MCN / Duckhams Superbike

Barry Sheene returns to the scene of so many of his great Superbike triumphs when he wheels out his Akai Yamahas at the Oliver's Mount circuit. Sheene's battles a few seasons ago at Scarborough against local hero Mick Grant are almost a legend at this twisty hillside test of men and machinery, Sheene was then Suzuki mounted and Grant on a 3 cylinder Kawasaki, their battles for points in Britain's most important road race series caused fierce loyalties amongst the crowd even to the point of Barry complaining of fist waving and insult hurling by Grant's fans. The two men clash again today in the 2 leg MCN/Duckhams Superbike round but they both probably have more intense competition than that of 2 or 3 years ago. Dave Potter leads the series from fellow 750 Yamaha riders Roger Marshall, Ron Haslam and Keith Huewen, the big fight will be between Marshall and Potter, only 15 points separate them. a slender margin with 15 points available in each leg for a win, Sheene cannot trouble them in the points as he has not contested the series as a whole this year, and Ron Haslam, traditionally, does not ride at the circuit where his brother Phil was killed. So, make Sheene the favourite to win with his undoubted ability and a new confidence in his new Yamahas he has struggled with at times this year, and with his determination to do well in front of his home fans. Potter and Marshall will both be out to beat each other and to stay at the top of the table and if their own battle is hard enough could upset Barry's ambitions. There is no threat from American whiz-kid Randy Mamola at this Superbike round he did not show much enthusiasm for the Oliver's Mount circuit and failed to enter the meeting despite Suzuki's claims to be out to capture the series, but there are still threat aplenty from a field that contains the best talent in Britain, and some more builders in the shape of work's Honda rider Takazumi Katayama, Takazumi had hoped to bring the NR 500 Honda to the Scarborough hills, but this was vetoed by Honda and it looks as though the Japanese ace, as his team mate Mick Grant, will have to ride his own 500 Suzuki, but that's not all! Huewen is emerging as one of our top racers and at 22 can, with some World Championship points under his belt, count himself as Britain's highest prospect for major honours. He lies fourth in the points, 49 behind leader Potter, and just look at the rest of the line-up., Steve Parrish, Steve Manship, Graeme McGregor, Steve Cull, Steve Henshaw, Phil Mellor. Points are scored – 15, 12, 10, 8, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1, in each leg with a 5 point bonus for the best overall scorer.

Up to date positions – Potter 129, Marshall 114, Haslam 92, Huewen 80, Mamola 74, Wood 48, Newbold 42, Guy 38, Grant 31, Sheene 30, Manship 14, Hartog 12.

Motorcycle Racing/Vladivar 250

It's a fact that the Motorcycle Racing Vladivar Vodka 250 Series is the most wide open championship on the British international calendar as it reaches it's sixth round here at Scarborough this weekend.

There has been a different winner at each of the five rounds completed, so with just two rounds to go after the Olivers Mount event anyone in the top ten at least has a good chance of claiming the £1,500 first place in the Series cash prize that is in addition to the prize money and bonus payments made at each round.

Last year's winner and reigning champion Aussie Graeme McGregor still has only 15 points following his third round win at Donington Park in June and Charlie Williams the man who followed him home last year and was tipped as the most likely winner this time has only 12 gained in a second place ride at Oulton Park on August Bank Holiday Monday.

Team Mitsui Yamaha rider, Williams was looking for a maximum score on his home circuit but admitted after a close race that he was beaten by the sheer power of the British built, Austrian Rotax powered Cotton, ridden, by winner Clive Horton.

It was the first score in the Series for the Team Appleby Glade rider but certainly not the first success for the Cotton concern.

Surprise leader of the Series at the present time, Ulsterman Stephen Cull won the second round North West 200 event on his Cotton to get his first points and he was followed over the line by three other Cotton riders, Tony Rutter, Chas Mortimer and Derek Huxley.

The first round of the third MCR Vladivar Vodka Series was won by yet another Cotton rider Steve Tonkin at Cadwell Park in May, and he added to his chances with a hard fought third place at Oulton Park after getting semi involved in a first bend, first lap tangle and getting baulked on the line by a slow starter.

The Oulton Park tangle at Old Hall ruined Chas Mortimer's hopes of regaining the Series trophy that he won in its first year in 1978.

Involved with three other riders in the incident that certainly was not his fault, Mortimer was looking for a first three placing to keep himself firmly in the hunt but ended the day in hospital with a broken left leg.

Oulton also produced another blow for McGregor who rushed back overnight from the West German GP at Nurburgring to contest the event on his Cotton.

This went on to one cylinder on the warm-up lap and despite a plug change there was no improvement and he was unable to get into the race, a slightly worse situation than the one that struck Cull who stopped during the first lap with ignition failure.

McGregor's retention hopes took a knock right at the start when he took a tumble at the Cadwell hairpin on the first lap of his qualifying heat while trying to make up time from being last off the line. On that occasion he elected to race his Yamaha because the Cotton he now rides was in early stages of development.

The same meeting also marked the start of a nightmare year for Mitsui Yamaha rider Williams who returned from the warm up lap for his heat to find that the clutch centre retaining bolt had dropped off.

Steve Henshaw, last year's winner of the best newcomer to the Series award was second on his Harold Coppuck sponsored Yamaha in that first round after a close battle with Horton on his Cotton, that ended as a half a front wheel over the line affair.

Cull built up on his North West victory with second place to McGregor — then on a Cotton — in the third round Donington event and then in a wet fourth round at Snetterton in July it was yet another colonial newcomer who kept up the different winner every round routine.

The rider was 19-year-old Graeme Geddes from Australia who was riding his fourth and last European race this season at Snetterton. It was a fitting and convincing end to an

experimental trip from his homeland to see if he liked racing over here and if he was cut out for any kind of success.

If nothing else that first place convinced him to come to Europe for a full 1981 season.

Another Series newcomer Frenchman Alain Gouin was second at Snetterton ahead of Mortimer who added to his score and set himself up with a chance once again after being a non starter in the previous Donington round because he could not come to a financial agreement with the organisers.

Yet again at Snetterton the favourites were in trouble with McGregor and Williams both pulling out of the race with mechanical troubles.

Machine trouble had already put Williams out of the North West round that he looked set to win in the absence of McGregor who decided to give that one a miss so that he could contest the Italian GP.

The pair did get together to battle it out in the third round Donington event but while the Aussie grabbed his first and only points so far in the Series Williams did what he rarely does and crashed.

Best prospect at the moment of the up and coming award is Lincolnshire's Pete Hubbard who is being guided towards the top by racer Jack Macin.

With all the top contestants in action at Scarborough there could well be a major breakthrough but it does seem that this MCR Vladivar Vodka Series is going to be a battle to the end.

It certainly has grabbed the imagination of sponsors Vladivar Vodka from Warrington, Cheshire, who have already agreed to be involved for a fourth time in 1981.

Already plans are in hand to make the championship that did much to help 250cc class racing survive in this country even more lucrative next year with increases in final prize money and race by race bonus payouts.

Motorcycle Racing and Vladivar Vodka have plumped for the 250cc class because all concerned feel that it not only brings the top international riders to British circuits but also gives the future hopefuls the chance to gain recognition and win some all important cash.

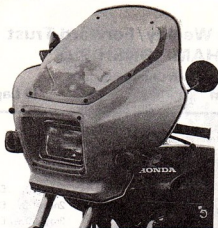
