Part of each Allcomer group's Practice session will be timed to decide the qualifiers for Groups A, B.and C.

The fastest 33% from Q1, Q2 and Q3 will form the A Group. The next 33% will form the B Group. The remainder will form the C Group.

The riding of machines of any sort in the paddock and areas surrounding the circuit is totally forbidden. Because the event is on private property it does not place it outside the Road Traffic Act in terms of insurance. 




