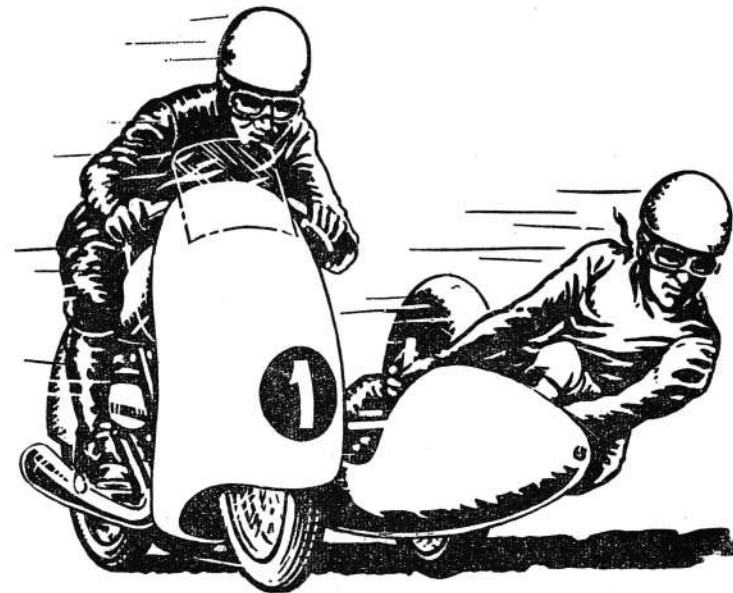

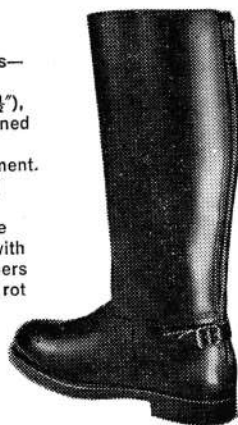

The International Three-Wheeler Race of the Year will present a feast of three-wheeler dicing unequalled on circuits this year, and there is a £1,000 in prize money to be collected by the successful drivers. In the same programme will be races for solos of 250, 350 and 500 c.c. plus Chairs, all in the Clubman category, to ensure a full and varied days racing. Two races and four heats comprise the International Three-Wheeler events, there are two capacity classes—500 c.c. and up to 750 c.c. The first twelve in each heat qualify for the final.

In the first heat of the 500 c.c. International three-wheelers the BMW's of Pip

Harris and Tony Wakefield will have the fantastic four cylinder 'home-built' URS of Helmut Fath to contend with. Initially this very powerful engine suffered with teething troubles but has just won its first International race on the Continent and given another 'clear run' should stand a good chance of winning the final.

Top BSA drivers Chris Vincent and Mick Boddice turn out in the second heat though their 500 Beesa's must be a little down on power on the Bee Em of Siegfried Schauzu, and Schauzu needs no advantage to be capable of winning, he won the Chair TT last year. The Final will be a scorcher. With up to 750 c.c. allowed, the bigger of the chair races are very much more interesting with the 650 and 750 British bikes capable of beating the BMW's. In heat one, Chris Vincent on the bigger of his outfits, plus Mick Boddice on his 654 BSA should stand a good chance of beating 'Pips' 492 Bee Em, though Harris should never be underrated with 20 years experience behind him.

In spite of only 500 c.c., Fath could still have enough bhp to beat Peter Brown's BSA in the second heat and again the first twelve go forward to the final.

The stars of the future are the Clubman of today and although they take second place in the billing today the racing should be just as keen as the International classes. In the up to 1300 c.c. three-wheeler race there is an interesting variety of machinery ranging from the usual vertical twins from Triumph and BSA to car engined outfits like the 875 Impala of J. Boardman and the bigger version by I. Evans, to the 1000 Vincent of J. Trustham who on form should figure in the results.

