# The Motor Cycle British Moto Cross Championship

## THE RACE FOR THE NUMBER ONE PLATE

Can anyone stop Noyce?

That's the big question here at Nympsfield today, at this crucial fourth round of the Motor Cycle-sponsored British Moto Cross Championship.

The incredible 19-year-old Hampshire ace has pulled out a devastating 28-point lead in the series so far, and with five wins and one second place to show for six individual races, looks almost invincible.

The only man to take him so far, in just one race, is reigning Champion Vic Allan. Two years ago, he clinched his 250 cc British title on this circuit, and the flying Scot will be hoping to recapture his former success for the Stadium CCM team. He knows if Noyce runs away with top points here today, he will see the crown he has held for two years slipping from his fingers.

Noyce's only other threat must be 34-year-old Vic Eastwood, Allan's four-stroke team mate and so often hitting dynamic form on the day.

But another youngster to watch is Neil Hudson. Like Noyce, Maico mounted, and upsetting the established stars this year with his consistent and steady riding.

They are the four top performers in the series so far, though if you look down the entry list you'll see an impressive array of the nation's best moto crossers. All of them hungry for points, several could pull a surprise today. But the chances are it will be Noyce, Allan or Eastwood setting the circuit alight.

August 30th Stepaside, Tenby - Saundersfoot & DMCC  
October 10th Beenham Park, Reading - Mortimer Club  
October 17th Ladies' Mile, Chalton, Hants - Portsmouth MCRC
