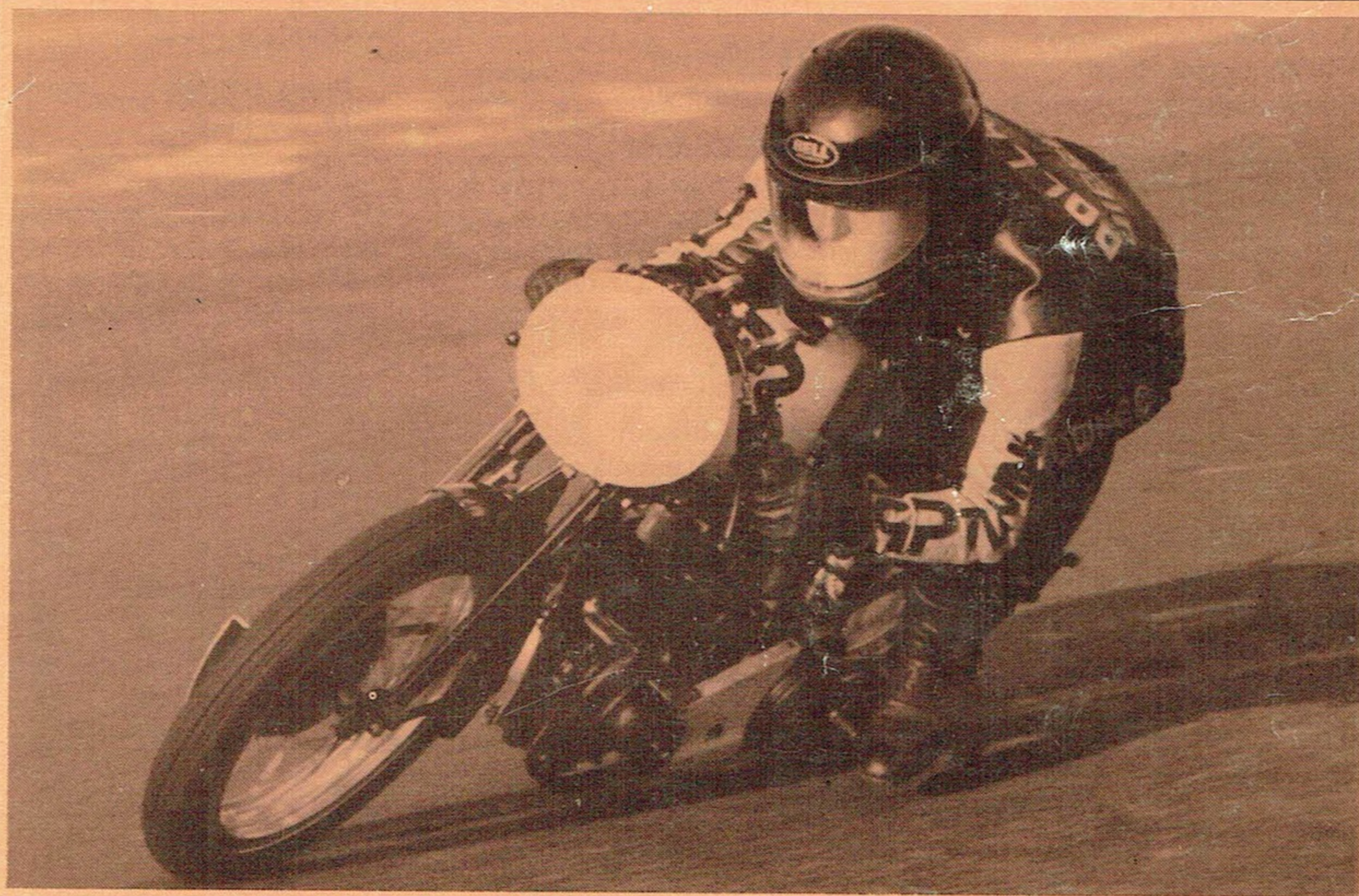

Welcome everyone to Oulton Park and the Vintage Motor Cycle club's third championship meeting of the season.

My first involvement with the Vintage club was in 1985 when I was asked by Kim Wilkinson to be the club's race commentator and my services began at the two day September Cadwell Park meeting the same year. My duties as a commentator takes me to circuits up and down the country assisted by my Father Bill, who is my lap scorer (today we are assisted by our Oulton regular lap scorer Roger Baston).

