The SMCA of GB was formed in 1990 with a whole series of aims which are still relevant today. The priority aims are:

- To promote sidecar motocross in the UK at all levels
- To improve communications between riders, organisers, supporters and the press by newsletters, press releases etc.
- 3. To increase public awareness of sidecarcross by advertising both locally and nationally.
- To assist clubs, where possible, in the running of sidecar events.
- To organise social events

So how are they meeting those aims?

- The SMCA promotes the Clubman's Sidecarcross Championships on behalf of the ACU. That entails identifying tracks and organisers prepared to run rounds, writing the rules, recording the results and liaising with the ACU. The SMCA advises the ACU on sidecarcross matters.
- For the last two seasons the SMCA promoted and ran the British Sidecarcross Championship, handing back to the ACU a vibrant and well supported championship.
- The SMCA currently produces a newsheet for its members, also available electronically; has its own website: http://www.smcgab.com; and SMCA members provide many of the write-ups for both international and UK meetings printed in T&MX and other publications.

- 5 An annual awards evening is organised by the SMCA.

Any Club is only as strong as its membership; new faces bringing new ideas are always needed to meet the changing aspirations of competitors and organisers and to ensure that the Association remains relevant to those it represents. It is a fact that without the efforts of a few dedicated SMCA members the current National Championships are likely to have had far fewer rounds and a decreasing number of clubs prepared to run sidecar classes. Supplementary Regulations

Practice: Experts, Juniors

Minimum 2 laps free practice. A board at the finish line will indicate that timed training has commenced (approx 2 laps)

Juniors seeding to races: 1st 33% from timed training in each group to Junior A. next 33% from timed training in each group to Junior B and the remainder to Junior C.

Start Line Positions: Experts as per timed training results. Juniors alternate positions from timed training results of Group 1, 2 and 3.

Timed Training times and race results will be printed out and displayed at the signing on container. (There are no monitors).

Abandonment or Cancellation




