

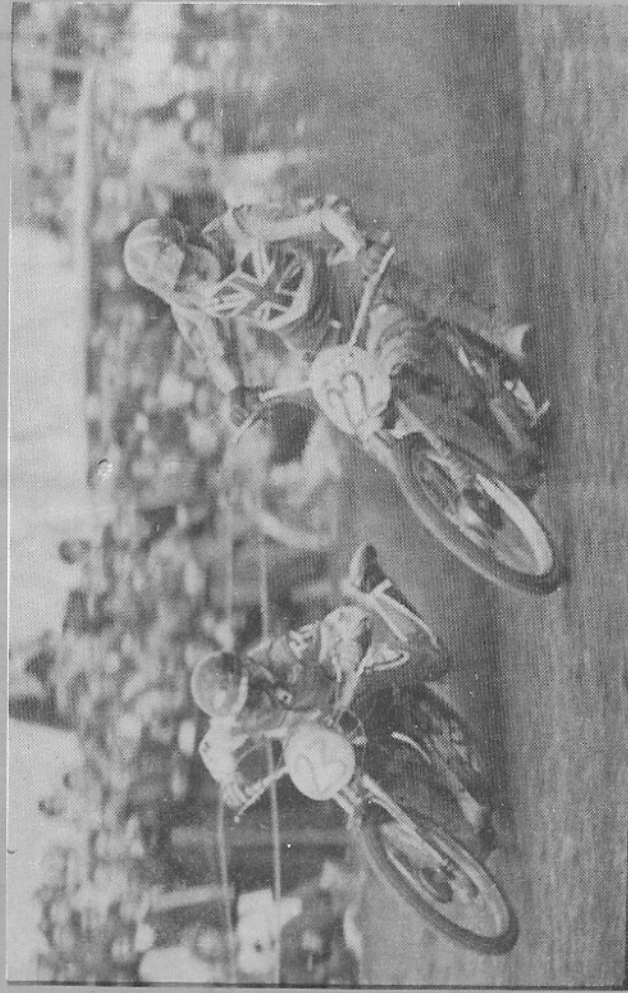

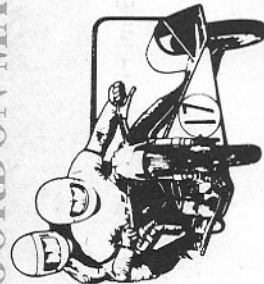

THE BAHNREKORD (TRACK RECORD)

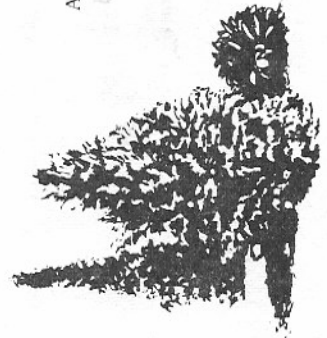
International continental grass track meetings are always preceded by an attempt at the track record.

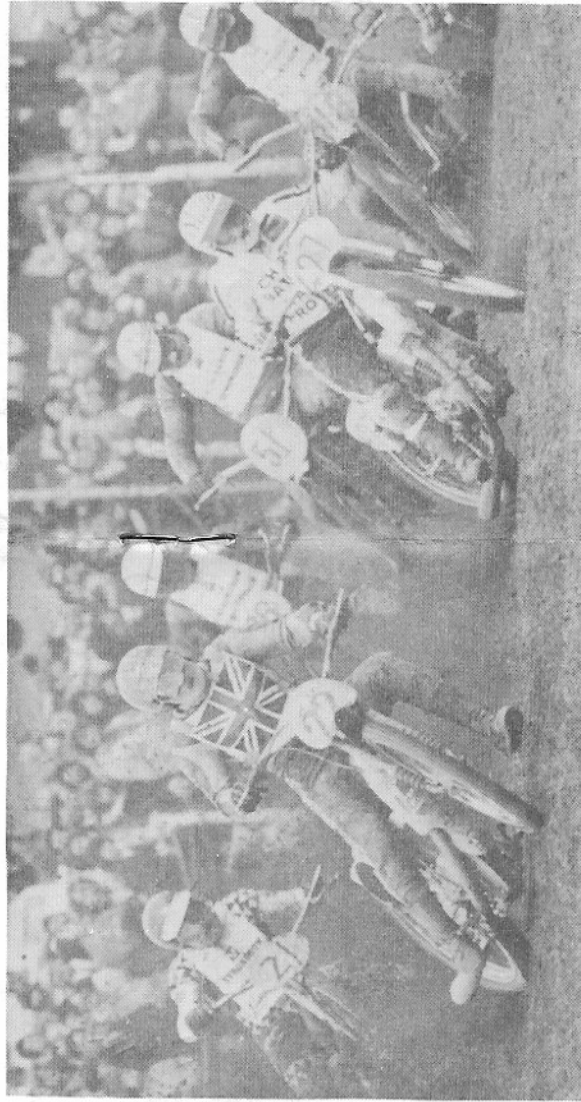

THE MIDLAND JUNIOR GRASS TRACK CLUB

The Midland Junior Grass Track Club was founded in 1973. Its purpose, to promote Grass Track racing amongst schoolboys (or girls), ages from 6 years to 16 years. The club runs to A.C.U. (Youth Division) rules. The classes are as follows:

CADETS:	6 yrs to 8 yrs	Machine capacity	50 cc maximum
JUNIORS:	8 yrs to 11 yrs	Machine capacity	100 cc maximum
INTERMEDIATES:	11 yrs to 13 yrs	Machine capacity	150 cc maximum
SENIOR A:	13 yrs to 15 yrs	Machine capacity	200 cc maximum
SENIOR A 1:	15 yrs to 17 yrs	Machine capacity	250 cc maximum

As you can see by the classes and machine capacities, the boys are restricted to machinery they are big enough to handle (although a tuned 100 cc single can be a potent machine, and capable of reaching speeds of 70 mph).

The club has had two very successful seasons with boys coming from all over the country to ride with us.

Some of our boys did very well in this year's National Championships and we feel sure they will go on to greater success in the adult ranks of the sport. We, as a club, welcome the opportunity to give a demonstration of the club's talent. We thank the Bewdley MCC for their recognition of the fact that today's schoolboy riders are tomorrow's Champions and that the future of any sport depends upon its youth. 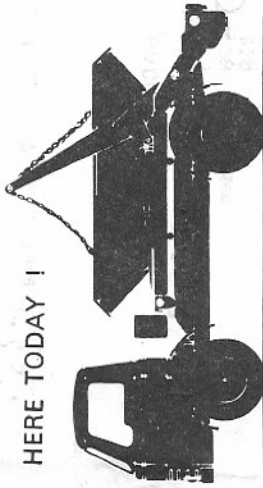

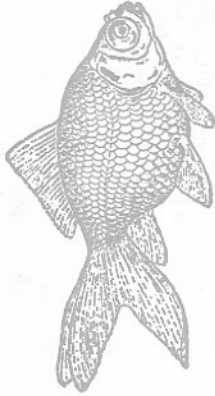