I really enjoy the friendliness of the people involved in the Vintage club and certainly enjoy broadcasting to the public all the gossip connected with the riders and their machines, everybody rallies around and helps each other like one big happy family.

To me the meetings are a good social gathering such as the many times when I go to the nearest pub to the circuits we are at with the men or ladies who thrill us with their antics on the race circuit.

As for today's meeting I am sure we shall see not only some close and exciting racing, but also some quick laps recorded on machines such as the Triumph Tiger, BSA, Velocette, Rudge and Norton to name just a few and the Oulton Park circuit is in good condition especially since the resurfacing work that was carried out over the winter months.

Oulton is my favorite circuit to actually do the commentaries at and the new commentary position at the start and finish offers a superb view.

As for the riders to watch this afternoon there is undoubtedly an enormous amount of talented solo riders such as Derek Pollard (five times a VMCC champion), David Witt (Current 500 champion), Reg Bolton (the leading standard class rider) and the beautifully prepared 1926 500 Sunbeam 90 ridden by John Grew (No. 140), the oldest Vintage racing machine.

In the Threewheelers and Sidecars there is Chris Williams with today his Brough, Bill and Maggie Tuer, Greg Bibby/Ian Bain on their Morgans, Karl Wheeldon/Nick Burton and Andy Molnar/Kim Wilkinson all whom always feature so well but there is obviously far more good two and three wheel participants.

I would finally like to thank all the Officials, Marshalls, medical people, and any other willing volunteers for their support here at Oulton today with the Vintage motorcycle club, without these people we would not have any racing at all.

Lets hope the weather is kind to us all and that all the spectators present enjoy the racing and hopefully my commentary adds to it.

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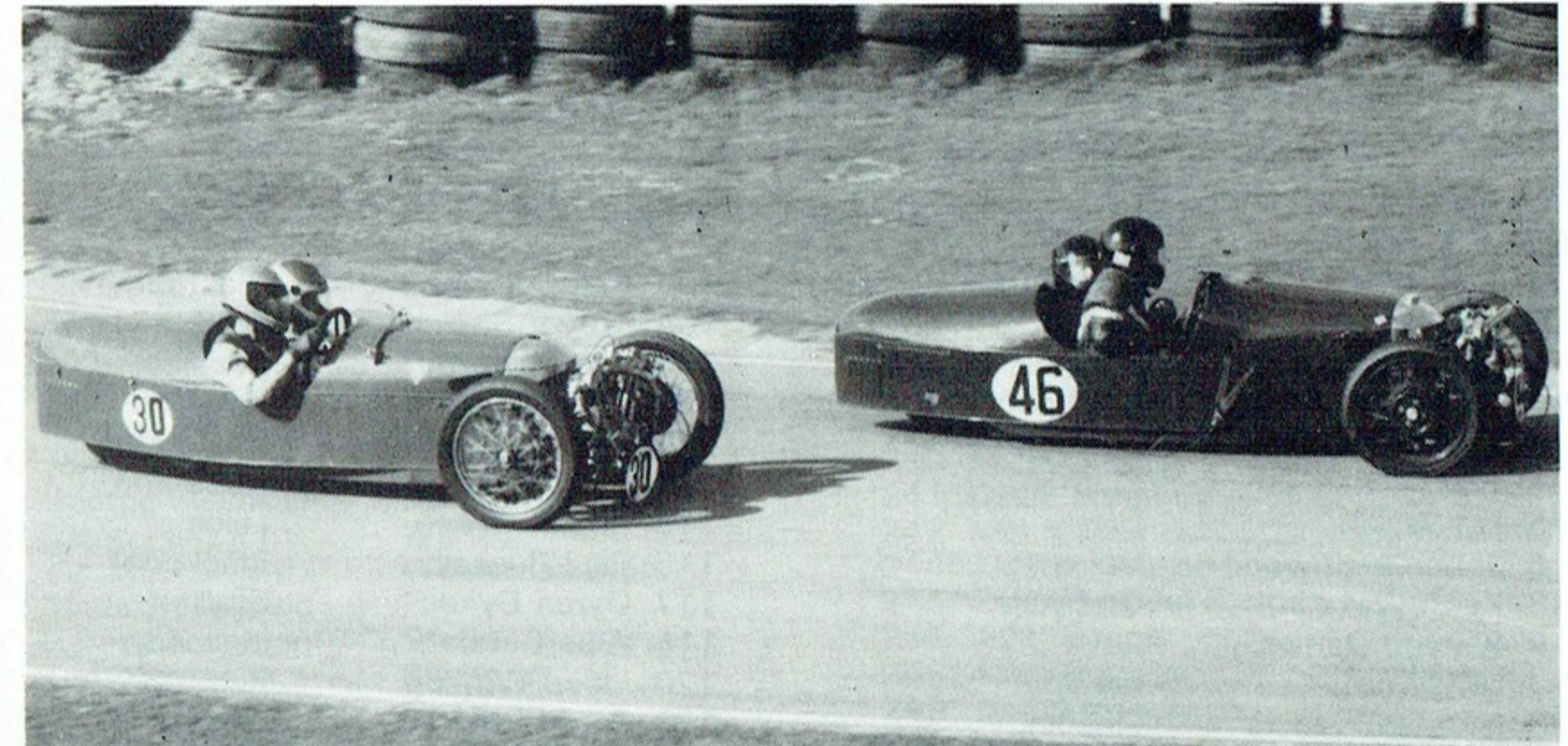

