## ***Today's Star Studded Field***

The first round of the 1970 British Championships was to have been held here on the 7th March, but this meeting was postponed due to three inches of snow lying on the track. Therefore the 1970 season now starts with today's meeting, the Daily Express Race of the North, also included in this meeting is the third round of the Shell 500 c.c. Championship and the organisation is in the capable hands of the Wirral 100 Motor Club.

The programme includes five solo events (125 c.c., 250 c.c., 350 c.c., 500 c.c. and 750 c.c.) and two 500 c.c. six lap three-wheeler races with the aggregate time of the two races deciding the winner.

Following Brands Hatch (Good Friday) and Mallory Park (Sunday) some riders left the M.C.D. circuits for other venues but there is sufficient talent in the entry list to ensure some exciting and competitive racing. Four of our six National Champions are in the line-up, Dave Browning (250 c.c.), Pat Mahoney (350 c.c.), Dave Croxford (500 c.c.) and the inimitable Chris Vincent (three-wheeler) in addition to a host of other stars, which include Percy Tait, Tommy Robb, Cliff Carr and Bill Smith fresh from their exploits in the Daytona 200. Also we give a big welcome to Steve Ellis, sixth in the 1969 500 c.c. World Championship who rides an Aermacchi in the 350 c.c. event and a Linto in the 500 c.c. race.

After his early successes at Mallory Park, 19 year old Barry Sheene should start favourite for the 8 lap 125 c.c. event, but he is sure to have the close attention of such riders as Stuart Graham (Suzuki), Steve Murray (Honda), Trevor Burgess (Yamaha) and Andrew Manship on the Padgett Yamaha.

Moving to the 250s over ten laps, Sheene, this time on the Brown Yamaha will have far greater competition and be hard pressed to repeat his Mallory double. Well in the hunt for victory will be Tommy Robb (Shepherd), the Yamaha quartette of John Cooper, Tommy Robb, Bill Smith and Dave Browning in addition to Jim Curry (Honda) and Cliff Carr (Ossa).

Godfrey Nash on the John Tickle produced Mank is an interesting starter in the 350 c.c. race where current Champion in this class, Pat Mahoney, is on a Kuhn Seeley. Star of the earlier 500 c.c. Mallory race, Bob Heath (B.S.A.) will be out to retain his new reputation but amongst those trying to stop him will be Derek Woodman (Seeley), Tony Rutter (Yamaha), 350 c.c. winner at Mallory, Trevor Burgess (Yamaha), Malcolm Uphill (Bridgetown Altair), Peter Williams (Arter-A.J.S.) Barry Sheene (Bultaco), Tommy Robb (Aermacchi), Dave Browning and Cliff Carr (Yamahs) and John Cooper on a Seeley Yamaha.

500 c.c. Champion Dave Croxford now on a Petty tuned Norton heads the list in the Senior race but there is much interest in the Italian Linto ridden by Steve Ellis. Percy Tait rides a Metisse-Triumph and strong opposition is provided by Bob Heath (B.S.A.), Pat Mahoney (Kuhn-Seeley), Peter Williams (Arter-Matchless), Barry Sheene (Bultaco), Bill Smith (Kawasaki), Derek Woodman, John Cooper and Tommy Robb all on Seeleys. Most of these riders will be out again in the 750 c.c. race where the chief interest will be in the riders back from Daytona, Percy Tait (Trident) and Bill Smith (Honda), together with the Harley Davidson ridden by Swenden's Anders Svenson. To add some International flavour to the solo events there is Bo Granath (M.Z. and Yamaha) from Sweden, Jan Kostwinder (Yamaha) from Holland, Jorgen Neilson (Bultaco) from Denmark and Adolf Ohligschläger (Yamaha) from West Germany.

Pip Harris (B.S.A.), Tony Wakefield and Graham Milton (B.M.W.s) provide the main opposition to Chris Vincent (B.S.A.) in the three-wheeler class which also includes the West Germans Hans Hubacher and Richard Wegener.

# Shell 500cc Championship 1970

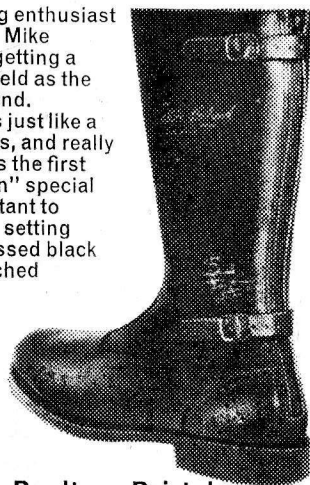

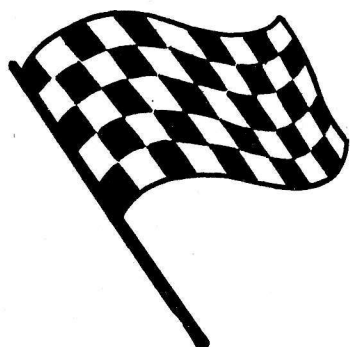
