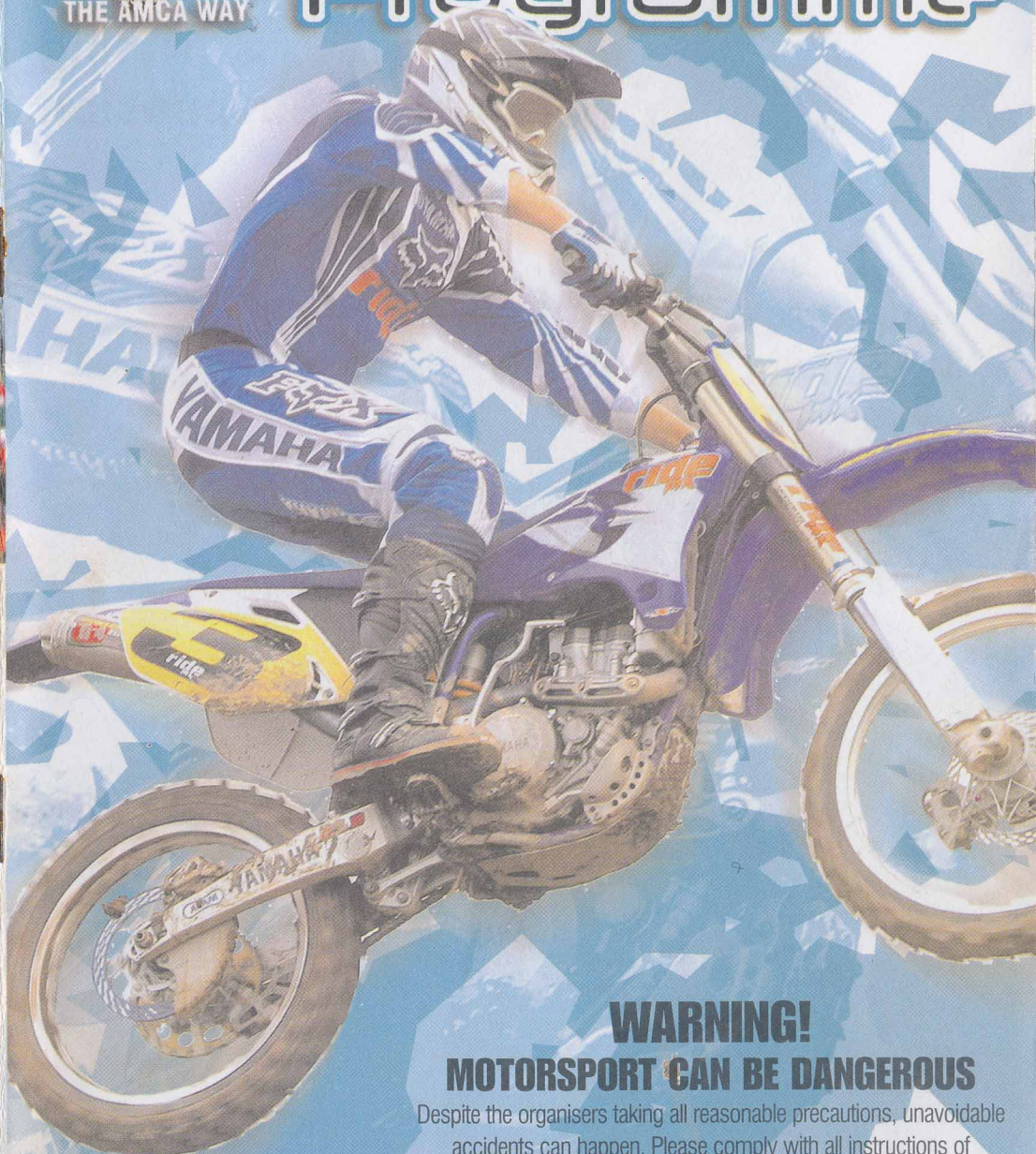

AMCA Championships

The third round of the 125cc and Open Class Championships take place at Matchams this coming weekend. Matchams can be found off the A31.

125cc

Rick Du'Feu currently heads the 125cc Championship chase after the opening 2 rounds, man of the moment Matt Porter is just 2 points behind Du'Feu after taking the overall win at the previous round. Alan Pearce, Brad O'Leary and James Lane complete a 250f Honda clean sweep off the top 5 positions.

Open

Charlie Hollis (Ride MX Yamaha) sits at the top of the Open class Championship on 85 points ahead of Simon Lane on 74 with Aaron Crowder on 68. Danny Blakeley, David Thomson, Paul Burn and Craig Chamberlain are in close attendance. James Russell and Jason Rennie could also be amongst the front runners.

125cc IMBA Championship, Dalecin, Czech Rep

Brad O'Leary and Rick Du'Feu were in superb form in the Czech Rep at the weekend, both riders taking a race win, which meant that O'Leary got second overall with Du'Feu third.

In the opening race O'Leary took the holeshot ahead of David Harrison and Rick Du'Feu with Lee Dunham in 12th. O'Leary cleared off at the front whilst Du'Feu and Harrison made a couple of mistakes to drop them back, O'Leary took a well deserved win with Du'Feu finishing in 5th, Dunham a solid 8th with Harrison in 16th.

The second race started and it was David Harrison who hit the front ahead off Swiss rider Daniel Huser and O'Leary. Du'Feu made a slight mistake mid race which dropped him back from fourth, at the finish Huser took the win ahead of O'Leary, Harrison was 5th with Du'Feu 7th and Dunham in 8th.

Rick Du'Feu scored a superb win in the final race of the day, Huser took the holeshot ahead of Du'Feu, Harrison and O'Leary with Dunham in 10th. Du'Feu made his move on the 4th lap to take over the lead and despite intense pressure held on for a heroic win from Huser. O'Leary took 3rd with Dunham in 8th and Harrison 18th after a mistake.
