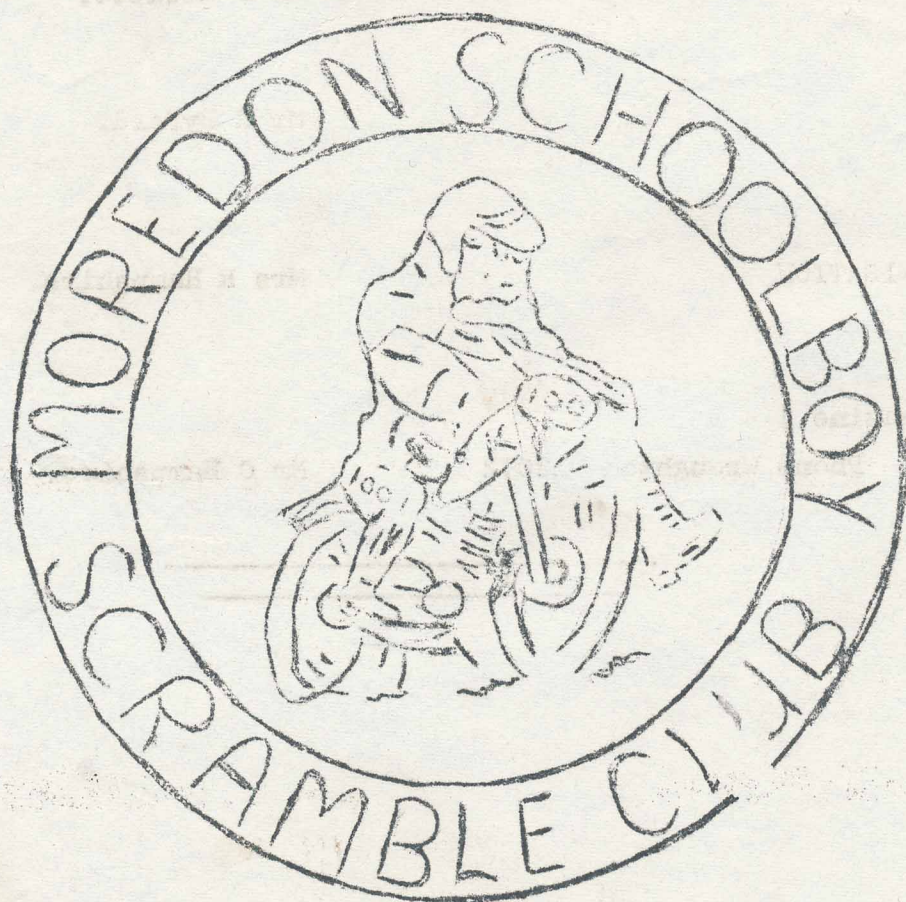

## RIDERS

I think it appropriate that riders are reminded of what the Flags mean to them.

### RED FLAG

Stop and do not pass the flag, return to starting area.

### YELLOW FLAG

Hazard ahead exercise caution, No overtaking in that section.

### YELLOW with Black Diagonals

Last Lap.

### BLACK and White Chequered

End of Race.

Failure to obey the flags will result in disqualification, or any other punishment as decided by the Committee.

## MARSHALLS REMINDER

The Blue Flag is used to indicate that First Aid Assistance is required, and when used is held above the head.

Marshalls are responsible for the course from His/Her point, to the next marshalling point, and the object is to warn riders of any hazard in your section, Should any rider stop, dismount, or fall off, the Yellow Flag must be held out IMMEDIATELY, and must stay out untill the course is clear.

So do not forget PRIORITY is to warn other riders of Hazard.
