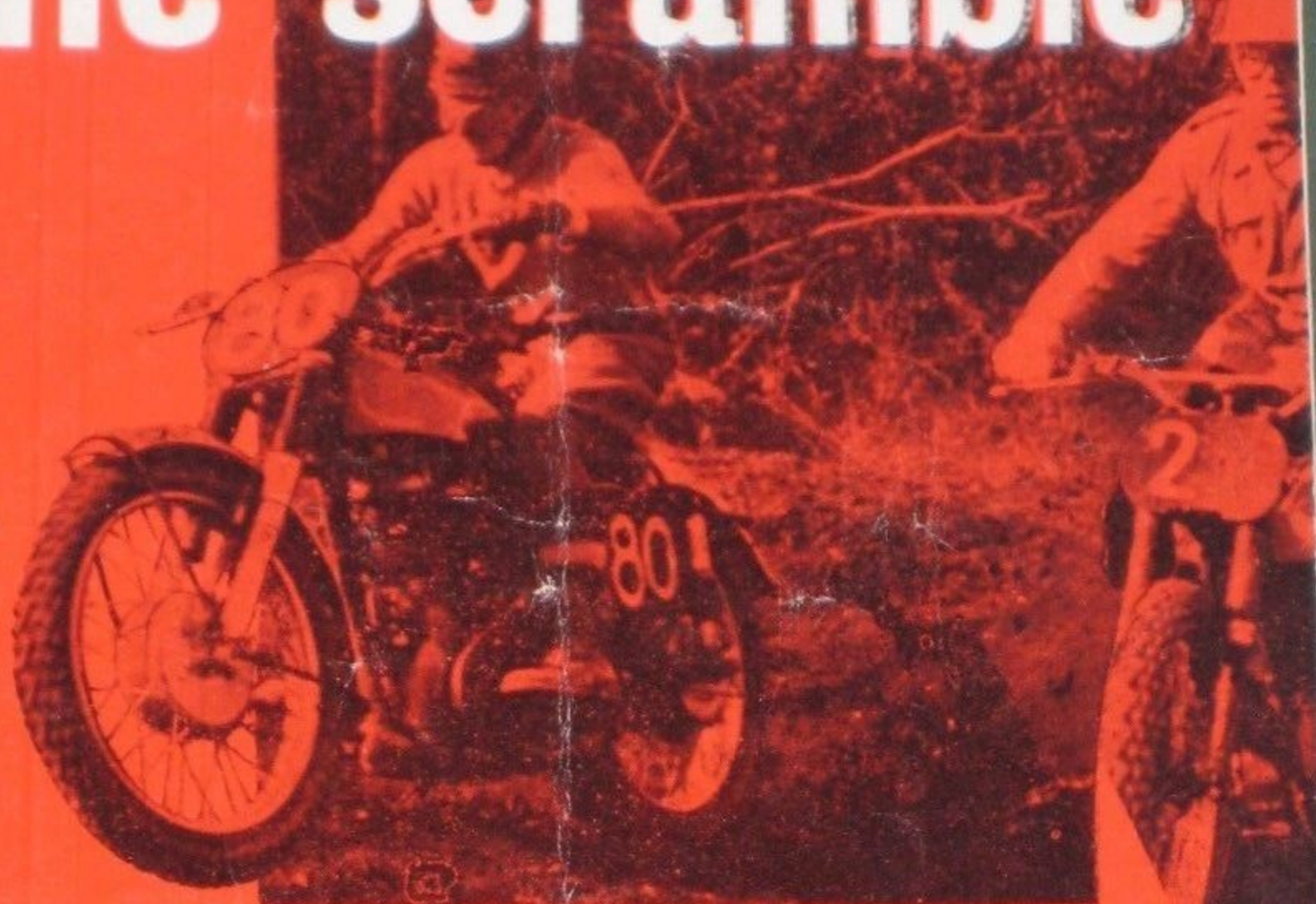

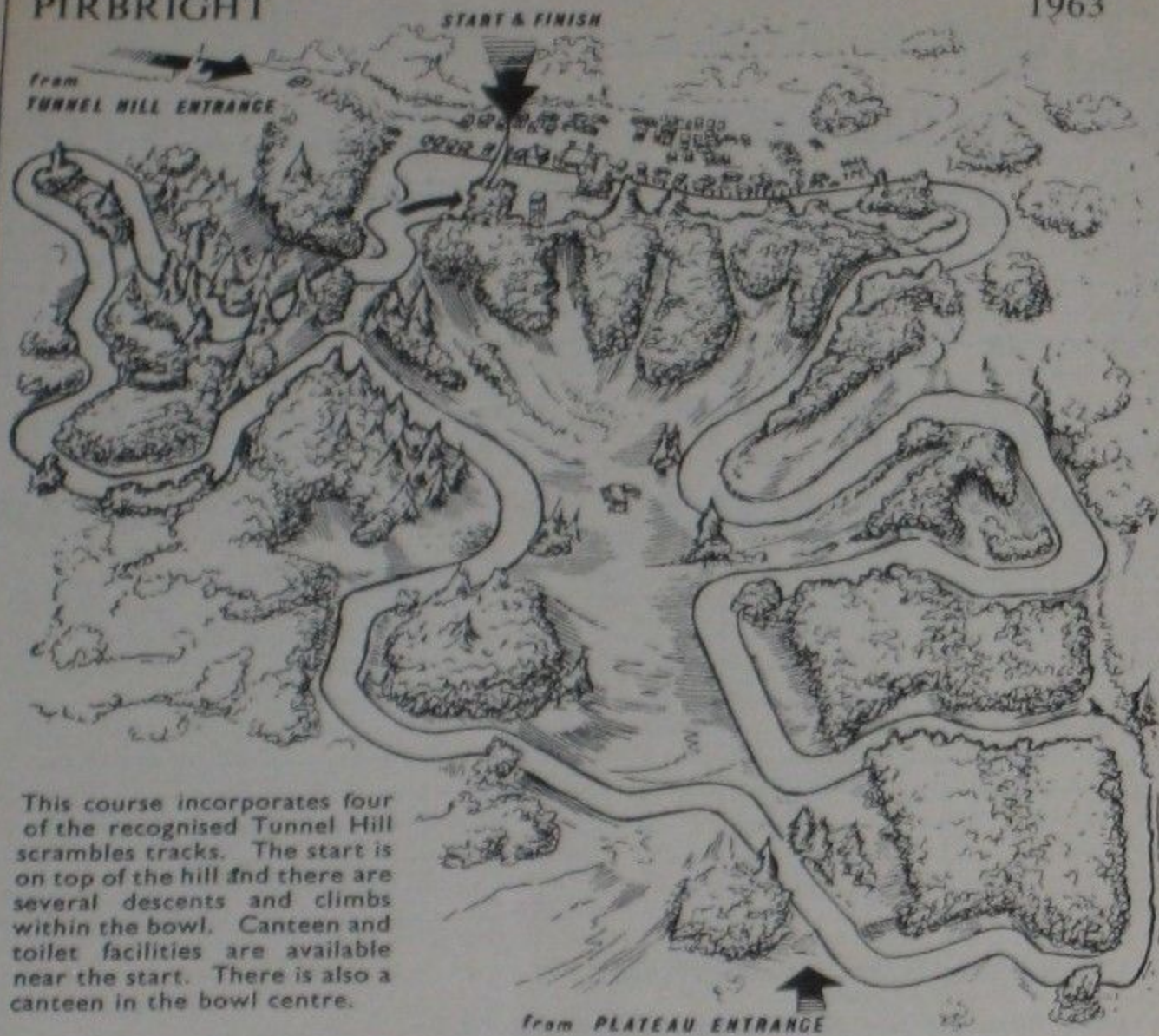

This course incorporates four of the recognised Tunnel Hill scrambles tracks. The start is on top of the hill and there are several descents and climbs within the bowl. Canteen and toilet facilities are available near the start. There is also a canteen in the bowl centre.

COURSE and RIDERS

As can be seen from the map, the course covers all types of riding ground. A steep gully drops down from the top straight followed by a sandy surfaced climb. Much of the course is over loose gravel and light sand but the final 400 yards are through trees and on a surface of leaf mould covering light clay.

If the weather has been damp there may be mud at the end of the top straight, otherwise the entire course will be dry.

A loudspeaker system will keep all parts of the course informed as to the position of the riders and a 'running commentary' will enable spectators to follow the race at all times.

The course will be altered slightly on the day of the race in order to make it suitable for the two sidecar events. This is the first occasion on

which the chairs have been featured in the 100 mile scramble programme. In the past the supporting event has been for Junior riders but now the Juniors are to be allowed to have a crack at the aces in the 100 mile race itself. The first three novice riders to finish will receive special tankards and, who knows, it is quite possible that a Junior could carry off the main trophy. After all, in a rough-country race over 100 miles long anything can happen, and often does!

Last year Triss Sharp won the big race and Mike Peach was the best Junior. This year there is the usual star-studded field and you can be sure that whichever of the riders wins the race he will fully deserve his trophy and every penny of his prize money.
