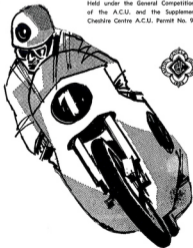

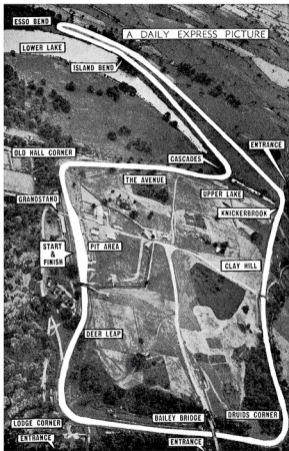

FOREWORD

TODAY the Cheshire Centre of the Auto-Cycle Union once again have the privilege of organising the Clubman's Road Races on behalf of the Auto-Cycle Union and although Oulton Park has become to be regarded as the home of these Races there may be many spectators who are asking themselves "What are the Clubman's Races?"

Well, it all started twenty years ago in the Isle of Man, when the first Clubman's T.T. was held for 250 c.c., 350 c.c., 500 c.c. and 1000 c.c. machines. These races were basically designed to cater for non-international riders on machines available to the general public and on which only small concessions to racing safety were allowed. The races continued on the Island until 1956, during which time several riders wisely used these races as a stepping stone to the International T.T. Races. Probably the most successful of the Clubman's "Apprentices" was Geoff Duke, who after winning the Senior Clubman's in 1949, won the Senior Manx Grand Prix in the same year and in the following year commenced his run of International successes by winning the 1950 Senior T.T.

Other successful Clubman's T.T. winners come to mind, namely the late Bob McIntyre, Brian Purlow, Bob Keeler, Derek Powell and Alistair King, not forgetting two prominent Cheshire Centre riders Phil Carter and the late Brian Jackson.

When the races came to the mainland the T.T. part of the title was dropped and shortly afterwards the Cheshire Centre decided, in my mind wisely, that normal racing machines could be used. The spirit of the races has been maintained however by barring holders of International licences and the spectator interest has been increased by adding the sidecar class. With the passing of the years, the demand for entries has increased, but unfortunately there is a limit to the number of riders who can safely practice and race in one day and many entries have to be rejected. This I know causes my friend Jack Thomas, our Racing Secretary, a great deal of grief.

In continuing to promote the Clubman's Races I feel that the Cheshire Centre is contributing a great deal towards a well balanced programme of racing at Oulton Park. After all, the function of any Centre or Club is to provide Motor Cycle Sport at all levels and here at Oulton Park we have Club Meetings on the Short Circuit, and specially restricted National and International Meetings on the full circuit.

So the stage is set for another Clubman's and right away I would like to wish all spectators an enjoyable day's sport and all riders and passengers an enjoyable and trouble free day of racing.

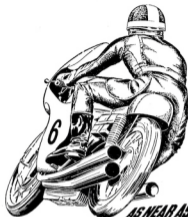
