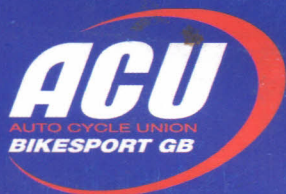

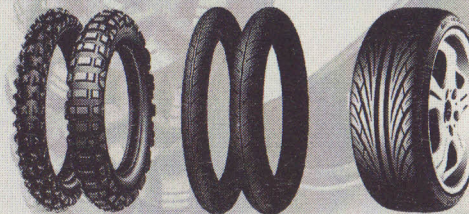

Maxxis British Sidecarcross Championships 2013

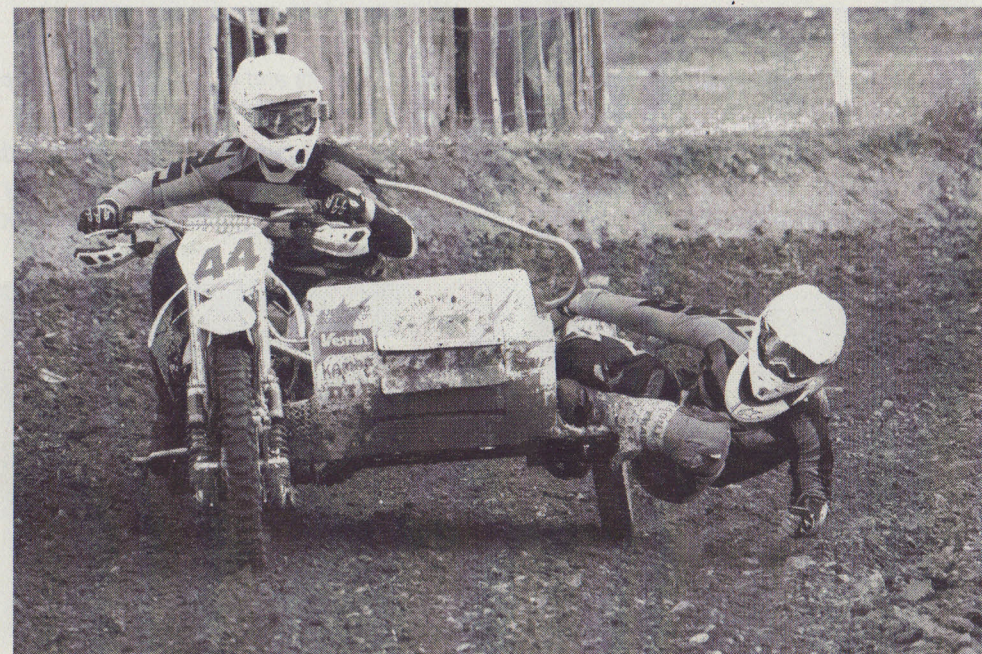
Defending champions Stuart Brown / Josh Chamberlain maintained their tremendous form of recent weeks at last weekend's fifth round of the championship by winning all three races which means they have clinched the title for this year. It also gave Stuart his eleventh championship win overtaking ten times winner, Chris Etheridge from Maidstone. When this is added to their world championship results when they finished sixth it has been one of their best years to date

Although the championship is now decided the racing at Wakes Colne last week has meant that the fight for the minor placings is now really on. Wilkinson / Parmenter are currently in second place but now they are only seven points in front of third placed Jenkins / Chamberlain. Jenkins had dropped to sixth place after a disastrous day at Grittenham in July when they came away with just eighteen points but three second places at Wakes Colne has brought them back into contention.

Just eight points behind Jenkins are Jack Etheridge / Scott Grahame who are just one point ahead of the hard charging France brothers, Steve and Stewart. Also in with a mathematical chance of a top three finish are Nick Jarvis / Ryan Humphrey who are eighteen points behind France but recent machine reliability problems need to be improved if they are to challenge those above them.

These five crews will be fighting it out in the three motos at Canada Heights in the hope that they can get onto the second or third step of the podium in the final classifications.

Although the championship has been reduced from seven rounds to five because of cancellations the racing has been as good as ever and we hope that will continue in this final round.

JOB VACANCIES in the SE MX Timing Team

The current timing team of Liz Argent, Carol Reeves and Lucy Watson are retiring at the end of this year and we need to recruit replacements. Ideally we would like volunteers immediately so the present team can train them over the rest of this season's meetings.

The timing team are required to be at every SE Centre MX event during the season to handle the hiring of transponders on the day, produce times for timed training and time and produce a set of race results for the meeting, finally posting them up on the My Laps website.

The job descriptions of the present team are listed below:-

- Storage of the equipment between meetings, bringing the equipment to the meeting and setting up including the timing loop.
- Liaising with the organising club on the event entry list and inputting the data prior to the meeting.
- 2 x timing operatives on the day responsible for timed training, printing the results and working out allocations to races and overall positions.
- Posting the meeting results on the My Laps website.
- Liaising with the organising club on which riders require to hire transponders on the day.
- Issue and collect back transponders for hire on the day of the event. Collect monies due, pay the travel expenses due to the team plus any consumables and finally bank the residue of the monies.

The Timing Team plays an important role in modern MX events and to make sure we keep a high standard there is a generous remuneration of "travelling expenses" on offer.
