YARWELL APPEAL HEARING

Last week the A.M.C.A. Appeal against the refusal of the EAST Northants County Council to grant planning permission for a permanent moto cross circuit at Yarwell was heard.

An Inspector appointed by the Minister of State listened to three days of evidence which lasted nearly 20 hours and a final decision is not expected before the end of the year.

Several A.M.C.A. Clubs have used this former quarry outside the village of Yarwell for six years for moto cross events and is an ideal all the year round type circuit.

The Hearing took place in the East Northants council chamber at Thrapston near Corby and the A.M.C.A. began by putting its case with evidence from Derek Penn Smith a surveyor who has helped Coalville and Crowborough Club in the last two years. A Noise and Highways expert then gave details of the suitability of the access roads and how the site could be further screened from the village. Terry King the A.M.C.A.'s East Group Co-Ordinator and who has been largely responsible for the events at Yarwell and its possible acquisition. Barry Nevills of the East Midlands Sports Council then explained the need for such facilities in the region.

All those people were cross examined by 3 legal representatives including 2 barristers who had been engaged by a) the local council b) KSR - who own a lot of the surrounding land at Yarwell including a former quarry and c) the Yarwell Parish Council.

The A.M.C.A.'s case was conducted by a Barrister who cross examined the witnesses called by the opposition and included the local planning officer, Environmental Health Officer, local Min-

erals Officer, 2 Wild Life and Nature Conservation Experts. From the village the parish clerk and several residents gave details of the problems they had experienced of meetings run and their concern over increased use of the site.

On the last day the two barristers who both live in Yarwell summed up for an hour each as to why the planning permission should not be granted.

After the hearing the Inspector visited the site and will be attending an event in August to see for himself the points and agreements raised during the hearing.

Over 50 people were in attendance on the first day of the hearing including many local residents and this dropped to about 30 on the last day. This is the second time second time the A.M.C.A. have gone to appeal, the first at Nangreaves near Bury.
