## *Welcome Race Fans*

Welcome to Canada Heights for our 2017 Motocross season finale featuring the final Maxxis British Sidecarcross Championship, The ACU British Quad Championship and 2 groups of support Solos.

After five rounds of the 2017 Maxxis British Sidecarcross championships defending champion Stuart Brown and his passenger Joe Millard hold a comfortable lead of thirty two points over Brett Wilkinson / Dan Chamberlain. Stuart and Joe haven't been beaten in England since the end of May and appear to be on track to give Stuart his fifteenth title and Joe his first.

Wilkinson / Chamberlain have got over their mid season injuries and also by changing from Mega engines to Zabel their machine reliability problems have gone away. They will be trying their hardest this weekend to win but Brown might have other ideas.

In third place is the Irish driver Gary Moulds with his English passenger Steve Kirwin who since they teamed up at the beginning of this year have surprised a lot of people with their performances. They won the opening round and have been in third place since round two when they suffered mechanical problems in race two and did not score. Not only are they in third place they also lead the Experts class which is contested in the same races. Only four points behind Moulds are King / Humphrey.

With both the Elite and Experts titles still up for grabs the racing should be highly competitive and may the best man win.

The final British Quad round here at Canada Heights is going to be a nail biter, Mark McLernon has accumulated a 1 point lead over the Dominant Paul Holmes who's taken 8 wins from this years possible 15 races, and it's all to play for the last Championship podium step with David Cowan sitting there with a 13 point lead over Carl Bunce, who's unfortunately had two dnf's this season but close too are last years U21 Champion Leon Rogers with Justin Reid some 18 points behind him so all to play for to get the last spot on the podium in the Main Quad Class.

Don't forget after the meeting riders and spectators can reflect on times, positions and overall positions using the MyLaps website or the new MYLAPS Speedhive app on your iPhone or Android device.

- **Crossing the Course:** Under no circumstances should anyone (other than marshals) cross the course whilst racing is in progress.
- **Control of exhaust sound level:** The Clerk of the Course may exclude any machine which exceeds the maximum permitted sound level, or which in his opinion is deemed to be excessively noisy. Sound checks will be conducted by an official throughout the meeting.
- **Unauthorised riding:** The riding of machines of any sort in the paddock and areas surrounding the circuit is totally forbidden. Because the event is on private property it does not place it outside the Road Traffic Act in terms of insurance. It cannot be stressed too strongly, that liability for a substantial claim could rest with the owners of the vehicle and the driver (or parents in the case of a minor) in the event of an accident.

- **Points Scoring System:**  
The following scoring will be used for all disciplines - 25 22 20 18 16 15 14 13 12 11 10 etc down to 1.
- **Abandonment or Cancellation:**

Yellow with diagonal black cross..... Last Lap  
Chequered..... Finish

Any rider not obeying flag signals will be excluded. Riding in the paddock is forbidden. Offenders will take no further part in the meeting.






