

RIDERS

All riders must start from the Marshalling Area,

When a rider as completed all the sections once he must return to the marshalling area,

When a rider as completed the number of round require to complete the trial, He will only ride from the marshalling to the pits, Not around the trials area.

Provisional Trial Dates,

Nov 28th, Dec 12th, Dec 19th, Jan 9th, Jan 16th, Jan 30th, Feb 17th, Feb 20th, Feb 27th, March 13th.

We held the first trial at Moredon on Sunday 28th Nov 1976 and what a great start to the season, 33 riders completed three rounds of 10 sections.