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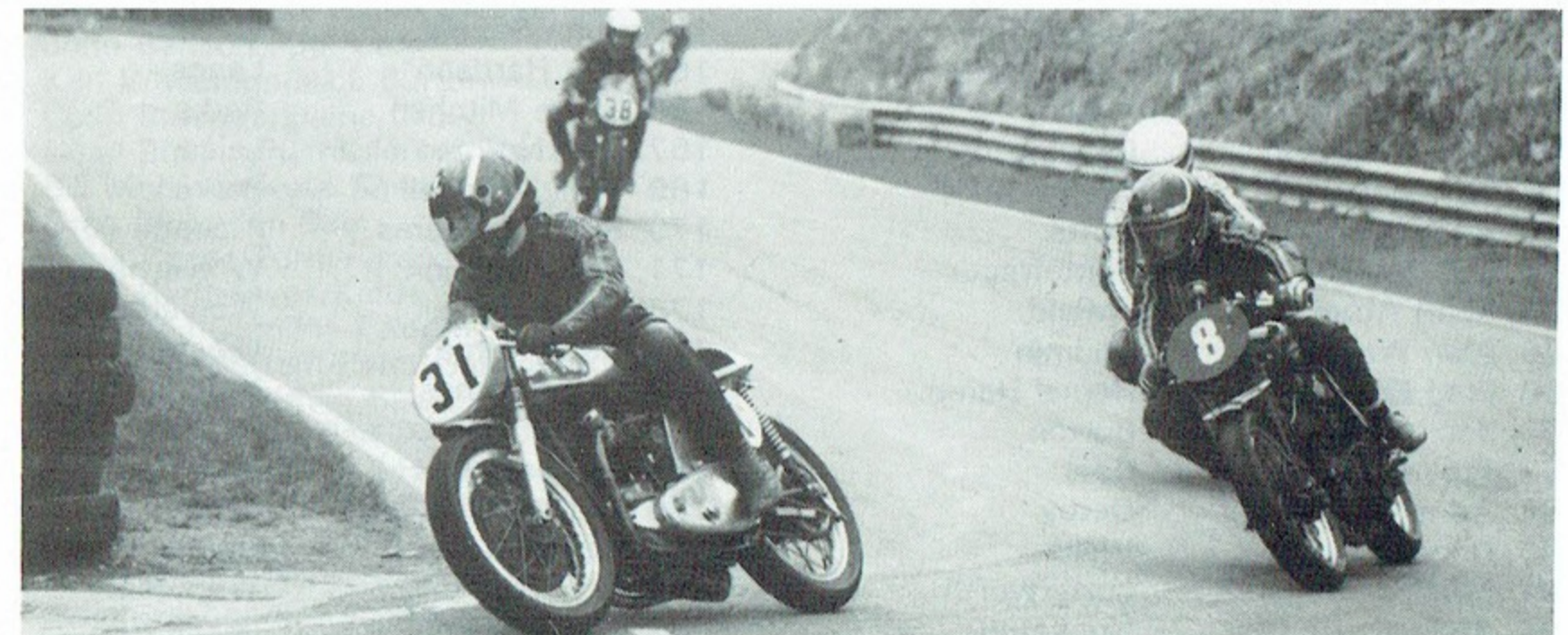

