



#### **Motor Cycle News 1971 Superbike Championships**

MOTOR CYCLE NEWS Superbike series, the international £2,000 road race championship which delights riders, sponsors, factories and promoters, moves north to Oulton Park for today's fourth round.

Before yesterday's round at Snetterton - the commentators will inform you of the up-to-date positions - Triumph works rider Percy Tait led the series.

After the Mallory Park and Brands Hatch rounds, his 35 points total was 21 more than that of runner-up Bob Heath on the BSA Rocket.

The series continues at the Race of the Year at Mallory Park on September 19, and climaxes at the final round at the Race of the South at Brands Hatch on October 3.

Points will be scored, as in the world championships, 15-12-10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1, with double points in the last round. There is a bonus five points for the fastest lap, and if more than one rider shares the fastest lap, each will receive five points. Overall winner receives £500, with £250 second and £100 third.

The fastest lap at each of the six MCN Superbike rounds will be backed by Norton-Villiers. They award £25 for the fastest lap, with the prize being split if the fastest lap is shared.

There are no lap bonus awards at this meeting.

Nothing would give greater pleasure than to put on a meeting that pleased everybody all of the time - really it is an impossibility, as one can gather from the correspondence columns of the Motor Cycle weekly press.

Even to-day we start off with a disappointment, this will not please anyone for it is the non-appearance of that popular super World Champion Giacomo Agostini. He was all set to be with us to-day when factory commitments decided otherwise, however, we still have two World Champions on the circuit and another with a World Title within his grasp - we hope he gets it.


Now to welcome and congratulate the 1971 sidecar World Champion, 33 year old West German Horst Owesle who only came onto the International scene a matter of three years ago, previous to that having competed in National events. He took over the four cylinder Munch when it's original pilot Helmut Fath parted company with the firm and what an outstanding success he has made of it particularly in recent races when he has been partnered by Londoner Peter Rutherford.

Lining up with the new champion to-day will be fellow countryman Georg Auerbacher, currently fourth in the world series and in opposition will be our own Chris Vincent which will enable us to assess how he would have fared in competition on the Grand Prix circuits. A score or more other riders will also pit their skill against these 1971 greats and will get some satisfaction if finishing in front or in close company. Peter Brown, Pip Harris and Co. are quite capable of doing just that.


Now to move on to the star packed solo programme which includes the fourth round of the Motor Cycle News Superbike Championship.

Rod Gould is our only reigning World Champion in the 250 c.c. class and following a lowly sixth place in the recent Ulster Grand Prix has snatched back the lead from Phil Read in the current series.

Rod had his troubles early in the season and it now appears to be Phil's turn for things to go amiss. A spill in practice for the Czech round at Brno cost him valuable points and then









with a lap and a half to go in Ulster, when safely in second place, his engine decided to call it a day. With only two rounds left he has a leeway of four points to make up on the Champion. Grand Prix racing forgotten for the moment they will be at it hammer and tongs to-day and amongst those joining them will be our potential 125 c.c. World Champion Barry Sheene. This near 21 year old Londoner has had a great season earning praise from both the press and his fellow riders. Victories in the 250 c.c. and 350 c.c. classes at Brands recently earned him the title of Super Sheene. To-day he may come in for more glory but first he will have to settle with both Read and Gould and chaps like Peter Williams and Ray McCullough winners of the respective 350 c.c. and 250 c.c. classes in the Ulster. This was Peter's first Grand Prix victory and followed closely on winning the £1,000 Mellano Trophy at the Hutchinson 100 meeting. Ray, no youngster at 30. works at Queens University. Belfast so has been somewhat involved in testing the QUB machines. He rides a Seeley QUB in the 500 c.c. race.

Not out of the reckoning will be the regular short circuit riders John Cooper, Paul Smart, Rex Butcher, Tony Jeffries and Percy Tait. Care to pick the winner of the 250 or 350 race. With 'Ago' missing from the Senior event it could be any of those riders again out in front but with Charlie Sanby, Bob Heath and Dave Croxford also having a say in the matter.

The Motor Cycle News Superbike Championship is catching on and to-day's entry is the biggest yet and with a clutch start it will be fair 'dos' for all. Percy Tait had such a lead before yesterday's meeting at Snetterton that he should still head the table. He had 35 points after two rounds, Bob Heath was next with 14 then came Charlie Sanby and Ray Pickrell on 12. With points going towards the big prize money and additional pounds for the fastest lap this is bound to be quite a scrap and bearing in mind some recent performances by Peter Williams, Paul Smart, John Cooper and Ray Pickrell, the Championship leader will have to fight hard for his share in the gold this time.

If the chances of any of the riders here to-day have been overlooked we apologise but at least the winner (we think) of every race has been mentioned. So to sign off with a sincere hope that the weather keeps fine and after an exceptional day's racing you have a safe journey home. Let your memories of speed remain of the circuit and do not try and emulate the riders in your effort to make a fast time back to your home town.
