Additional Notices

- **Crossing the Course:** Under no circumstances should anyone (other than marshals) cross the course whilst racing is in progress.
- **Control of exhaust sound level:** The Clerk of the Course may exclude any machine which exceeds the maximum permitted sound level, or which in his opinion is deemed to be excessively noisy. Sound checks will be conducted by an official throughout the meeting.
- **Unauthorised riding:** The riding of machines of any sort in the paddock and areas surrounding the circuit is totally forbidden. Because the event is on private property it does not place it outside the Road Traffic Act in terms of insurance. It cannot be stressed too strongly, that liability for a substantial claim could rest with the owners of the vehicle and the driver (or parents in the case of a minor) in the event of an accident.

Course Length 1.8 km

- **Points Scoring System:**
The following scoring will be used for all disciplines - 25 22 20 18 16 15 14 13 12 11 10 etc down to 1.
- **Abandonment or Cancellation:**
The organisers reserve the right, subject to the approval of the Stewards of the Meeting, to cancel, postpone or abandon the competition if circumstances should arise which, in their opinion render such action necessary.

This is an ACU National competition held under the National Sporting Code and the Standing Regulations of the Auto Cycle Union together with any supplementary regulations issued by the promoting club.

FLAG SIGNALS

Red..... Danger all riders to stop
Black with riders number..... That rider to stop immediately
Yellow Static..... Danger, take care, drive slowly
Yellow Waved..... Great danger, prepare to stop, no overtaking
Green..... Course Clear
Yellow with diagonal black cross..... Last Lap
Chequered..... Finish

Any rider not obeying flag signals will be excluded.
Riding in the paddock is forbidden. Offenders will take no further part in the meeting.

RIDERS NUMBERS

Regulation size. One in front, plus one each side, following colours:

MX2 up to 125 two stroke/250 four stroke

Black plates with white numbers

MX1 250 two stroke/450 four stroke

White plates with black numbers

Sidecars yellow plates with black numbers

Make sure your numbers are readable – remember the lap scorers.

British Quad Championship

Today's meeting features the final round of the **ATV's Only British Quad Championship** and the action promises to be hard fought with four riders still in with a mathematical chance of taking the prestigious ACU title.

Realistically though it's a two-horse race between series leader, Mark McLernon, from Hillsborough in Northern Ireland and Harrogate's Paul Holmes, who have been locked in a titanic battle throughout the six round series.

In the first half of the series, 28 years old Holmes, the current title holder and three times a British Champion, looked to be on course to retain his title after wins at the opening round at Cusses Gorse in April and a devastating maximum at round three at Fat Cats.

However, McLernon, who took victory at the second round at his home track of Desertmartin, has turned the tables in recent months with victory at round four at Pontrilas and then round five at Dean Moor.

That has left 21 years old McLernon leading by 36 points, and with 75 points available from today's three 20 minute plus two lap races, he could theoretically clinch the title in race one. Don't bet against the highly experienced Holmes, an ex-European champion, taking it to the wire though!

Two other riders – Justin Reid from Comber in Northern Ireland and Reading's Carl Bunce – have a very remote chance of taking the title if disaster befalls the leaders.

However, the pair are more likely to be focused on their titanic battle for the final podium spot. Former British Champion Reid, now one of the veterans of the series at 38, holds just a five-point advantage over 30 years old Bunce, a multiple runner-up in the series.

Fifth in the series is 21 years old Leon Rogers from Navan in the Republic of Ireland, a heat winner at the last round at Dean Moor. However his priority will be to clinch the Willcock Holeformers Under 21 British Championship, which he leads by 46 points.

The only man who can overhaul him is fellow 21 years old, Luke Cooper from Beddau in Wales, also a heat winner this year.

The battle for third in the Under 21 looks set to be a tough one, with just 15 points separating a trio of 17 year olds, Dafydd Davies who has already been crowned the Rookie of the Year, and Harry Walker and James Bevan.

Today's action also features several Wildcard riders. The Wildcards best placed to cause an upset are likely to be Dutchman, Marc de Vries, who was fifth in this year's European Championship, and the sixth placed finisher, Zdenek Polacek, from the Czech Republic.

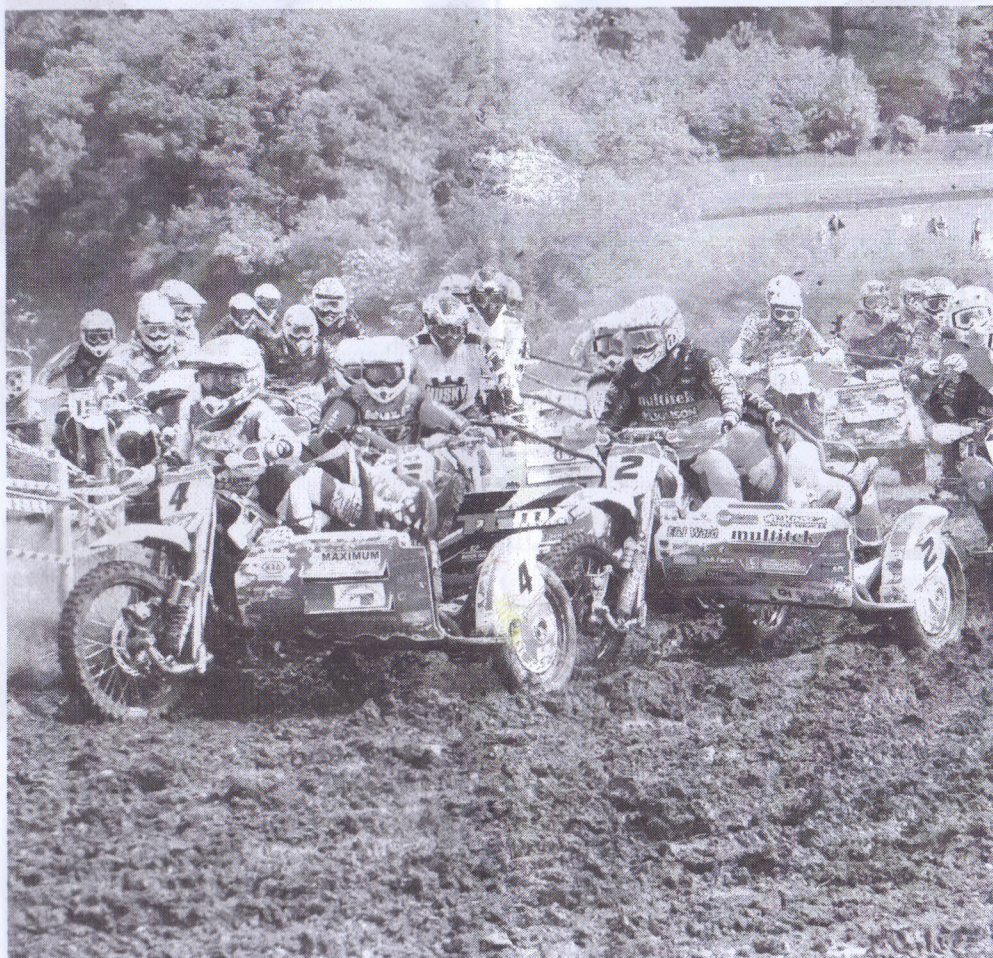
