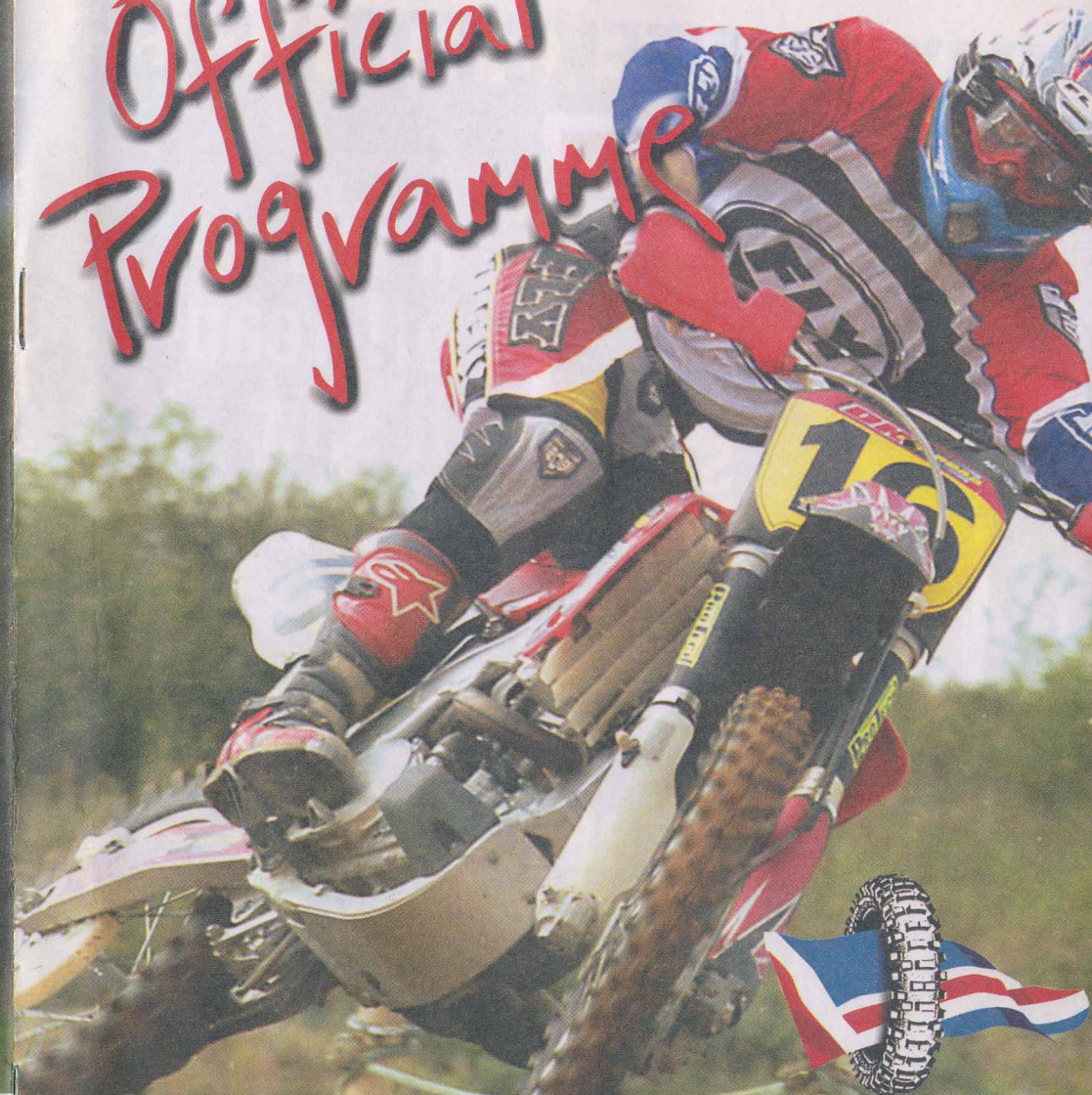

Stuart Lines 2nd in Czecho

Riding in the IMBA European Sidecar Championships at Redhost in the Czech Republic on Sunday Stuart Lines and passenger Marc Cooper scored a fine 2nd overall after winning the 2nd race. His other race results were 5th and 3rd and he was only beaten by the Championship leader Eddy Somers of Belgium who scored a win and 2 - 2nd places. A good result for Mark Banks and Pete Davis who finished 5th overall after taking 2nd place in the opening race, they now lie 12th in the Championship. The other AMCA riders included Craig Edwards and Tony Phillips from Telford who finished 17th overall while John Grahame and Michael Stones were unable to finish the 3rd race.

Dartmouth Classic.

