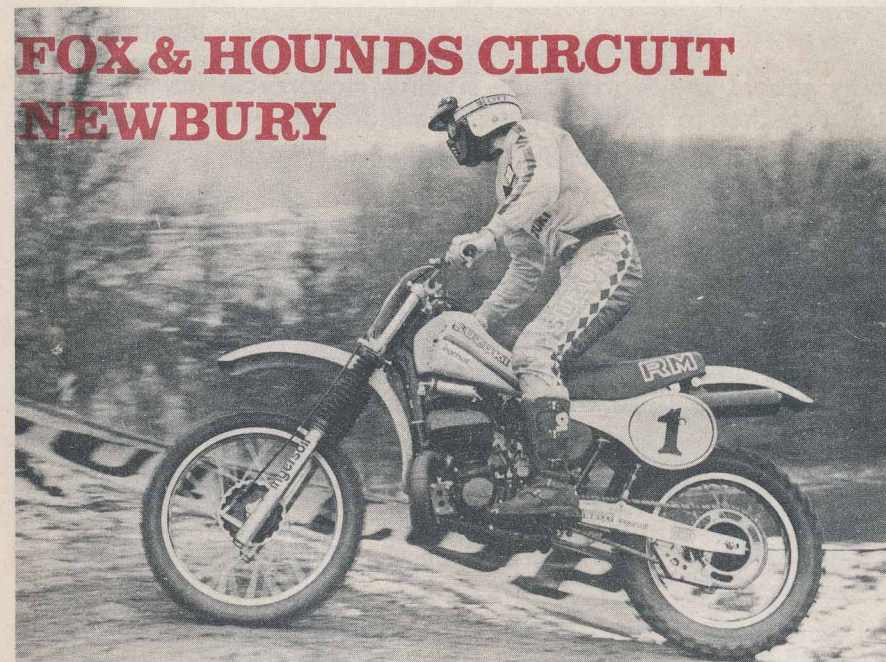

## BRITISH MOTO-CROSS CHAMPIONSHIP

INTRODUCTION by PAUL FOWLER (Motor Cycle News)

WELCOME to Newbury and Round 3 in the Moto-Cross battle of the giants. The clash between four times Champion Graham Noyce and his long time rival Neil Hudson has set the series alight and brought the fans to their feet.

Yamaha mounted Hudson and his Honda rival Noyce are so evenly matched and so far ahead of the rest of the pack in speed, skill and prowess that their tussle has almost attained a stature of a separate series. Quite simply they are in a class of their own.

After the opening round at Hawkstone Park, the dualling duo could not be separated on points, but at last weeks Nantwich encounter Hudson inched ahead to claim a slender 10 points advantage. Can Noyce claw back a deficit? ..... can Hudson consolidate his advantage? Can any other rider get on terms with the super fast pair who have turned the Championship into a private battle royal? You'll know all the answers by 6 o'clock this evening but one thing is sure, you're in for a matchless day of Moto Cross.

Reigning British Champion Geoff Mayes heads the following pack, albeit 55 points in arrears of Noyce, but the battle for his third place is certainly hotting up. Suzuki team mate Billy Aldridge on 48 points, is just two points behind No. 1 plate holder. Kawasaki 250 pilot Jonathan Wright is in turn 2 points behind Aldridge and 1980 runner up Dave Tomasik (KTM) another 2 points down in sixth,

Pete Mathia (Yamaha) and Bob Wright (Maico) share the seventh place with 40 points apiece, Scot Willie Simpson (Husqvarna) is ninth with 34 points and Maico's Rob Hooper completes the top ten, 4 points behind him.

In the all important Qualifying Championship Suzuki Jeremy Whatley is run away leader, 22 points ahead of Maico Gary Woolam. Scottish Maico man Cameron Knox is third on 32 points.
