START

Union Jack or Green Flag to be used for handicap events, all other races to have an elastic type gate or approved starting gate

COMMENCING

Yellow flag with black diagonal stripes

LAST LAP

(FINISH) to be white with black squares

CHEQUERED FLAG

To be used only for stopping races and all riders should then stop and cut engine

RED FLAG

YELLOW FLAG

Caution do not overtake but take extreme care there may be someone injured on the circuit

BLACK FLAG

A rider signalled with a black flag should stop at once

BLUE FLAGS

For directing riders off the course after the finish of a race and practice

TRACK CLEAR

At end of race. When travelling marshal is not used, recommended that the Yellow and Red Flags be held overhead in a crossed position

WHITE WITH A

DIAGONAL RED CROSS

For attracting the First Aid to distant parts of the track

1984 CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFYING SYSTEM

250's - 750's

The A.M.C.A. Executive Committee have ruled that riders for the 250 and 750 1984 Championships must qualify in 1983 in these classes or have finished in the top 10 in the 1983 - 250 and 750 Championships. 1983 Licence Holders unable to qualify through injury may be given a second chance to qualify at the start of the 84 Season but these riders must inform the Office immediately that they are injured.

125's

Any rider who qualifies in the 125 class will not be able to change classes into the 250 or 750 for 1984.

4 STROKES

Four stroke riders for 84 should have informed the Office if they wish to do this Championship which will be for Experts only and will not be open to riders who have attempted to qualify for any other class.

SUPER CLASS

In 1984 it is hoped to run the Super Class at the end of the season open to the top 1984 finishers in all the solo classes and riders are able to change machines to a different capacity to the one on which they qualified on for the Super Class.

NOISE LIMITS 4 STROKES

As from October 2nd any 4 stroke machines over the noise level will be banned, the ruling has been relaxed during September to enable riders to conform. Silencers that do conform to the rules can be supplied by
