PHIL READ - BARRY SHEENE TEPI LANSIVUORI - MICK GRANT BARRY DITCHBURN - BILL CURRIE MAC HOBSON - GERRY BORET & CO.,

WELCOME once again to Oulton Park and phew!! what a summer and superb racing with records being smashed all over the place. So much can happen in the course of a year including that disasterous Easter week-end, long since forgotten, but other incidents have a habit of sticking with us. It is a year less a day that Peter Williams had his disasterous prang and as we all know he has, with great courage stuck to the business of making a full recovery and back to his great love of motor cycle racing. While still having trouble with his left arm Peter was at Brands Hatch Hutchinson 100 Meeting and with another invalid Mike Hailwood handed over the giant Mellano Trophy to the incredible Barry Sheene still not 100% fit after his 170 m.p.h. crash at Daytona. Barry like Peter was determined to get back into the game and what a fantastic season he has had including two wins in the World 500 c.c. Championship Series. His four victories at Brands and particularly that over Phil Read in the Shellsport Championship together with his recent Silverstone win over Barry Ditchburn will long be remembered. So too will the fact that Phil, Barry and Tepi Lansivuori were racing in the final round of the World Championship Series in Czechoslovakia just 24 hours ago. To-day we greet Phil as still the World Champion or commiserate with him on missing his 'hat-trick'. With such riders as Phil, Barry and Peter setting an example to the up-and-coming young-sters there should be little wrong with this racing game for many years to come. The newcomers, however, must remember that even these three and a lot more of the top-liners all started from scratch and had a long haul before they could claim the start money that they now so richly deserve.

By this meeting a year ago Barry Sheene had the Motor Cycle News Superbike and Shellsport Championships pretty well sewn up—now he has to work very hard if he is to retain his titles for with the victories at Brands he is still only in third position in each competition. Mick Grant (55 points) and Barry Ditchburn (44) lead Barry (32) in the Superbike series. The Kawasaki riders proved at Silverstone that

they really are a force to be reckoned with and with Tepi Lansivuori, Pat Mahoney, John Newbold, Kork Ballington in the lineup to-day's race could be quite a cracker. With maybe, that 100 m.p.h. lap.

The battle for the 500 c.c. Shellsport Championship is really hotting up now that the current leader is out of action. Austin Hockley with 25 points was injured recently in Holland and a report suggests that he may have to give up racing altogether. This is extremely bad luck particularly as he was just coming to the fore. Steve Manship is second with 19 points followed by Barry Sheene (16), Phil Read (14) and Bob Heath (12). This by the way before yesterdays meeting at Snetterton, missed by both Barry and Phil. This could be a bit of a revenge race with Phil out to reverse the recent Brands placings, anyway we must not overlook the presence of Grant, Newbold, Charlie and John Williams, Lansivuori, Ditchburn and Alan North.

What a line-up there should be for the final of the Motor Cycle International Sidecar Championship with all of the leading point scorers in action. There was a round of this at Snetterton and before that the title holder Bill Currie currently leads the list with 24 points. Mac Hobson, now we hope fully recovered from the 'Dutch' incident together with Trevor Ireson are on 20. George O'dell who put up such a great show at Silverstone comes next followed by Steve Sinnott and Derek Jones. This bunch together with Gerry Boret, Dick Greasley, Roy Hanks, Dick Hawes and Co., could produce some new race and lap times providing the weather is kind. The South African duo of Kork Ballington, who likes this circuit, and Alan North should be seen well to the fore in both Lightweight and Junior Championships with perhaps Tony Rutter, Bob Heath, Ray McCullough and that regular Swiss visitor Gyula Marsovszky also taking a hand.

The names listed in the following pages should provide a thrilling afternoon's racing. What more can you ask? Keep your fingers crossed for the weather and take care on the way home for there is going to be an enormous amount of traffic about.

MOTOR CYCLE NEWS 'Superbike' Championship

(after 4 rounds - Cadwell Park, Brands Hatch (2), Mallory Park)

Barry Sheene arrives here today by helicopter with his GP Suzuki team mate Tepi Lansivuori straight from the Czechoslovakian GP to challenge the impressive Kawasaki team of Mick Grant and Barry Ditchburn, currently first and second in this year's exciting series.

The Suzuki stars are making the overnight dash from the Czech Brno circuit to make sure they get full practice before the important race battle for points.

Sheene needs Tepi's help and a lot of hard riding if he is to beat the very quick green meanies in the championship and take the M.C.N. title for the third year running.

The full Suzuki force of four is made up with young John Newbold and Stan Woods, both keen to improve on their fourth and sixth places respectively in the big money series.

But the abundance of work's machinery does not rule out the chance of victory for one of the hard riding, Yamaha-mounted privateers.

Dave Potter is the highest placed of these in fifth spot with Ted Broad's 750 four Yamaha, with Tony Nash seventh on Colin Wade's similar model.

Pat Mahoney ties with Dave Croxford despite only scoring in one round on the Clean Walls machine, and "Dave the Rave" is likely to be on Les William's 870 Triumph Trident.

Dark horses in this fifth round of the championship could well be Kork Ballington, the English based South African who rides Sid Griffith's 700 Yamaha, and Jim Harvey, making an impressive comeback this year on a similar machine.
