

RED FLAG Stop and do not pass the flag, return to starting area.

Hazard ahead exercise caution, No overtaking in that section.

MELLOW with Black Diagonals

Last Lap.

BLACK and White Chequered

End of Race.

Failure to obey the fflags will result in disqualification, or any other punishment as decided by the Committee.

#### MARSHALLS REMINDER

The Blue Flag is used to indicate that First Aid Assistance is required, and when used is held above the head.

Marshalls are responsible for the course from His/Her point, to the next marshalling point, and the object is to warn riders of any hazard in your section, Should any rider stop, dismount, or fall off, the Yellow Flag must be held out IMMEDIATELY, and must stay out untill the course is clear.

So do not forget PRIORITY is to warm other riders of Hazard.
