"THE CLUB MEMBERS"

Probably the best known of our many members today is road racer **Tom Phillips**. During the winter he announced he was retiring to take up sponsorship, but I am glad to see he has changed his mind and is again to be seen around the circuits with a variety of machines including Aermacchi, Norton-Honda, Norton and Dunstall Domiracer. His first machine—a Norton/Triumph—Tom built himself. In the meantime he has raced Ray Petty's Nortons, Syd Lawton's Aermacchis, Paul Dunstall's machines and Vic Camp's Ducatis, besides his own Bultaco, Norton and Yamaha models. In 1963 riding the Frank Higley Greeves he won the 250c.c. A.C.U. road racing star (the forerunner of today's British championships). Other major successes have included 500c.c. class wins on the Geoff Dodkin Velocettes in the Brands Hatch 500-miler and the Barcelona 24 hours in 1966.

Almost as well, if not better, known must be **Peter Stirland** who made his name as a trials rider, both in the one-day and the six-days variety. In the former he scored four wins in the Southern Experts Trial, a record it needed Sammy Miller to equal. He also has a collection of Gold Medals for unpenalized performances in the International six-days Trial, to gain which he travelled to Poland, Germany, etc. During his long career he has been a works rider for James, Royal Enfield, B.S.A. and Greeves and is currently fashionably mounted on a Bultaco. He has also tried his hand at scrambling, mounted on a P.T.S. of his own manufacture, amongst other machines.

Tony Worthington is our most successful local expert scrambler. Today he is riding a 360c.c. Bultaco, but in the past has always supported the 250 class with Puch, Parilla and Greeves machines.

Lest it be thought that the club be split into 'competitors' and 'workers,' I should like to point out that Peter is often to be seen collecting gate money at our scrambles, Tom has acted as timekeeper and Tony assists with the course preparation.

Many ex riders are still active in the club affairs also. As an example, **Harry Argent** and **Pete Eacott** will be lap scoring today. In 1956 this dynamic duo all but won the 500c.c. class of the Thruxton 9-hour race for production machines, riding the former's privately owned and prepared Gold Star. These two will be assisted by **Pat Tanner** who in the old days used to act as pit attendant to them. So here is a team that has stuck together for many years.

If one man must be singled out as the driving force behind the growth of our scrambles over the past six years, then he would be club secretary ex-scrambler and moto-cross enthusiast supreme, **Dave Joyce**. In all the club business, particularly as secretary of these meetings, he is ably assisted by his attractive wife **Sally**, who is officially the club's Assistant Secretary.

In our case the term P.R.O. manages to include carpentering, painting, reporting to the press and performing cabaret at the annual dinner. You name it and it is ably done, accompanied by many a cheery quip, by our trouble shooter in chief, **Frank Flower**.

Ron Tarry is our persuasive Chairman. He usually acts as Club Steward and starter at our events, but his talents really come to the fore when keeping good natured order at enthusiastic club and committee meetings.

Treasurer **John Stanley** probably holds the most vital, but also the most tedious job in the club. The responsibility is very great when you consider that the turnover for just one of our meetings can easily run into four figures. In the past he has organised Sprint meetings at Membury and acted as chief instructor to our Newbury and District R.A.C./A.C.U. Training Scheme for learner motor cyclists.

Trials riders **Jim Randall** and **Stan Speller** between them run our very popular winter film shows. As well as this Jim is kept busy organising dances for us and ensuring that the club scrapbook is kept up to date, while Stan acts as the club recorder. These two also run the Newbury Trophy Trial.

Throughout the Southern and Wessex centres clerk of the course, **John Spanswick** is well known by his blue woollen bobble hat as he serves as marshal or observer at road races, scrambles, trials, etc. He has also acted as travelling marshal at Castle Coombe. Together with **Tony Weekes** he is joint editor of our "Newbury Newsletter" posted monthly to all members to keep them up to date with the club affairs.

Peter Hoult, junior, is now making a name for himself in both trials and scrambles, thereby following in the footsteps of his father—a former club Captain. Gaining much experience as a road racing sidecar driver of machines built by himself is **Bill Matthews**.

Keen junior scramblers and trials riders who do much hard work for the club include **Dave Tench**, **Colin Smith**, **Keith Chandler** and **Colin Bosley**.

Arch scrambles enthusiast and dedicated R.A.C./A.C.U. instructor **Bob Tucker** acts as machine examiner at all the various types of event we hold. In this responsible job he is ably assisted by **Dennis Huntley**.

Big John Dyson keeps order amongst enthusiastic competitors in his role as chief Paddock Marshal, despite being deeply occupied with his other great interest, Water Polo, throughout the summer. Last winter he has even been attempting to teach some of us club members the rudiments of correct swimming.

Skittles have proved very popular as a social activity amongst the members and their wives and girl friends, thanks to the efficient running of these evenings by **Pete Cooper**. Last year he also found the time to get married. Congratulations Pete!

Recently we have discovered in our midst a very efficient time-keeper, so some glamour has been added to the lap scorers' caravan in the shape of **Jean Cruse**. She also submits reports to our local newspaper.

Not all the members live close by. As well as the aforementioned J. Spanswick and T. Weekes, who both live at Marlborough, we have **Clive Chick** and **Cecil Withers** who regularly travel over 30 miles to attend working parties and club functions, from Andover.

We even number a Police motor-cycle patrolman amongst our keen and regular attenders—big **John Young**. Unfortunately his friend **John Field** has not been seen much lately following a road accident. Another stalwart for working parties and club evenings is veteran **Syd Apthorpe**, who regularly rides a motor-cycle on the road. (There are not many of us left today!).

I hope this brief introduction has given you an insight into the variety of our membership—my apologies to all those I have been unable to include. How about coming along to join us? We would be pleased to welcome you any Tuesday evening at the "Fox and Hounds" inn, right by the entrance to this circuit, where even the landlord **Dick Dent** is one of us by virtue of his interest in veteran motor-cycles.
