





### 'MOTOR CYCLE' BRITISH MOTO CROSS CHAMPIONSHIP

by Martin Christie, Moto Cross editor of 'Motor Cycle'

The new-look moto cross championship, sponsored by 'Motor Cycle', has lived up to its expectations. After just one round, three top challengers emerged. Reigning champion, Vic Allan (Bultaco) and John Banks (C.C.M.) each won one race of the opening clash, and definitely set themselves up as the men to beat. But Welshman Andy Roberton, runner-up in both of those races, came away with top points.

So there are desperate men at Pickwick Lodge Farm today. Because of the points-scoring system, no one who wants to win the title can afford to miss a race. There's no second chance for a rider to pick up points on the best overall performance. It's straight racing, and on this fast Wiltshire course it will be a test of speed, as well as stamina, with most riders using 360 c.c. motors or above in this open-class event.

The big battle is obviously between the British-built C.C.M.s, and the Spanish Bultacos. Vic Eastwood and Norman Barrow bring up the Bolton-based team of Alan Clews. Former 250 c.c. champ, Malcolm Davis, is always a threat in the Bultaco camp, but watch out for Kiwi Ivan Miller, who thrives on this sort of course.

Also hitting top form, Bob Wright (Montesa) and Stuart Nunn (C.Z.), could pull some surprises, as could fastest man from the gate, Bryan Wade (Suzuki). Don't count on any sensations from some of our senior stars, like Dave Bickers (C.Z.), Dave Nicoll (Maico) and Andy Lee (C.C.M.), but they'll still be giving the youngsters a run for their money.

One thing that will make or break the series is how well our upand-coming aces can cope with the grand prix length races. So keep an eye on lads like Rob Hooper (Husqvarna), Terry Dyer (Suzuki) and Graham Noyce (Husqvarna). It's to them we must look for the future.




