BEHIND THE SCENES

at a Newbury and District M.C. Promotion

Any large sporting event, such as this Berkshire Moto-Cross, you are about to watch, always reminds me of an Iceberg—for all that shimmering ice you can see, nearly ten times as much remains hidden beneath the surface of the sea. The tip of our iceberg as seen by you, the spectator, is this series of hard fought races, i.e. the splendid show put up by that grand bunch of sportsmen—the riders. However I think it would not do any harm to think about all the undercover activity that has led up to the glittering promotion you have travelled to our “Fox and Hounds” circuit to see.

Far and away the largest amount of credit for the success of our scramble is due to our M-X organiser and club secretary, *Dave Joyce*, and his assistant (and club Newsletter editor) and attractive wife *Sally*. Their labours started months ago—right from the time the Southern centre of the A.C.U. granted us the date of September 14th for the event. To give you some idea of how much foresight is required, Dave is already making plans for next March's big promotion—our nationally famous “Battle of Newbury.” This despite the fact that he will still be tying up the loose ends of today's meeting for some weeks to come.

Having secured a good entry and arranged publicity and advertising, the layout and printing of programmes, besides satisfying the stringent A.C.U. regulations, all of which is done by the aforementioned Secretary of the Meeting, the next most important item must be the circuit. Its preparation is in the very capable hands of *John Spanswick*. This involves not only staking out and double roping over a mile of track, but the siting and erection of multiple toilets, programme stalls and official caravans, laying out the paddock area, allocating the car parking space and arranging suitable entrances and exits for both competitors and spectators (who can arrive by coach, car, motor cycle or on foot). In all this John relies very much upon the help of *Doug Richardson*.

Now we come to the man who many people would consider has the most vital job of all, the Club Treasurer (and time trial organiser) *John Stanley*. He is responsible for providing change, collecting all gate and programme monies, paying out the successful competitors and meeting the bills for the very many expenses we have. Such as printing and advertising, track permit fee, ground rent, hire of ropes and tentage and donations to any organisations that help us, such as the St. John Ambulance Brigade, without whom racing could not take place, etc., etc. It may well be months before John is able to wind up his side of the event, showing how much profit (or sometimes loss!) the club has made in his final balance sheet.

Assisting John in the biggest part of his job, i.e. collecting the cash off you, the paying public, are his wife, *Edna*, *Mrs. Doug Richardson*, *Mrs. Muriel Tucker*, (well-known for her contributions to our Newsletter) and *Jim Randall* (better known for his efficient organisation of our Trophy Trial). Likewise *Mrs. Ann Huntley*, who is the boss of programme sales.

Now of course the track has to be under surveillance to see that the public do not stray into prohibited areas and also to render assistance to any fallen riders, etc. For this a whole host of people are efficiently briefed and controlled by our chief marshal, *Clive Chick*, aided and abetted by *Cecil Withers*.

To keep the riders in order in the paddock and especially on their entry to the circuit is not a job for the weak willed. So we are lucky to have big *John Dyson* to carry out this vital task. The clever box arrangement which controls riders exit from the paddock was John's brain child and in the winter he keeps us fit by endeavouring to teach the rest of us to swim correctly.

Before the machines can be allowed onto the track, even for practice this morning, each and every one of them has to be meticulously vetted for suitability and safety. Also the riders protective clothing must be similarly examined. This onerous task is carried out in efficient but friendly manner by scrutineers, *Dennis Huntley* and *Bob Tucker* (who is also a keen R.A.C./A.C.U. training scheme instructor).

Starting of the races, which includes checking the eligibility of the riders coming to the line for each event, besides operating our system of lights, is done by club chairman, *Ron Tarry*. Similarly, flagging off the competitors at the end of the race, indicating the number of laps remaining and showing them the yellow flag at the end of the penultimate lap is the job of *Stan Speller*, our press secretary and film show organiser.

Before the winner can be flagged off, or the official results announced by the P.A. commentator, the lap scorers have to do their stuff. They are also responsible for seeing that all starters in the races have completed sufficient qualifying laps during the official practice periods, timing the winner of each race and working out any necessary handicaps. Here our regular team consists of two ex-road racers, *Harry Argent* and *Pete Eacott* (club vice-chairman) also *Pat Tanner*, social secretary and another training scheme instructor.

Our meetings usually go off pretty smoothly, but when the odd snag does crop up, you may be sure that *Frank Flower* will soon be on the scene to sort it all out, quietly and calmly. Officially he is the P.R.O. of the meeting, but I prefer to look upon him as our chief “trouble shooter,” in which role he is ably assisted by *Colin Boseley*. These two stalwarts were largely instrumental in the design and manufacture of our unique electric starting gate, lap scorers caravan and “Ladies” caravan.

Should it still become necessary for the club to make an on the spot ruling, then club steward *Alan Loader* will step forward to settle the problem with charm and wisdom. Alan is also our signwriter and he thought up and made our superb “Laps to go” indicator.

There are of course many more members who do vital jobs, but I hope this article gives you some insight into what lies beneath the surface. Meanwhile, enjoy your iceberg!!
