The first Open Cotswold Scramble was held at Througham on the last Saturday in June, 1934, and today's event is the 11th meeting. It is now known as a "National" event under the new code of the F.I.M. and is open to competitors from any part of Great Britain.

Once again the entry list contains the names of practically all the most famous scramble riders, many of whom have represented Great Britain in International events both in this Country and abroad.

Much the best view of the racing is obtained from either of the spectators enclosures, the situations for which have been especially chosen to give a comprehensive picture of the start and finish and a large portion of the course.

The Course is 2½ miles in length and will be covered 8 times in the Junior and Senior races, 6 times in the Lightweight, and 4 times in the race for 150 c.c. machines. The course is extremely difficult and riders have to surmount a wide variety of obstacles. Severe gradients and descents follow in quick succession and there are sections of rocky surfaces, bogs, woodland tracks and a number of streams to cross.