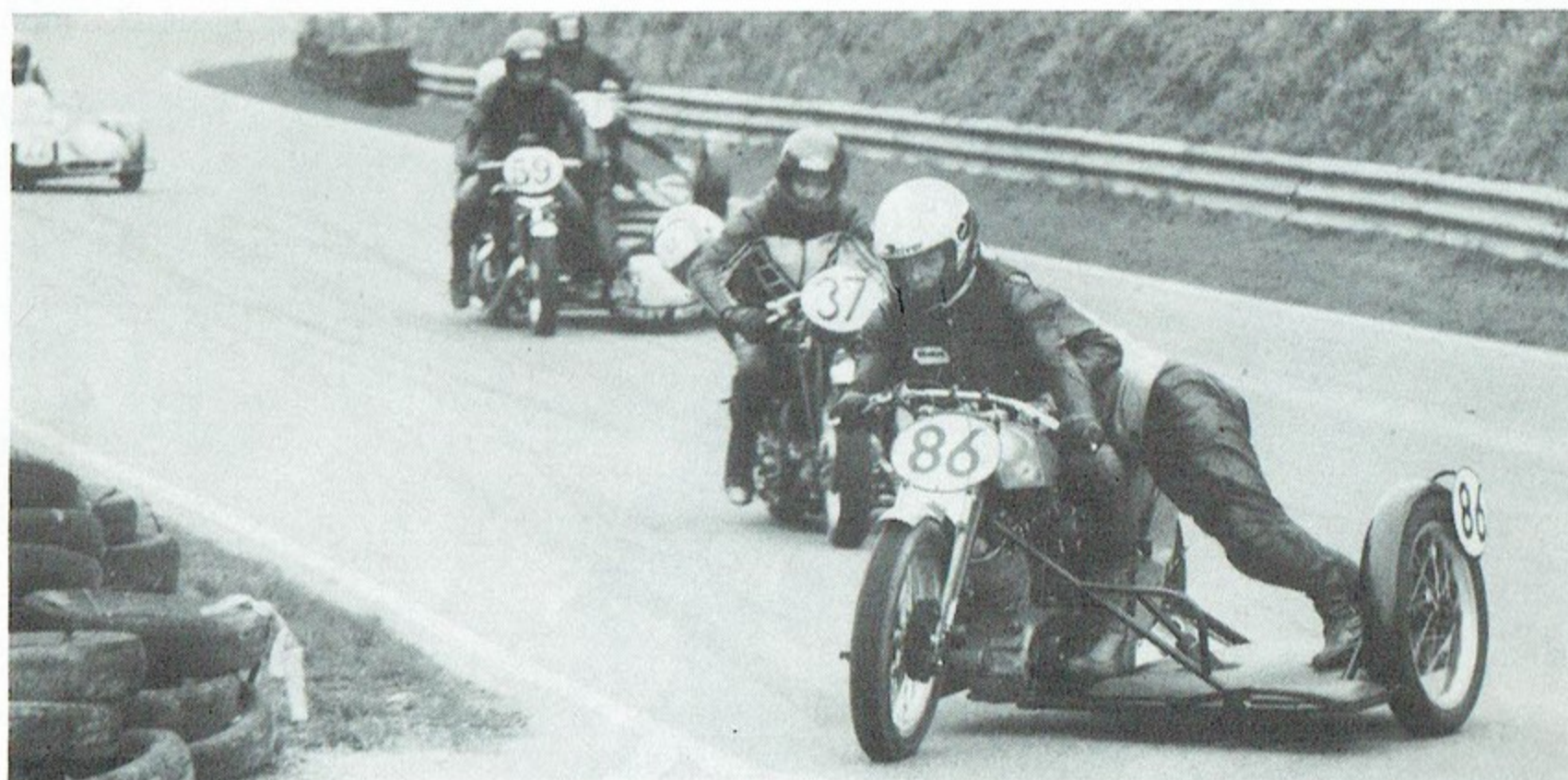