The club will be accepting late entries on Sunday at its Classic Scramble at Harberton, Devon, in addition free camping will also be available plus a local meat Barbecue on Saturday night. Marshals are also needed and any volunteers are asked to contact John Dal-laway on 0797 4567833. He will also take calls from anyone with queries and riders are asked not to contact Clive Causer whose mother has recently died. Hoping to ride at this event is Roger Neal who has been away for over 18 months following an injury last year at a Bath Classic meeting where he suffered head injuries which resulted in an air ambulance taking him to hospital.

Matchams Park - This event has been over subscribed with entries and a lot of riders cannot be fitted into the event, some have been sent to other events whilst others will have to have their entry fees returned via their clubs. With only 9 events this weekend it has been impossible to fit everyone in with an event. The problem is caused by the East, Avon and South West groups not having any events, even so, nearly 2000 riders have been accepted.

Yorkshire Group - Several track changes this weekend beyond the control of the Ossett club and the venue is now at North New-bald near Junction 38 of the M62, take the B1230 towards Beverley. If travelling from the South, cross the Humber Bridge and then turn left onto the A63 to South Cave and then the A1034 to North Newbald.

KWS - Charlie Hollis from Walsall club dominated the AMCA's Open Class races at Foxhills last weekend with 3 wins from Dave Thompson with Matthew Porter (Shepshed) who finished 3rd overall. In the 125's AMCA class Lee Dunham from Dursley was the overall winner with two wins beating Leigh Hodgson from the Tormarton club by 3 points with David Harrison from Rob Riding 3rd. Simon Lane riding in the Open Pro Class finished in the top 20 with a 16th in the 2nd race.

The Foxhills circuit was in prime condition after the KWS team had spent most of the week working at the track preparing the circuit and were no doubt helped by a heavy rainfall on the Saturday morning. The AMCA Transponder system produced results for all the 24 races within seconds of the races finishing. Over 300 riders competed over the two days and details of the final round on August 15th and 16th will be announced shortly.

North Shrops Club.

The club met last Monday night and have had a sort out with new officials taking over the running of the club. New Chairman is Steve Williams with Andrew Wagstaffe the new Secretary. The club meets on Mondays at The Castle in New Street, WEM on Mondays evenings, next week a decision will be taken over the 2 Moto Cross events the club are due to run at Shawbury on August 8th and Sept 5th. They will be attending the next meeting of the North Shrops and North Wales group of clubs meeting next week.

Moto Cross events this weekend.

Mid Cheshire running at Norley will accept Late entries from the home group only - North Midlands. Same story for the Teme Valley's meeting at Boraston, only late entries from the Home group - Border who must pre-book with Alan Smith the Club Sec on 01905 391622 or Mobile 07941 470988. Matchams Park, a reminder that the gates will be locked at 10.30 p.m. on the Saturday night. Ossett in Yorkshire will only accept late entries if they are pre-booked with Danny Blakeley on 07958 635306 and note Camping will be £5 per vehicle and awnings will not be allowed due to limited space for parking.

Bridgwater Club. - The club wish to state that the letter included in this column a couple of weeks ago was incorrect. Unfortunately the club made an error on the company name. The company that actually let the club down was 'Response Medical Services' based in Lyme Regis and not 'First Response Medical Cover' as the club stated in the e-mail. First Response Medical Cover are also based in the southwest in Exeter and are actually a well renowned company that cover many Moto Cross events across the region and the club apologies for any inconvenience they may have caused.

CLUBMAN Series.

The Provisional Dates for this series are as follows, the riders have been split into classes - Over 30's and Over 40's due to the demand.

The Over 30's are split into 4 areas for the first rounds with AREA 1 for riders from the North West, North Midlands and North Shrops and North Wales competing at Mold - 22nd Aug and Sandbach - 29th Aug.

Riders from the Area 2 - Yorkshire, Trent Valley and East riders compete at Wakefield on 15th Aug and Oakham on the 29th Aug. Area 3 are riders from West Midland, Border and the Northern part of Wessex and they ride on 8th Aug at Cannock and Aug 15th at Druids. Area 4 are for rider from the Avon, South west and the southern part of Wessex who ride on the 15th Aug at Teignbridge and 29th Aug at Bridgwater.

Over 40's are split into 2 areas with Area 1 consisting of riders from north West, North Midlands, North Shrops and North Wales, Yorkshire, Trent Valley and Coalville Club from the East. They will ride at Rossendale on the 22nd Aug, Warsop on 29th Aug and South Yorkshire on 5th Sept. Area 2 will be for riders from the East group (less Coalville), West Midlands, Border, Wessex, Avon and the South West. There events are 8th Aug at Hereford, 15th Aug at Shepshed and Marshfield on 12th Sept. Riders should note that the dates and venues may change as clubs inform the Office that they cannot take these races. Note the entry has closed for these classes.
