# **BRITISH 500cc MOTO CROSS GRAND PRIX**

# Preview by Paul Fowler, Motor Cycle News

The warmest of West Country welcomes to Farleigh Castle for the British 500cc moto cross Grand Prix.

For the third year running the West Wilts Motor Club are your hosts for this most prestigeous event in the British moto cross calendar.

This year Britain has the finest chance for years of scoring a victory in the world championship chase and a British victory here today could be the forerunner to that ultimate prize.

It was in 1968 that Vic Eastwood won the British GP on this very soil to become the last Englishman to win a world championship on his home groud.

Then Eastwood scored first and second places on his Husqvarna and completed the second leg with a flat back tyre in terrible weather conditions that left the track in a quagmire. Let's hope the god's decide to let us have more favourable weather today!

At the first round of the 1979 title chase Britsh Champion Graham Noyce proved he was in with a chance of bringing the championship back to Britain when he broke a 10 year victory famine with a magnificent overall win.

Since then the 22 year-old Hampshire Honda rider has fought neck and neck with his former team-mate in the Honda squad, American Brad Lackey.

Lackey made the decision to switch to the rival Kawasaki concern during the close season and his decision has certainly paid off.

The 1979 season so far has seen no one person dominate the grands prix in the way that quadruple champion Heikki Mikkola [Yamaha] did last year but both Mikkola and five times world champion Roger DeCoster suffered from pre-season injury problems that muted their early challenge.

Suzuki have fielded by far the strongest factory team challenge in terms of numbers with Dutchmen Gerrit Wolsink, and Gerard Rond, and Belgian Andre Vromans backing up team number one Roger DeCoster.

The French have provided a few surprises this year. KTM man Jean-Jacques Bruno delighted his countrymen when he became the first Frenchman ever to win a GP moto cross leg at the French second round, and Honda number two Andre Malherbe is having his best season so far.

England's remaining graded runners are the Cotton EMX team of Pete Mathia and Rob Wilkinson and the only four stroke campaigner, Bob Wright (CCM), while the third Cotton man, Ulsterman Lawrence Spence, rides under the banner of the MCUI.

Once again today's promotion is sponsored by cigarette giants Camel and Champion Spark Plugs, with help from Kawasaki. Motor Cycle News and Girling are weighing in to back the supporting races.

# Graham Noyce-leader to date of the 1979 Series





Reigning British Champion, comes from Eastleigh in Hampshire. 22 years old in February this year, an ex Schoolboy champion who started Grand Prix moto cross with the West German Maico factory. Finished 4th in 500 cc Championship in 1976, 8th in 1977, then switched to Honda and finished 7th in 1978. Now number one rider for Honda and having by far his best International season, the sky is the limit for this young, talented and spectacular rider on whose broad shoulders rests the hopes of all moto cross enthusiasts in Great Britain. We wish him all the luck and good fortune there is to go with his undoubted skill and ability.



### **BRAD LACKEY**

This very likeable Californian was born in 1953, and he fist came to Europe in 1973 and finished 13th. He improved greatly to finish 6th in 1975 and 5th in 1976 with the Swedish Husqvarna factory. He then went to Honda and was 4th in 1977 and runner up to the World Champion in 1978. He then left Honda to ride for Kawasaki and contest the 1979 series. He was overall winner here in 1977 and 1978 and will be looking for a hat-trick on a circuit he enjoys riding at.

### HEIKKI MIKKOLA

Current World Champion this immensely talented Finnish rider is the only rider as yet to have been World Champion in both 250 and 500 classes. He won the 250 Championship for Husqvarna in 1976 then joined Yamaha and won the 500 class in 1977 having already taken the same class title for Husqvarna in 1974! This year he was injured early in March and missed the opening round of the 1979 series, and with performances since not as consistent as this very tough and resolute rider would like—with the exception of the Italian round which he won. Overall he is surely looking to gain every point he can. Who can forget his meteororic ride in the second leg at Farleigh last year when from a position at the back of the field on the first lap he carved his way through to finish third.



### ROGER DE COSTER

One of the finest riders Moto Cross has ever seen, five times World 500 cc Champion—1971—72—73—75—76 a superb stylist and a very talented engineer, we shall be seeing Roger ride here for the last time today for at the end of the season he retires to concentrate on development. Born in Belguim in 1944, married with two children Roger was gravely injured in February last year whilst practising and against all the odds was back racing just eight weeks later, and finished the season in third place. He has been selected no less than 21 times to represent his country's team in Moto Cross and Trophée des Nations. Truly an Ambassador of Motor Cycle Sport, and everyone will join in wishing him success in his future work.

### **GERRIT WOLSINK**

Born in Mengelo, Holland in 1947 he graduated as a dentist but made moto cross his profession. For a number of years he was overshadowed in the Suzuki team by Roger de Coster but in 1976 his consistency and undoubted talents showed when he came a very close runner up to Roger. In 1977 he was third behind Roger and Heikki but in 1978 he dropped to 5th.




