


The fun machines of the modern age

Throughout Britain, motor cycling is on the upsurge. New registrations in 1971 totalled 127,922 machines of all types a 20% gain on the previous year, and there is every indication that 1972 will bring an even greater increase.

With the cost of getting to work by public transport continually rising, and with travelling conditions on trains and 'buses becoming ever more difficult, thousands are turning to the natural alternative of a powered two-wheeler. Much of the growth in Britain at the moment is among the incredibly economic mopeds. lightweight two-wheelers with a 50 c.c. engine and pedals attached. Priced from £70 to £150, they are robust and easy to handle and they do an astonishing 120/150 miles per gallon of fuel, which works out at around three miles for 1p!

They are also among the safest forms of motorised transport, which is why the Insurance Companies provide a cheap, flat rate cover on the machine itself so that any member of the family old enough to hold a driving licence can ride. However, it is not only the smaller motor cycles which are attracting attention. The big capacity models up to 750 c.c. are suddenly enjoying a new found market in Britain—and they cost anything from £600 to £1,200! These are the machines for the trendy young executive or the older, established tycoon returning to two wheels and recapturing an almost forgotten zest for life. These people invariably own cars as well—but the motor cycle is their FUN machine. We are seeing today the late arrival in Britain of a trend which has been sweeping many parts of the world (particularly the U.S.A.) for the past two or three years—a trend which is fast establishing the motor cycle as the functional and fashionable, fun and leisure machine of the modern age.

The big bicycle boom!


