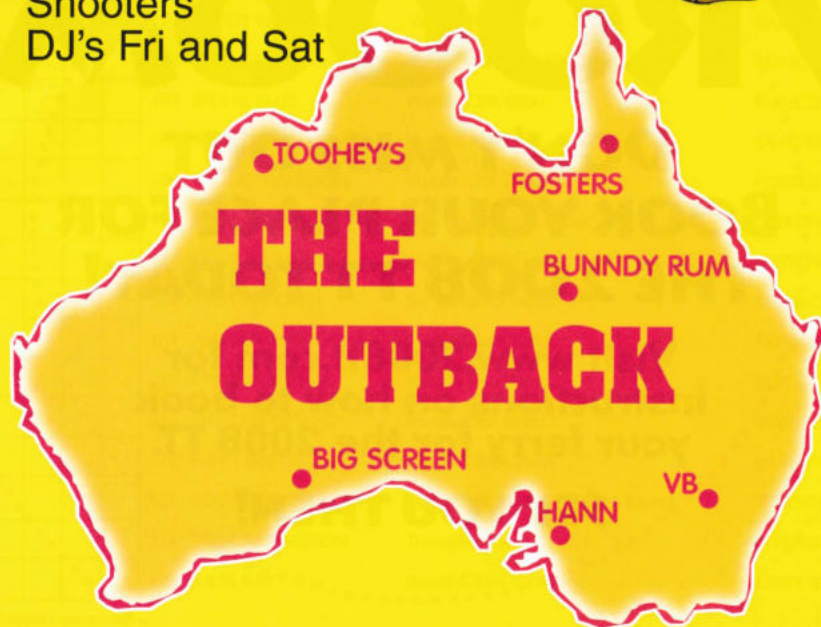

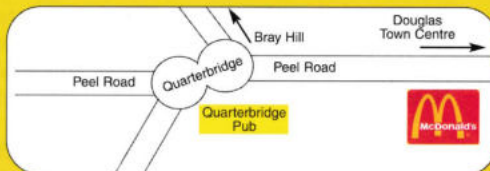

They are usually "run off" areas, on the outside of bends, where spectators could be at risk if a rider leaves the road and where the presence of spectators could be a danger to a rider who loses control and enters the area.

For your own safety and the safety of riders PLEASE DO NOT go into prohibited areas and always remember that, if marshals ask you to move on, they are doing so for your safety.

Also, please do NOT take prohibited area signs as souvenirs. We need them. Every one taken has to be replaced at a cost which could otherwise go towards buying more safety fencing to protect the riders and missing signs make the marshals' work that much harder.

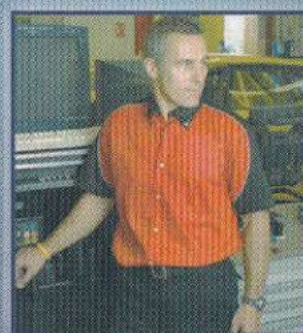

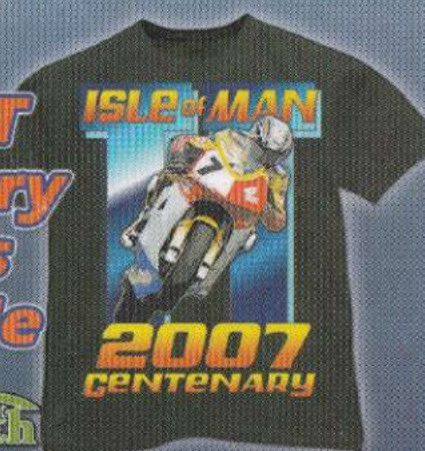
