



MCN Superbikes

-the championship that matters

Ray Pickrell, a London night shift worker, races a new Triumph-3 in today's fifth round of the MCN Superbike championship, sponsored by Motor Cycle News, the world's biggest selling motor cycle newspaper and the biggest selling weekly publication dealing with motor cycles or motoring in Britain.

Said Ray: "This is the championship that matters. It has the publicity, the build-up, the excitement. And the money. The series really has caught on with the British public."

After his Silverstone blow-up, Pickrell rides a new Triumph - one he hopes will pack even more power into its three cylinders.

And he'll need all the power possible. For the opposition is formidable.

Leading the line-up are Pickrell's fellow BSA-Triumph racers - MCN Man of the Year John Cooper, 1971 double TT winner Tony Jefferies and last year's Superbike winner Percy Tait.

And there's the John Player Norton trio of Peter Williams, Phil Read and Mick Grant. Remember, too, that Williams won a race on the 750 Norton at Oulton at Easter and won another at the recent Hutchinson 100 meeting at Brands Hatch.

Making their first appearance in the MCN Superbike series will be Cheshire pair Bill Smith and John Williams. Both ride 750 cc four-cylinder Hondas.

There's also Paul Smart, who makes a late decision as to which machine he will ride. His choice? The three cylinder Triumph on which he scored many successes last year before emigrating to California or his Imola-winning veetwin Ducati from Italy.

It should be a cracking race.

Said MCN Editor Robin Miller: "We're delighted with the success of the series over the last two years. But we hope next year's will be better still".

Two wins at Brands Hatch, a second at Mallory Park and a third at Cadwell Park gives Ray Pickrell a 15 pt. lead over John Cooper, who won at Cadwell and Mallory, in the eight-round MCN Superbike championship.

Overall winner of the series receives £500, with £250 for second, £150 third, £100 fourth, with prize money going down to tenth place. There's also £50 and a trophy for the best dealer-entrant.

Top scores after four rounds: 1 Ray Pickrell (Triumph-3) 62, 2 John Cooper (BSA-3) 47, 3 Peter Williams (John Player Norton) 32, 4 Tony Jefferies (Triumph-3) 27, 5 Dave Potter (Kuhn Norton) 19, 6 Phil Read (John Player Norton) 18, 7 equal Percy Tait (Triumph-3) and Tony Holland (Norton) 11, 9 Ken Redfern (BSA-3) 10, 10 Dave Nixon (Boyer Triumph-3) 9.

The scoring is world championship style - 15-12-10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1 - with five bonus points for the fastest lap. If the fastest lap is shared, each rider receives five points. At the final round, double points will be scored.

Remaining rounds are: September 10 at Scarborough Gold Cup meeting; September 17 at Mallory Park Race of the Year; and October 8 at Brands Hatch Race of the South.

For today's race, all ten £10 awards to the lap leaders will be backed by Castrol, and Norton Villiers continue their £25 awards for the fastest lap in the Superbike race.

Will the World Champion Complete a Double? All the Stars in Superbike Clash!!

Once again we extend to you a warm welcome to this Daily Express sponsored Auto-Cycle Union Rothmans International Trophy Meeting and sincerely hope that the superb entry will provide racing that you will long remember. There has already been two great feasts of speed this month, the Hutchinson 100 at Brands Hatch and the Daily Express International at Silverstone and there is no apparent reason why the racing here should not be up to that high standard.

It is always a thrill to see that popular World Champion Giacomo Agostini in action and we extend a sincere welcome to him and the many other visiting riders from the Continent and elsewhere. Let us hope that there is no such misfortune as happened in the opening race at Brands when Ago took a nasty tumble on the damp surface. The Champion who was as disappointed as the thousands of fans, will, no doubt, ensure that this does not happen again. In both 350 c.c. and 500 c.c. races he must be recognised as favourite but many of our own riders who are in remarkable form will be out to prevent him from completing the double.

Topping the bill, however, must be the fifth round of the Motor Cycle News 1972 Superbike Championship in which, another very popular rider, has, at this stage, a reasonable lead. Ray Pickrell proudly sits on top of the table with 62 points, second placeman is John Cooper with 47. Then comes Peter Williams (32) and Tony Jefferies (27). They are all in to-day's line-up and so too are Paul Smart, Phil Read and Mick Grant who are all riding in terrific form. Phil only lost by inches to Paul, in the Formula 750 race at Brands so will be out to take revenge for that one while Mick won the 350 c.c. race in fine style. Smart handled the big Ducati well on the compact Club circuit but reverse direction racing was not everybody's cup of tea, the uphill push start knocking out several riders from the 'off'. However, the clutch start for the Superbike Series ensures that it will not happen on this occasion. Percy Tait, 1971 Champion came back with a bang at Silverstone and could easily repeat the dose here.

This Championship has overshadowed and even created greater interest than the National Championships and with three more rounds to go the current leader cannot afford to be complacent. Ray has only to slip and with a win and fastest lap to-day John Cooper will be breathing down his neck. With so much bonus around this must be the 'race of the day'. It is anyone's guess who will be the winner.

The 125 c.c. race looks a very open affair but the appearance of Rod Gould in the 250 c.c. race is really going to hot things up. Barry Sheene, Barry Randle, Paul Smart and Mick Grant are in great form and should give the globe trotting Rod something to think about. Others who could well be involved in a close finish are Irishman Ray Mc-Cullough, Tony Rutter and Brian Kemp. Appearing in this and the 350 c.c. race is Alan Barnett who had an unfortunate tumble here early in the season. Alan showed some of his old style when he had his first outing at the recent Brands meeting and should be well up at the finish. Ago tops the 350 c.c. list and it will be up to Sheene, Randle, Smart, Grant and Tony Jefferies to stop the first part of an expected double. Peter Williams who had overtaken the Champion before he crashed at

Brands will be out to show that this was no flash in the pan - providing Tom Arter's Matchless goes as well this time there should be some fun. Rod Gould adds spice to this 500 c.c. battle while Dave Croxford, Sheene, Kemp, Steve Ellis and Mc-Cullough will all give a good account of themselves.

What a fantastic three-wheeler entry there was and a great pity that they could not all be accommodated. After his brilliant win in the Finnish G.P. and again a fine performance at Silverstone Chris Vincent on the Munch 4 must start favourite but

Swiss star Rudi Kurth partnered by Dane Rowe have the Crescent engined CAT really flying and circuit lap record holder Peter Williams will be having his say. For a good outsider we look to Peter Brown, Mick Boddice or Pip Harris to upset current form.

One great hope is that all of these riders and their machines have survived from yesterday's meeting at Snetterton where Ago was riding for the very first time.

Enjoy the racing and take care on the way home.
