Welcome to Canada Heights for our 2018 Motocross season finale featuring the final Maxxis British Sidecarcross Championship, The ACU British Quad Championship and 2 groups of support Solos.

Today we have round five of the 2018 Maxxis British sidecarcross championships with nearly all the county's top riders taking part. Unfortunately the defending champions Stuart Brown / Joe Millard will not be racing today as Stuart is not fully recovered from injury sustained at the end of July. Therefore for the first time in eleven years we will be crowning a new champion if not today then certainly at the final round next weekend.

The favourites to take the title and unbeaten in the last six races are Brett Wilkinson / Dan Chamberlain. They are forty nine points ahead of Ireland's Gary Moulds and his passenger Steve Kirwin. In the experts class which is contested within the same races the newly crowned Clubmans champions Scott Balsillie / Josh Haynes are leading from the vastly experienced Rob Oldfield / Faye Barnes. With three twenty minute races to be contested let's hope for fast competitive racing which the Canada Heights circuit usually provides.

The allcomer Solos will be out in force with the Juniors giving the Experts a hard time as they go for bragging rights, watch out for Shaun Springer the ex South East Champion who returns from injury and will be out to conquer the demanding Canada Heights track again.

Don't forget after the meeting riders and spectators can reflect on times, positions and overall positions using the MyLaps website or the new MYLAPS Speedhive app on your iPhone or Android device.

Part of each Allcomer group's Practice session will be timed to decide the qualifiers for Groups A and B.

The fastest 50% from Q1 and Q2 will form the A Group. The remainder will form the B Group.

Unauthorised Riding

The riding of machines of any sort in the paddock and areas surrounding the circuit is totally forbidden. Because the event is on private property it does not place it outside the Road Traffic Act in terms of insurance. Quad Championship

Unusually as the finale has historically has always been at Canada Heights over the last few years. This is meeting is now to be the 'penultimate' round due to the failed and rescheduled Quad and Sidecar round at Foxhills now for 14th October

Holmes (233) will be looking to get closer to seal his fifth British title, and protecting his lead of 35 points from both Leon Rogers (198) and Harry Walker (184) in second and third respectively. Both lads are both showing promising form after recently representing their respective countries in the recent Qxon in Denmark where the Irish team claimed the runner up spot behind USA, with UK fifth. The Irish contenders Rogers, Reid and McLernon can all change affairs at the top of the leader board.

After Reid's joint top scoring spot at Round 5 in Deanmoor Cumbria, Callaway (178) whose form had gained in the sand recently is firmly sat in fourth place and will also be someone to watch. The fast starting young gun Daffyd Davies will always be the one to mix it up in front of these guys with his ability to get awesome starts.

The under 21's now headed by Walker after his recent clean sweep at Deanmoor and overall win on 241 points. With Scotsman, Murray Graham second with 228 points and Welshman Davies third with 224 points this category has changed after every meeting and is looking to be a true international affair with Irish Rookie Dean Dillon sat in fourth position.

Wildcards in the form of Ayrton Knowles, Tom Chell, Rhydian Owen and 'young gun' Zak Orchard (just 17 years old September) plus Geoff Otway will make up the numbers to fill the field and make an interesting days racing.
