RIDING IN THE PADDOCK

Once again attention is drawn to the serious consequences which could arise following an accident caused by unauthorised riding of any sort of machine in the Paddock.

All too frequently at meetings children are allowed to ride machines in the mistaken belief that because a race paddock is on private property and outside the jurisdiction of the Road Traffic Act, no insurance is necessary. It cannot be stressed too strongly that liability for a substantial claim could rest with the owners of the vehicle and the driver. (Or the parent in the case of a minor.)

The Union's insurers will quite legitimately repudiate any claim on them for damages arising out of the accident caused by an unauthorised driver.


Just to keep the action flowing, invited expert riders also do battle on this fast demanding circuit.