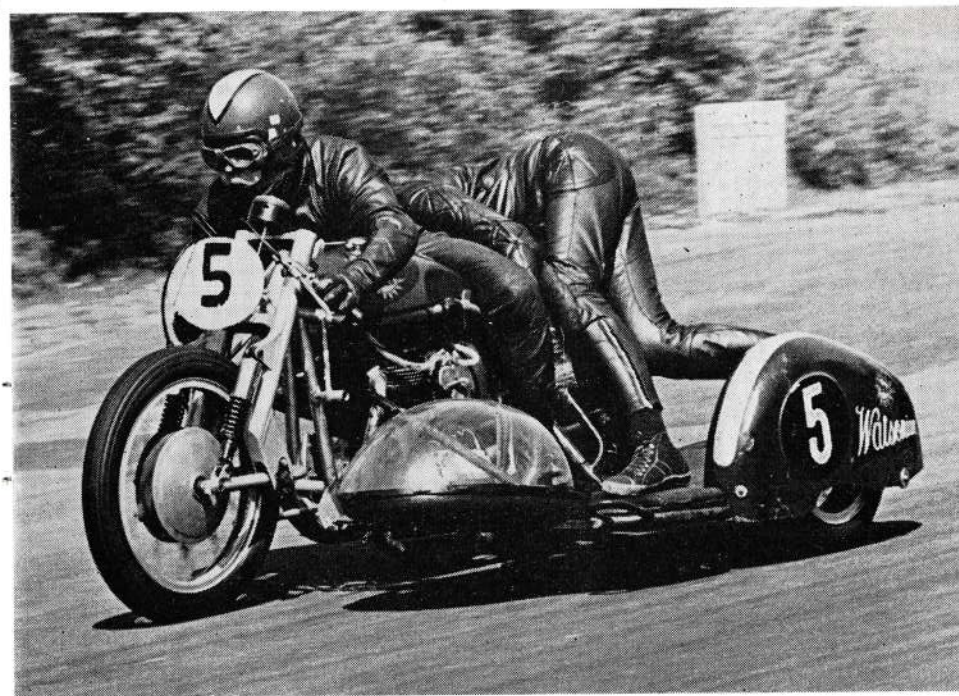
After all the excitement and acrobatics of the three-wheelers, the three races in the solo classes, each has two heats to select the finalists. You will not be familiar with many of the names but already making

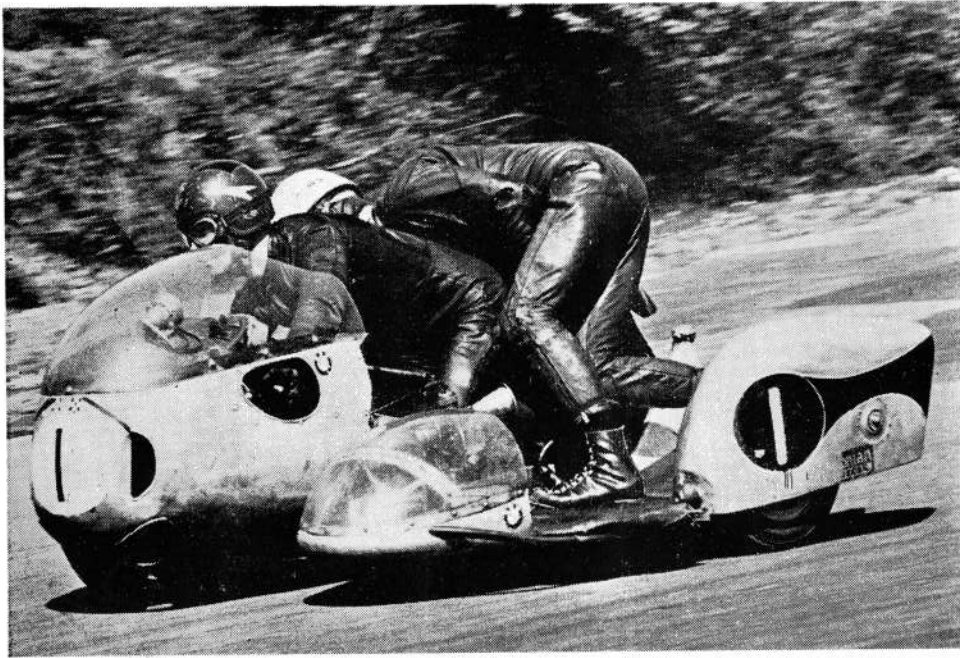
his mark this season is Steve Woods on his rapid 'five port Yam'.

The 350 class sees the continued encroachment by foreign machinery of what was once the preserve of the British Camshaft singles. Now there are the fast Italian pushrod Aermacchi's and the two stroke twins from Japan, in particular D. Padgett's 305 Yamaha and the Kawasaki of D. Thomas. A Kawasaki recently won its first big race in England at Brands Hatch. At least in the 500 class the big single continues to dominate in Club racing and in spite of the many fast Triumph powered machines in the programme the winner will probably be astride one of the Nortons or Matchless'. The thing about making predictions in club racing is that there is always somebody on the way up to upset the appercart and whatever machinery today's Clubmen ride you may be looking at the Champs of tomorrow.
